• LSU held a total of 15 opponents this season under 60 points, with 14 wins ... LSU, earlier in the season, had a streak of seven straight games holding opponents under 60 and winning, equaling the streak of 7 set Jan. 16-Feb. 14, 1953.

* Justin Hamilton is part of a number of categories in the SEC stats -- 14th in points (13.2), 8th rebounds (7.2), 5th in FG Pct (51.5%), 9th FT Pct (77.0%), 10th blocks (1.3), 2nd off. boards (3.4) ... In league games only, he is 11th in scoring (14.1) and 7th in rebounds (7.5).

* With the UGA win (12/22), LSU

now has 17 victories on the year, guaranteeing that LSU will finish with a winning record for the first time since the 2009 season.

* Anthony Hickey's 21 treys, along with 17 by Andre Stringer and 15 by Ralston Turner make up 53 of 63 treys for LSU in league play.

* Andre Stringer has been in double figures in 4-of-last-5 games, averaging 12.4 points with 15 assists and 8 treys.

* The Tigers had its second 50 percent shooting from the arc in league play at South Carolina, making 5-of-10

after making 11-of-21 from the arc at Mississippi State (1/25) ... LSU was 5-of-14 (36%) in the UGA win (2/22).

* The Tigers are now 11-3 at home this year ... LSU is 6-1 in the league at home after 1-7 in PMAC in 2011, 2-6 in 2010.

* UT leads the series, 59-43, with UT having won three straight in the series ... LSU leads, 25-22 in Baton Rouge ... LSU last won in Baton Rouge in 2007.

•The ceremony for LSU's three senior players will be held prior to the game beginning at 7:45 p.m. prior to the 8 p.m. tip.

Trent Johnson

Head Coach • 4th year at LSU (13th year as head coach)

Trent Johnson, with two strong back-to-back recruiting classes on board, enters his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU Tigers in 2011-12.

Johnson's passion and vision for the LSU basketball program has the Tigers headed in the right direction.

As Johnson and his staff continue to develop players both on the court and off the court, they expected continued improvement athletically, academically and socially from the team.

Johnson, the 20th men's basketball coach at LSU, seeks to build on more than a decade of excellence at LSU, Stanford and Nevada. Having earned Conference Coach of the Year in all three leagues (Western Athletic Conference, Pac-10 and Southeastern Conference), Johnson knows the route to success to getting LSU back in the national spotlight.

In his first season at LSU, Johnson led the Tigers to 27 wins, tied for the third most wins in a season in LSU history. The Tigers won the SEC regular season championship with a record of 13-3. LSU returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2006, advancing to the second round before falling, 84-70, to North Carolina in the closest game the eventual national champions would have to play. LSU had a second half lead on the Tar Heels and the game was still in the balance entering the final eight minutes.

Coach Johnson has a blueprint for success for himself and his players. As his players grasp the vision for success, they have the opportunity to embrace playing in a fast-paced system where executing in the half court and defending and rebounding are at a high level.

Johnson has a record of success and his team will have the opportunity to blend together and learn from a coach that is a fierce competitor who exudes and demands toughness.

His devotion to the team, his protective beliefs toward his players and his loyalty to his former players is evidenced by the fact that three of his former players are now members of the LSU basketball staff. Johnson is a program builder and he has re-established the base of the LSU program by visiting with former players and coaches to bring together the past, the present and the future of the program.

Johnson also is charged with the development of athletes both on and off the court. Off the court, he has worked hard since day one to make sure student-athletes understand the "student" part of their days at LSU. At all three stops in his head coaching career, he has developed not just successful athletes and winning basketball teams, but young men who are having success in life.

In his 13 years combined as a Division I head coach at LSU, Stanford and Nevada, he has won 208 games and taken teams in seven-of-the-last-nine seasons to post-season play, including five NCAA appearances.

Johnson was named the 2009 consensus SEC Coach of the Year and was a finalist for four national coach of the year honors as he became the first LSU men's basketball coach to win the league title and take the team to post-season play in his first year at the school.

Johnson has always been a big believer in special causes and joined former LSU basketball coach Dale Brown and star center Shaquille O'Neal in cutting a series of commercials that aired nationally for the "Be A Match" organization of bone marrow donors.

In June 2010, Johnson was part of a 10-day trip to Africa as part of the Nkomazi Sports Club Organization program that was established to stop the transmission of HIV through culturally relevant, locally sustainable health and life skills education-based programs in communities affected by HIV/AIDS.

He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and has served on the NABC Special Committee on Recruiting and Access. He also gives his time freely to such organizations as the Boy Scouts of America, the Louisiana Health and Rehab Center, Inc., the American Diabestes Association, Samaritan's Feet, Troops First and the Jimmy V Foundation for cancer research.

Johnson, was born in Berkeley, Calif., and is married to Jackie and they have two children: a daughter, Tinishia, 28, and a son, Terry, 25.

Johnson's vision and passion is what drives him to make LSU basketball a success. With a coaching staff and a group of players that believe in the same vision and passion, that success has to be very much in sight.

Last Time Out - Ole Miss 72, LSU 48 (Feb. 25, Oxford, Miss.)

The Tigers were unable to get anything going at all in Oxford as Ole Miss shot 50 percent from the field, including 75 percent from the arc in the first half in building a 10-point, 34-24 halftime advantage ... But in the second half things went from bad to worse as LSU shot just 25 percent from the field and Ole Miss shot 15-25 at the free throw line to win going away ... LSU finished 18-58 from the field, 31 percent, 4-23 from the arc and 8-of-14 from the free throw line ... LSU was out rebounded 37-36 overall, but LSU did have one of its better offensive rebounding numbers with 18.

Storm Warren off the bench hit 4-of-8 field goals and 5-of-6 at the line to finish with a team best 13 points in 13 minutes, while Andre Stringer had 10 points and three assists. Johnny O'Bryant III had nine points and 11 rebounds.

Tigers Assure Themselves Of Winning Season With 17th Victory

The Tigers are now 5-2 in February and with the win last week against Georgia (2/22) came LSU's 17th victory of the season, assuring that the Tigers will have a winning overall record in 2012 ... With seven league wins, LSU needs one more conference win to assure a non-losing conference season ... In Coach Johnson's four years in Baton Rouge, LSU is 15-15 in the month of February with nine of those wins coming in an undefeated month leading to the 2009 SEC Championship.

For the first time since the 2008-09 season, the Tiger basketball team topped the 11-win mark with the win against Auburn (1/17), its 12th of the season ... Only in one of the past five seasons (2009) has LSU been able to win more than six conference games in a year and the last two years combined, the Tigers had just five conference victories (2 - 2010, 3 - 2011) ... The final two home games are Wednesday at home against Tennessee and at Auburn on Saturday.

Senior Night

The Tigers will honor three seniors prior to the game at approximately at 7:45 p.m. as Chris Bass, Storm Warren and Malcolm White will come on to the floor of the PMAC for the final time in the regular season.

Bass enters the week having played 118 career games with 22 starts with a 1.7 ppg and a 1.8 rpg career average in 16.1 minutes per game ... Bass has 263 career assists to just 123 turnovers as he has had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio every year of his career.

Warren in his career has played in 118 career games with 66 starts, averaging 18.8 minutes per game with career marks of 7.5 ppg and 4.9 rpg ... He is one of just three players in LSU history to have career 500 rebounds-100 blocks-100 steals.

White, who transferred from Ole Miss after his second year, has played in 57 games with 31 starts over two years, averaging 17.8 mpg, 5.7 ppg and 3.8 rpg.

Both Bass and Warren were members of the 2009 SEC Championship at LSU.

All three are scheduled to graduate in May 2012 ... Bass and White will both be graduating with a degree from the College of Humanities and Social Science in Interdisciplinary Studies and Warren will be graduating with a degree from the College of Education in Sports Management.

Tigers Find The Line

At the free throw line, LSU led the league in free throw shooting for much of the first month of the season, before falling down the league list ... Then a four game run where LSU shot 80 percent (52-65) in mid-February moved the Tigers back to second in the league ... But after LSU shot just 26-of-44 at the line the last two games, the Tigers free throw percentage dropped from second to fourth and now to sixth at an even 70 percent (338-483).

In SEC games, LSU is 160-of-232 with opponents +26 in free throws made and +57 in attempts in the 14 SEC games ... Opponents are 186-of-289.

Storm Warren showed the team's ability late at the free throw line by making the two charity tosses with 1.2 seconds left to win the game at Houston (11/29) ... Warren was a 51.5 percent free throw shooter a year ago (17-33), but this year he has already made 43 free throws in 60 attempts (71.7 percent) ... Andre Stringer has been strong at the line, hitting 52-of-62 for 83.9 percent ... Ralston Turner is at 77.4 percent (41-53).

Justin Hamilton made 8-of-8 against South Carolina in the win and over the previous five games before the Ole Miss trip had made 24-of-his-last 25 attempts and stood at 79.1 percent ... But after a very uncharacteristic 0-3 at the line in Oxford, he stands at 87-of-113 for the season (dropping from 79.1 to 77.0 percent).

Last season LSU made 66.5 percent of its free throws (432-650), the second consecutive season LSU was below 70 percent.

games in SEC play ... The stretch of games versus Florida-Mississippi State and Kentucky marked the first time LSU played three consecutive nationally-ranked AP opponents in the regular season since the Tigers met # 22 Mississippi State, #4 Florida and #23 Alabama at the end of January 2003.

Defense Under 60

LSU has held 15 opponents under 60 points including a string of seven straight wins and a 14-1 record in those games:

Vs. Western Kentucky – 57 points; Vs. Georgia Tech – 50

At Houston – 58; At Rutgers – 50; Boise State – 45; UC Irvine – 59; #10 Marquette – 59; At North Texas – 58; Grambling – 37

#21 Virginia (L) – 57;

Ole Miss – 55; Auburn – 58; Alabama – 58; South Carolina – 58; Georgia – 53;

It had been almost 50 years since a team of LSU basketball players held opponents under 60 points in each of seven consecutive wins as the 2010-11 team did ... The 1952-53 team from Jan. 16 to Feb. 14 held seven consecutive teams under 60.

In that streak of seven games, LSU won three times on the road (at Houston, at Rutgers and at North Texas) and four in the Maravich Center (Boise State, UC Irvine, Marquette and Grambling).

LSU is 35-5 in the Trent Johnson era when holding teams under 60 points.

Season 41 At The PMAC; Tigers Assured Of Winning Home Record; 6-1 In SEC

It was the 1971-72 season that the first game was played in the then LSU Assembly Center, opening the building on Jan. 3, 1972 against Vanderbilt, an 80-73 loss. The Tigers got their first win in the building on Jan. 6, 1972 against Georgetown, 90-71.

LSU has been able to get its home court advantage back this season at the Maravich Center after winning just 8-of-18 games a year ago. The Tigers are now 11-3 and assured of the 29th double digit season of wins in the 41 years of play in the PMAC ... If LSU is able to win its home finale, the 12 home wins would mark the 19th time an LSU team has had at least 12 home wins ... Overall, LSU is 472-167 in the building (73.9 percent) and 219-129 (62.9 percent) in SEC home games ... Trent Johnson is 16-15 in home SEC games.

Attendance Up; Paid and Actual

Through 14 home games, LSU paid attendance (NCAA recorded attendance of tickets sold plus student and media attendance) is at 119,434, an average 8,531 a game ... That is up some 1,400 from last year's average of 7,166, an increase of 8.4 percent over a year ago ... The actual attendance average through 14 games is 4,780, an increase of over 1,300 fans a game compared to last year's average of 3,466 (an increase of 7.2 percent in the stands).

Wins On The Road

LSU has a 4-7 record on the road this season ... The three wins in non-conference play on a road court in the continental United States marked the first time since the 1985-86 season that LSU has won three on the road.

In the road wins at Houston (59-58) and Rutgers (55-50), LSU had to come from behind twice in the second half against Houston and Rutgers ... The Tigers defeated Houston after the Cougars scored with 9.1 seconds left to take a 58-57 lead ... Anthony Hickey drove the lane, missed a contested layup, and then senior Storm Warren grabbed the rebound with 1.2 seconds left. Warren hit both free throws for the LSU win.

Against Rutgers, LSU was down five with 7:01 to play and allowed just two Rutgers points the rest of the way ... Those points came after LSU had taken a 49-48 lead on a Hickey jumper with 1:20 to play ... Rutgers made two free throws to take a 50-49 lead 15 seconds later, but Hickey got inside and one game after having his layup attempt knocked away, drove back inside and scored to give LSU the lead for good, 51-50. Rutgers would turn the ball over on a charge and on the inbounds, Hickey found Johnny O'Bryant for a dunk with 12 seconds left to make it a three-point game.

Those two road wins marked the first time LSU had won consecutive road games since February of the 2008-09 season when LSU beat Arkansas and Kentucky. The last time LSU won two road games in the same week period and back-to-back on the schedule came in Feb. 2006 when LSU defeated Auburn on Feb. 18, 2006 and then Vanderbilt on Feb. 22, 2006.

The South Carolina win (2/18) marked the first SEC road win for LSU and LSU's fourth road win surpassed last year's total of three ... Trent Johnson is now 13-26 on opponent's home courts ... With the three neutral court games in Charleston, LSU is 6-8 this year away from the Maravich Center.

Game No. 400 For Coach J A Win

The Arkansas game (2/4) marked Coach Trent Johnson's 400th game in his 13-year career as a head coach ... The LSU mentor, in his fourth year as head coach in Baton Rouge, also coached five years at Nevada and four years as the head coach at Stanford before being named LSU's 20th head coach.

He was 79-74 in five years at Nevada with one Western Athletic Conference title and NIT appearance and an NCAA Sweet 16 showing ... After that at Stanford in the Pac-10, the Cardinal was 80-47 with one NIT appearance and three NCAA appearances, including a Sweet 16 showing ... At LSU presently in his fourth year, he is 66-60 with one SEC title and an NCAA Tournament second round appearance.

He has won Coach of the Year honors in all three leagues and enters the weekend with an overall record of 225-181.

Against Ranked Teams

The Tigers are 1-5 this season against ranked teams, defeating No. 10 Marquette on Dec. 19, 67-59, and losing to 21st-ranked Virginia on Jan. 2, 57-52, #17 Florida (1/21), 76-64; a 76-71 loss to #18 Mississippi State and the 74-50 loss to No. 1 Kentucky ... LSU is 2-17 in the Trent Johnson era against ranked teams ... The other win before Marquette came against nationally-ranked Butler in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament ... LSU is 60-231 all-time against ranked teams in the AP poll since it started in 1948-49.

LSU beat Mississippi State (2/14), but the Bulldogs were ranked only in the ESPN/USA Today poll at No. 23 and just receiving votes in the AP poll.

Tennessee Information

Tennessee comes to Baton Rouge on a roll, having won six of its last seven games, including wins last week at home against Ole Miss and a 73-64 win at South Carolina on Saturday ... Tennessee shot 52.2 percent for the game, 14-of-28 in the first half and 10-of-18 in the second half ... The Vols were also 7-of-14 from the arc and 18-of-25 from the free throw line, outrebounding South Carolina, 38-32 ... Trae Golden had 21 points with three treys and 8-9 at the FT line ... Jordan McRae off the bench added 16 and Jeronne Maymon scored 14.

Cuonzo Martin is in his first year at Tennessee after three seasons at Missouri State. .

The Students Said It; Vests Getting Good Reviews

It started as a chant and then it became a hash tag on Twitter but as Coach Johnson was being interviewed on Cox Sports TV after the Boise game (12/10), the Maravich Maniacs began chanting, "Fear The Vest!" ... So far the Tigers have won five times with the coaches wearing white, four times in purple, three times each in grey and black and twice in brown ... It's not a fashion statement or a trend that Coach Johnson and his staff are trying to make to the rest of the league, just as Coach Johnson has often said, a comfort statement and who can argue with that.

Gold Is Good

The Tigers have three sets of uniforms, white, purple and gold, but Coach Johnson has primarily used the white and purple almost exclusively since he arrived here at LSU ... The gold jersey made one appearance on Feb. 1, 2009 in the 100th anniversary game at the PMAC and one other appearance in the last couple of seasons, but they were in the equipment lockers until brought out for the "Gold" Game against Alabama (2/11) when everyone was asked to wear gold ... LSU won ... Surprisingly, when the team came out the next Tuesday against Mississippi State (2/14), the Tigers were wearing the gold jerseys once again and the Tigers won ... The fans asked on his talk show and Coach Johnson brought out the Gold again against Georgia (2/22) and the result was another LSU victory.

Depth Back; Contributions Coming From All Classes

The LSU program has something it hasn't had to this magnitude in several years - depth. Each class has three players on the present 12-man roster.

Several times that depth has been important to the success of the season ... In the Boise game (12/10) when one starter at off-guard and another top reserve guard did not dress for the contest. But LSU was able to attack the game from a bit of a different direction and was able to sustain its defense in the process.

Again against Ole Miss (1/7), two forwards were out (one with injury, another bereavement), but LSU responded with strong performances on the perimeter and inside to easily win its conference opener.

In the Arkansas game (2/4), eight players scored and only one of those eight played less than 17 minutes.

The other main benefit of having depth this year is that LSU has been able to sustain most of the games through the entire 40 minutes, something that LSU was unable to do in the past couple of years.

Through 27 games, there is a remarkable balance in the scoring of the team, especially with the freshman and sophomores ... The freshman have scored 28.1 percent of the points and sophomores 28.8 percent ... With Hamilton coming on strong in SEC play, the juniors represent now 23.8 percent

of LSU's scoring ... The three senior players account for 19.3 percent of the scoring.

Consider the fact the seniors are contributing over 19 percent with primarily all three players coming off the bench for the majority of the season.

Freshmen have led LSU in scoring five times (Hickey 3, O'Bryant III 2), sophomores 11 times (Stringer 6, Turner 4, Courtney 1), junior nine times (Hamilton) and a senior three times (Warren).

One of the aspects that has been important for this team is everyone appears to know their roles and has accepted those roles in the team concepts ... It was those three seniors (Warren, White and Bass) that came off the bench with LSU down 13-0 to Marquette (12/19) who came in and slowly began the march back that led LSU to the win ... It was the four post players at North Texas (12/22) who were all in double figures (Warren, White, O'Bryant, Hamilton) that played a big part in that win ... Again, it was the seniors coming off the bench that helped get LSU jumped started from a 30-13 deficit against Mississippi State (2/14).

Ralston Turner Dec. 26 SEC Player of Week; First Since March 2009; Helping Tigers In SEC Play

The Southeastern Conference selected sophomore guard Ralston Turner as its Player of the Week (12/26) ... It marked the first time an LSU player was named Player of the Week by the league since March 2009 ... Turner helped LSU to wins at home against previously undefeated 10th-ranked Marquette 67-59 (Dec. 19) and then at North Texas (Dec. 22) ... Highlighting the week, Turner had the second highest scoring game of his career in the win over Marquette, hitting 4-of-5 shots from the arc, scoring 22 points against the Golden Eagles.

Turner struggled to get the same good shots to go down in the first three league games as he was just 4-of-24 from the field. But he knew that things were going to change his way by not changing and he came out and hit his first two three-pointers against Auburn and finished 4-of-9 from the field (3-7 from the arc) with 11 points in 25 minutes.

Against Mississippi State (2/14), Turner hit 6-of-13 field goal attempts, to lead the Tigers with 17 points in 38 minutes and followed it with 3-of-4 from the arc in a nine-point, two-assist outing in the win at South Carolina (2/18).

Overall, he is averaging 8.9 points per game (fourth on the team) and he is making 35.4 percent from the arc (40-of-113) ... He has 88 career treys and averages 29.1 minutes per game.

Hamilton Earns SEC POW Jan. 9; Just Keeps Going

The junior transfer from Iowa State showed no ill effects of the one-year transfer rule that kept him off the competitive court and is proving to be one of the better big men to transfer in to LSU in recent years ... He was over 20 points in both games against Virginia (1/2) and Ole Miss (1/7) that earned him LSU's second SEC POW of the season ... Here are the numbers:

Vs. Virginia - 36 minutes, 9-of-14 FG, 3-6 FT, 4 blks, 2 stls, 21 points-9 rebounds
Vs. Ole Miss - 29 minutes, 9-of-12 FG, 5-6 FT, 2 blks, 1 stl, 23 points-16 rebounds
Totals - 65 minutes - 18-of-26 FG, 8-12 FT, 6 blks, 3 stls, 44 points-25 rebounds

In two of LSU's road league games, he has also been strong, topping 20 points at Arkansas (1/14) and at Florida (1/21):

At Arkansas - 28 minutes, 8-of-17 FG, 4-7 FT, 3 blks, 20 pts-8 rebounds
At Florida - 38 minutes, 13-of-22 FG, 1-1 3FG, 1 ast, 27 pts-8 rebounds

In the second half against Arkansas, Hamilton had 17 points and at Florida he had 18 of his points in the final 20 minutes ... He had a seven consecutive double figure scoring game streak stopped against UK and that equaled the longest streak of recent times that Storm Warren had late in the 2011 season ... His 13 made field goals against Florida marked the second most FGs for an LSU player in the Trent Johnson era, topped only by the 15 that Tasmin Mitchell made against Auburn in 2010 ... The last player to top 25 points before Hamilton did against Florida was Bo Spencer who had 26 against Auburn on Feb. 27, 2010.

Since the Kentucky game, Hamilton had another five-game double figure scoring streak highlighted by back-to-back double double games with 13 points, 11 rebounds vs. Arkansas (2/4) and 10 points and 11 boards against Vandy (2/8) ... Versus Alabama (2/11), he hit 9-of-12 field goals in a 21-point effort ... He had 18 points in the win against South Carolina (2/18).

Hamilton in the last two games has seen the defenses clamp down as Georgia and Ole Miss held him to 2-of-9 shooting from the field and just nine total points ... Hamilton was inexplicably 0-3 at the line in the Ole Miss game.

Hamilton has had double figure points in 11 of the 14 SEC games ... He was 8-of-8 from the free throw line against South Carolina and in the five games prior to Ole Miss he was 24-of-25 from the stripe.

Hamilton is now averaging 13.2 points per game and 7.2 rebounds ... Since the start of 2012, Hamilton's scoring average has gone up from 11.6 to 13.2 points per game ... He is averaging 14.1 points per game in league play.

Andre Stringer, Second In Scoring

Andre Stringer was in good form in the Georgia win, hitting 6-of-12 field goal attempts, includ-

ing equaling his career best of four treys in an 18-point effort. He also had two assists and no turnovers in 34 minutes of play. His 10 points at Ole Miss made it four games in the last five he has been in double figures.

Andre Stringer also put together a strong game against Alabama (2/11) at the Maravich Center, as he hit 5-of-11 field goal attempts for 15 points in 35 minutes ... It was his best effort since coming off the bench at Mississippi State (1/25) when he had 17 points.

Earlier in December, Stringer missed five games after fainting in practice prior to the Boise State game (12/10) ... He returned and played 24 minutes against Virginia (1/2).

Stringer is one of the best at the free throw line, making 52-of-62 for 83.9 percent.

The sophomore is averaging 10.4 points per game, second on the team ... At Vandy (2/8), Stringer had five assists and just one turnover in 28 minutes and 5 assists and just two turnovers vs. Mississippi State (2/14) ... Stringer's double figure game versus Alabama (2/11) was his 10th of the season.

Last year, Stringer averaged 11.2 points per game.

Hickey All-Tournament Last Time in South Carolina, At Charleston

LSU finished the Nov. 17-20 Charleston Classic with a 2-1 record as LSU defeated Western Kentucky, 76-57, and Georgia Tech, 59-50, after an 88-82 first-round loss versus Northwestern. In the process, point guard Anthony Hickey was named to the five-member all-tournament team after averaging 16 points for the three games, hitting over 51 percent of his field goal attempts (19-of-37), making six treys and averaging 4.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

After getting 17 against Western Kentucky, Hickey clinched the spot in the fifth place game against Georgia Tech ... Hickey had 20 points, including four treys. LSU led by four at the half and the game remained close until LSU went on a 9-4 run in which Hickey, Ralston Turner and Andre Stringer all hit threes to put LSU up for good.

Hickey Backing Up Mr. Basketball Title

Kentucky's Mr. Basketball has shown his worth to the LSU Tigers, averaging 9.1 points per game, 3.7 rebounds and 3.8 assists ... More importantly, he has a positive assist-to-turnover ratio of 105 assists to 53 turnovers (2.0, third in the league) ... In SEC games, Hickey has 50 assists and 24 turnovers, a 2.1 ratio, and that is third in the league game only stats ... He also is third in the SEC with 58 steals (2.1 average) and is sixth in assists ... Despite having to come off the bench as a penalty for missing a team video session, Hickey responded with the second best scoring game of his career in the Auburn win (1/17) getting 18 points with a season high tying seven rebounds ... He also had six assists and just one turnover in 39 minutes of play ... He made 6-of-12 field goal attempts, including two treys ... At Florida, he was in double figures again with 10 points with two assists and no turnovers.

At Mississippi State, he led an LSU charge in the final two minutes with three treys as LSU came from nine back to within a point in the final few seconds. Hickey finished with 16 points on 6-of-12 shooting, 4-of-7 from the arc with six assists and three steals ... In the rematch in Baton Rouge, while held in somewhat in check before hitting his 8-foot floater in the lane with 1.4 seconds to play to give the Tigers the two-point overtime victory.

On the road at South Carolina (2/18), Hickey had his best road game in assists as he recorded seven, the second time in SEC play he has matched that number (Ole Miss, 1/7).

Hickey has had 15 games of four assists or more ... He has had three steals or more in 14 games ... Among freshman he leads the league in steals and is second in assists.

McDonald's All-American O'Bryant Has Had Good Return

Johnny O'Bryant III has shown no ill effects since his return from the broken bone he suffered in his left hand on Jan. 4 that forced him to miss the first part of the SEC schedule.

He missed the first five conference games, returning at Mississippi State (1/25) as O'Bryant played 20 minutes with six points and four rebounds ... He returned to the starting lineup against Kentucky (1/28), leading the team with 12 points and nine rebounds in 28 minutes.

In the Arkansas win (2/4), O'Bryant had 8 points and 11 rebounds with two blocks in 23 minutes.

But his best game back came vs. Alabama (2/11) when he hit 5-of-9 field goal attempts for 17 points, nine rebounds and a season best three assists. Against Georgia (2/22), he hit 5-of-10 field goals in a 14-point night in 24 minutes.

Before breaking his hand, O'Bryant III came up big earlier in Charleston Classic in the Northwestern game (11/17) when he hit 6-of-8 field goal attempts in 22 minutes and made 9-of-11 at the free throw line in a 21 point effort. O'Bryant III also had a team high eight boards.

Against South Alabama (11/23), O'Bryant III led the team in rebounds for the second time this season with eight ... He started his first college game against Houston and tied for team rebound lead with seven, five of which were offensive ... He posted 11 points at Rutgers (12/3) and 10 points in the Boise State game (12/10) ... Just like the Houston game, O'Bryant had seven boards against UCI (12/15), but five were offensive ... He recorded his first college double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds at North Texas (12/22) ... He equaled that 11 board total at Ole Miss (2/25).

Warren Adding On To Milestones Of 500-100-100; One Of Just Three At LSU To Have Those Numbers

LSU senior Storm Warren, who moved back into the starting lineup for O'Bryant against Ole Miss (1/7) and started six games in this stretch, had a double double in the Ole Miss win, although it was slightly overshadowed by the performance of Justin Hamilton ... But Warren's double double was just as important as he had 15 points and 11 rebounds (six offensive) ... He recorded his second double double of the season against Mississippi State (2/14) with 10 points and 11 rebounds, giving him 13 double ups for his career.

The Monroe, La., native continued putting special notes on his career and the most prominent came with 14:15 to go in the first half when he pulled down the first of his six rebounds against Grambling (12/29) to make him the 37th LSU player to have 500 career rebounds ... Against Boise State (12/10), he blocked the 100th shot of his career ... He became the eighth player and first since Garrett Temple in 2009 to reach triple figures in blocks ... He also in the month of December became the 22nd LSU player to record 100 career steals.

He becomes just the third LSU player since 1990 to record 500 rebounds-100 blocks-100 steals in a career, joining Shaquille O'Neal (1989-92) and Garrett Temple (2005-09) ... He was a freshman on the 2009 SEC Championship team under Coach Trent Johnson.

Warren is averaging 8.3 points and 5.0 rebounds ... He returned to the starting lineup at South Carolina (2/18), scoring 12 points in 25 minutes, the 12th double figure scoring game of the year ... At Vandy (2/8), he led the team in scoring for the second time this year with 13 on a night when he made 6-of-8 field goal attempts and had 13 to lead the team in the loss at Ole Miss (2/25).

Chris Bass - Off The Bench To The Point

Senior Chris Bass, the brother of NBA star and former SEC Player of the Year Brandon Bass, has been using his minutes very well to help LSU when he goes in either in place of/or with Anthony Hickey in the LSU offense ... Bass, who has had a positive assist-to-turnover ratio each of his first three seasons, is well on his way to making it four straight years with 45 assists and 28 turnovers this year ... For his career, Bass has 263 assists and 123 turnovers (2.17 assist-to-turnover ratio for his career) ... Plus, while never thought of as a scoring threat, he is coming up this year with good decisions and a score or two in several consecutive games for the Tigers, including two three pointers against Mississippi State (1/25) ... Bass is averaging 13.1 minutes per game ... The Baton Rouge native is 16-of-35 from the field this year (5-12 from the arc), averaging 1.7 points per game.

Eddie Ludwig

It was Eddie Ludwig, the junior from Metairie, who had to step into the Andre Stringer position in the starting five when he went down ... For the game against Boise State (12/10) he responded with a big time effort of 33 minutes ... While he only scored two points, he did have a career high of nine rebounds, an assist and a block and was part of the defensive effort against leading Boise scorer Anthony Drmic, who came in averaging 15 points a game and was held scoreless.

Against UCI (12/15), Ludwig came through as a scorer, equaling his career high of 12 points in 24 minutes ... In those two games, Ludwig played 57 minutes, was 5-of-11 from the field, 2-of-7 from the arc, 2-2 FT, 14 reb, 2 assists, 2 blocks and 14 points.

After starting the two previous games, Ludwig came off the bench against Arkansas (2/4) and equaled his career high of 12 with an impressive 17 minute performance ... Ludwig hit 4-of-6 field goals, including his only trey attempt, while hitting 3-of-3 free throws with four rebounds and two assists.

For the season, Ludwig is averaging 2.3 points and 2.0 rebounds.

Malcolm White

The senior made a couple of big plays in the Mississippi State win (2/14), both offensive and defensively in the 13 minutes he was in the contest ... He hit 2-of-3 field goal attempts and had a steal in the game as he scored four points ... He was 2-of-2 from the field against Georgia last Wednesday and had five points in 11 minutes ... He is averaging 3.2 points per game and 2.1 rebounds a contest.

John Isaac

The team's other freshman has had some good point totals against some important teams this year, most notably six points in the Alabama win (2/11) ... He also had six points in the league opener against Ole Miss and seven in the Tigers win over No. 10 Marquette in non-conference play ... He is averaging 14.8 minutes a game and is proving to be a tenacious defender, while averaging 2.7 points per game and 1.3 rebounds a game.

50 Percent or Better

LSU topped 50 percent from the field against both Boise and Marquette and for the Trent Johnson years at LSU, the Tigers are 12-0 when they shoot 50 percent from the floor.

While LSU overall is 10th in the league in shooting percentage at 40.8 percent, the LSU

defense has allowed the Tigers to still have success, holding opponents to 41.2 percent (4th in SEC) ... The Tigers are ninth in three-point percentage (31.4 percent) but second in three-point field goal percentage defense (31.5 percent).

Morgan has garnered national recognition from the recruiting sites, ranking No. 75 overall in The Rivals 150 for the class of 2012. The four-star prospect is also ranked 11th in the country at the shooting guard position.

This past year Morgan averaged 28.9 points a game, including a career-high 52 points in one game against Riverside. He also averaged nine rebounds, two steals and two assists a game.

Morgan's mother, the former Detra Brown, was a four-year letter-winner in volleyball while at LSU where she was twice an All-SEC selection.

SEC Tournament Tiebreakers

Teams should be seeded No. 1 through No. 12 in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season SEC standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive a "bye" on the first day of the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament.

1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.

B. Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).

C. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more). When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used.

A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 ... Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).

C. If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

D. If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.
