SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU wraps up a five-game road swing and travels to Nicholls State for a Wednesday tilt at 6 p.m. in the Colonel Softball Complex. It marks the Tigers first mid-week road contest of the 2012 season.
- ▶ LSU has won 22 of its previous 23 meeting with the Colonels, including all eight games played in Thibodaux. The Tigers won all three meetings by a 27-2 margin last season.
- ▶ Meghan Patterson picked up two of the three wins in the circle for LSU over Nicholls State. A complete recap and game box scores from the 2011 meetings can be found on pages 6 & 7.
- ▶ LSU is coming off a 1-3 weekend against No. 8 Oklahoma and No. 23 Oklahoma State, a pair of 2011 Women's College World Series squads.
- ▶ Going back to the 2006 season, LSU has been ranked in 87 of the last 93 editions of the *USA Today/NFCA* Top 25 polls. The Tigers are unranked in this week's editions of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- LSU had its season-long six-game winning streak come to a close against No. 8 Oklahoma last Friday and carry a 10-7 record into Wednesday's contest against Nicholls State.
- As a team, LSU is hitting .295 during its 10 wins compared to a .153 ratio in its seven losses. In those 10 wins, the Tigers also have outscored their opponents by a 57-8 margin sparked by eight shutouts.
- After battling an injury and appearing in only three games in 2011, Ashley Applegate has started 16 of 17 games this season.
- Applegate has collected hits in six of her last 10 games [Feb. 19-26] from the top of the batting order. Her 10 hits are tied for third on the team.
- Allison Falcon has hit in the No. 2 hole during her last four appearances (Feb. 12-21) after starting the season at the bottom of the lineup. She has garnered a team-leading .455 batting average on 10 hits but missed LSU's eight games due to injury.
- All 10 of Falcon's hit have come on her current career-long six-game hitting streak (Feb. 12-21). During the streak, she has three multi-hit performances and picked up RBIs in her last four games.
- Simone Heyward has already found herself in four different positions in the lineup on the young season. She had been filling in for Falcon in the No. 2 slot at the Tiger Invitational (Feb. 25-26), but has missed LSU's last four games due to injury.
- Heyward has scored seven times, including her four of her last seven games (Feb. 19-26). During her career, LSU is 29-4 when she crosses the plate.
- Ashley Langoni has contributed two of LSU's four home runs and banded home a team-leading 10 RBIs on the season.
- Langoni is one of nine players in program history to blast 25 career homers. With her next longball, Langoni will tie Stephanie Hill (2003-06) and Anissa Young (2009-11) for seventh place on LSU's all-time list.
- Juliana Santos has notched hits in 11 of her 17 appearances en route to a team-best 12 hits. Her seven RBIs are second on the team.

- Santos has already garnered a four-game hitting streak (Feb. 11-18) and a pair of three-game stretches (Feb. 19-25) & (March 3-4).
- Dylan Supak has produced hits in five of her eight starts at first base. She went 1-for-3 with a double and scored a run during LSU's 7-4 victory over No. 23 Oklahoma State (March 3).
- Rikki Alcaraz has tallied a hit in seven of her 12 games when she is the starting second baseman. She had a five-game streak (Feb. 21-26) come to a close at No. 8 Oklahoma (March 2).
- Alcaraz has drawn five walks over her last three outings (March 3-4) and scored two runs during LSU's 7-4 win over No. 23 Oklahoma State (March 3).
- Kailey McCasland has made five starts at designated player and four starts at third base.
- McCasland belted her first career home run and claimed a 2-for-2 effort with two runs scored to go along with three RBIs during LSU's 7-4 win over No. 23 Oklahoma State (Feb. 23)
- Morgan Russell has added two multi-hit and two multi RBI performances on the season. She contributed both of LSU's RBIs highlighted by a sixth-inning solo home run during a 2-0 win over McNeese State (Feb. 25).
- In her seven starts at catcher, Lauren Houston has reached base in five of those contests. She has compiled a .308 batting average and .524 on-base percentage.
- Houston notched a 2-for-2 effort with a RBI in LSU's 7-4 victory over No. 23 Oklahoma State (March 3).
- Cassie Troclair made her season debut at the Tiger Invitational. In her first game, she ripped a RBI-double which proved to be the game-winning run in a 5-4 win over South Alabama (Feb. 25).
- Troclair also deposited a two-out, two-run single to cap a four-run second inning during LSU's 7-4 win over No. 23 Oklahoma State (March 3).
- Jacee Blades is 2-for-3 with a pair of singles as a pinch hitter. The rest of the LSU team is 0-for-12.

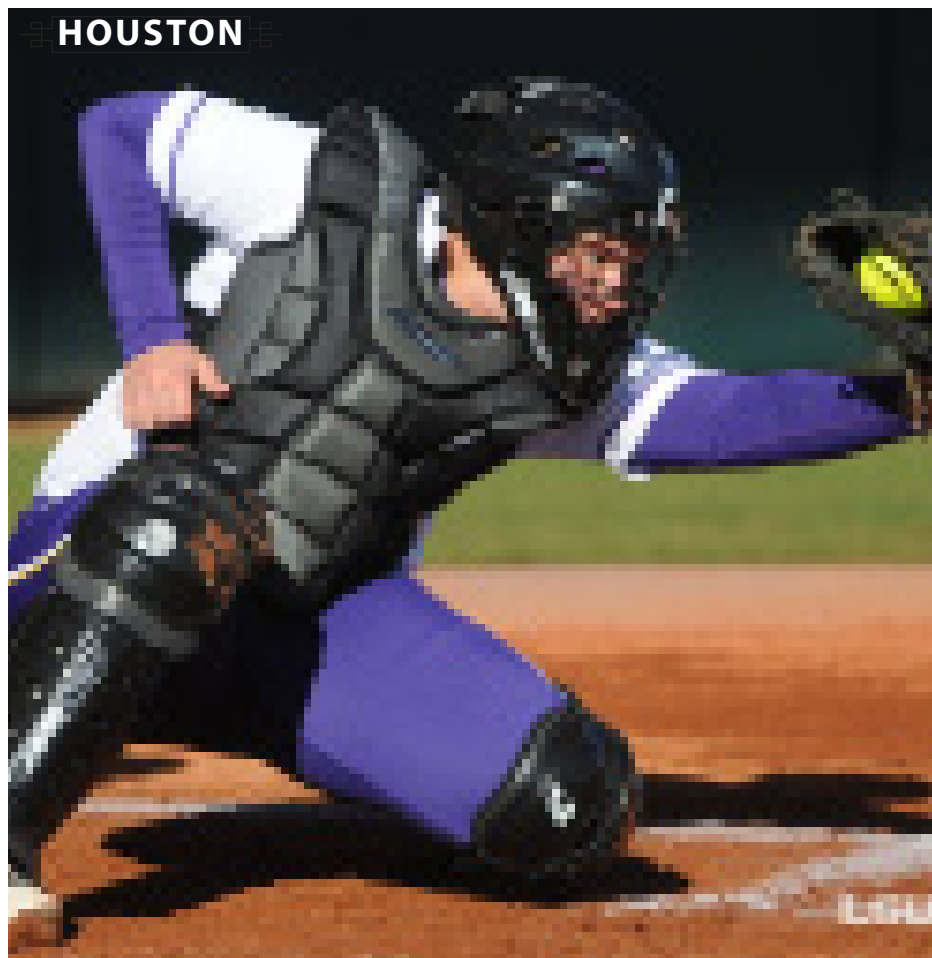

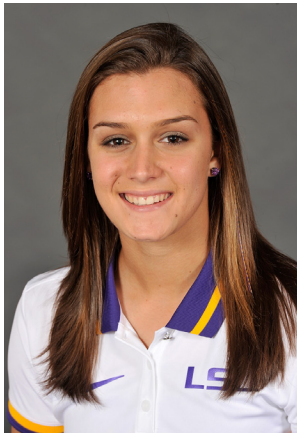

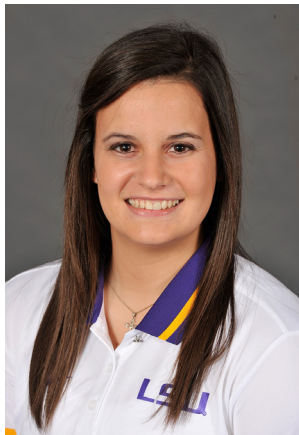
