SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU finishes its opening week of SEC play and welcomes Mississippi State to Tiger Park for a three-game weekend series.
- ▶ Friday's opener is Teacher Appreciation Night at the ballpark where the Tigers will recognize some of their favorite faculty members pregame.
- ▶ LSU will honor 18 former Alumnae leading into Saturday's middle game. The first 1,000 fans will receive a LSU drawstring bag and green K cards.
- ▶ LSU holds a 42-5 edge in the all-time series with Mississippi State, including a 17-game winning streak going back to 2005.
- ▶ Brittany Mack picked up all three wins during the 2011 season series in Starkville. Complete recaps and box scores of those games are available on pages 6-8 in the notes packet.
- ▶ Going back to the 2006 season, LSU has been ranked in 87 of the last 94 editions of the *USA Today/NFCA* Top 25 polls. The Tigers are unranked in this week's editions of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- LSU has won 13 of its last 16 games highlighted by a pair of six-game winning streaks [Feb. 19-26 and March 7-14] dating back to Feb. 19.
- LSU will carry a 16-8 overall record and 1-1 SEC mark into this weekend's series with Mississippi State.
- As a team, LSU is hitting .313 during its 16 wins compared to a .140 ratio in its eight losses. In those 16 wins, the Tigers also have outscored their opponents by a 96-14 margin sparked by 11 shutouts.
- After battling an injury and appearing in only three games in 2011, Ashley Applegate has started 23 of 24 games this season.
- As LSU's leadoff hitter, Applegate has recorded hits in her last four of her last five games [March 9-14]. She collected her first RBI of the season versus Mississippi Valley State [March 10].
- Allison Falcon has hit in the No. 2 hole during her last 10 of her last 11 appearances (Feb. 12-March 14) after starting the season at the bottom of the lineup. She missed an eight-game stretch (Feb. 25-March 4) due to injury.
- Falcon has garnered a .325 batting average. Her 10 RBIs are second on the team. She added a two-out RBI single during LSU's three-run fifth inning in game one against Auburn [March 14].
- Falcon belted her first home run of the season, a two-run shot, during LSU's 6-3 victory over Troy (March 9).
- Simone Heyward has already found herself in four different positions in the lineup on the young season.
- Heyward had been filling in for Falcon in the No. 2 slot at the Tiger

- Invitational (Feb. 25-26), but has missed LSU's last 11 games due to injury.
- Heyward has scored seven times, including her four of her last seven games (Feb. 19-26). During her career, LSU is 29-4 when she crosses the plate.
- Ashley Langoni has contributed three of LSU's seven home runs and banded home a team-leading 17 RBIs on the season.
- Langoni has collected 26 career dingers. She is tied with former All-American Stephanie Hill (2003-06) and Anissa Young (2009-11) for seventh place on LSU's all-time list.
- Langoni has produced hits in six of her last nine outings (March 3-14) fueled by five multi-hit efforts. During the run, she has raised her batting average by 120 points to a .333 clip.
- Langoni contributed a two-out, RBI double during LSU's three-run fifth inning in game one versus Auburn (March 14).
- Juliana Santos has notched hits in 15 of her 21 appearances, including seven of her last eight outings (March 3-14).
- Santos has recorded 18 hits to rank second on the team. She also has chipped in nine RBIs and broke a 10-game stretch without a RBI during a 3-for-3 performance in game one versus Auburn (March 14).
- Santos has already garnered a pair of four-game hitting streaks (Feb. 11-18) & (March 9-14) and three-game runs (Feb. 19-25) & (March 3-4).
- Dylan Supak has produced hits in nine of her 15 starts on the season, including five of her last eight appearances (March 4-14).

STARKVILLE, Miss. - With two runners on and no outs, Rachele Fico moved down three consecutive batters as the No. 21 LSU softball team notched a dramatic 4-2 victory over Mississippi State to open a SEC series at the MSU Softball Field.

Fico struck out Heidi Shape, Chelsea Raines and Jessica Cooley in succession to strand the tying run in scoring position. It was Fico's first save of the season and sixth of her career.

Brittany Mack fired the first six-plus frames and sprayed two runs on eight hits. The junior right-hander racked up 11 strikeouts against three walks to move to 14-5. It was the fifth time this season that Mack reached double-digit Ks. She started the seventh with a hit batter and a walk before giving way to Fico.

The Mack-Fico duo stranded 12 MSU base runners, eight in scoring position as LSU (33-15, 14-9 SEC) notched its seventh straight win and has won 18 of its last 21 games dating back to March 19.

"We're very fortunate and a little lucky to escape with this road win," head coach Yvette Girouard said. "Mack held on long enough. Although she had 11 Ks, I didn't think she was as sharp as she's been, but credit her for making big pitches when they had scoring opportunities. It's a great change-of-pace because Mack is such an off-speed pitcher and then Fico comes in throwing BB's out of the pen. The two of them are a phenomenal tandem."

LSU manufactured a pair of runs during the third and fourth innings to grab a 2-0 edge. In the third, Jacee Blades coaxed a leadoff walk followed by consecutive infield singles by Tiffany Shaw and Simone Heyward to fill the bases. Juliana Santos picked up the first of two sacrifice flies for the game's first run.

The Tigers struck for some two-out lightning in the fourth. Morgan Russell was hit-by-a-pitch, while Blades and Shaw loaded the bags with back-to-back infield base knocks. LSU took advantage of a Raines fielding error at third base to make it 2-0.

"Coach Girouard keeps telling us that every game counts," Heyward said. "We know we have to have focused at-bats to win games. We swung at good pitchers and for the most part we were able to stay off the junk. That's why we were successful tonight."

Mack worked her way out of trouble and stranded multiple runners on the base paths during the first four frames. The Bulldogs (23-27, 9-14 SEC) had a bases loaded threat of their own in the fourth, but Santos made a spectacular play on a slow ground ball off the bat of Kaili Smith to extinguish the threat.

MSU broke through for two runs in the fifth inning to tie the score. With two outs and a runner on second, Raines collected a bloop RBI double to left field. The next batter, Jessica Cooley, cranked a RBI triple off the right field wall for the equalizer.

Mack fired back and received a pop out to keep the tally at 2-2. The runs ended LSU's stretch of 41 consecutive innings without allowing a run.

LSU seized the momentum right back during the sixth inning. Once again, the bottom of the lineup set the table as Lauren Houston smacked a single, Russell was plunked and Shaw drew a walk. On a 0-1 offering, Heyward slapped an infield single to vault the Tigers back to a 3-2 lead. Santos knocked another sacrifice fly for the final margin of 4-2.

"It's a statement when you can come back and answer," Girouard said. "When you don't answer, you worry about your team losing the momentum. It was big for us to get the momentum right back after they scored."

LSU finished the contest with 10 hits sparked by a trio of two-hit efforts from Heyward, Shaw and Anissa Young. It marked the seventh time this season that the Tigers have belted double figure hits.

STARKVILLE, Miss. - Tammy Wray cranked a RBI double with two on and two out during the sixth inning, while Brittany Mack retired seven on the last eight batters she faced to vault the No. 21 LSU softball team to a 7-6 comeback victory over Mississippi State at the MSU Softball Field.

Ahead of Wray, Anissa Young and Ashley Langoni drew back-to-back walks to extend the frame. The Somers, N.Y., native put a 0-for-3 day in the rearview mirror and belted a 2-1 offering down the left field line to plate Young for the go-ahead run.

"I told Tammy that she had to keep battling at the plate," head coach Yvette Girouard said. "It certainly was a team effort today. Offensively, I thought we did a lot of things well. We pushed runners into scoring position, got timely hits and the slappers were on-base to manufacture a lot of runs. It's been the pitching that has carried us for most of the season, but we ran into a buzz saw today. There were times where we couldn't find the plate, but kudos to the offense for coming through."

Mack tossed 3.2 frames of two-hit relief sparked by six strikeouts. She struck out the side around a one-out single during the seventh inning to secure the 7-6 triumph and notch her 15th win of the season.

The Tigers (34-15, 15-9 SEC) moved their winning streak to eight games and have won 19 of their last 22 outings dating back to March 19. It also marked LSU's 16th straight series win over the Bulldogs (23-28, 9-15 SEC) dating back to the 2005 season.

LSU carried a 5-1 advantage into the fourth inning before Mississippi State turned the tables. Jessica Cooley opened the rally with a solo home run to right field. After Brittany Gates coaxed a walk, the Tigers lifted starter Rachele Fico from the game in favor of Meghan Patterson.

A hit batter and three walks later, MSU pulled back to 5-4. Mack entered the game and Heidi Shape knocked a two-run single past a diving Juliana Santos and Jacee Blades through the middle to hand the Bulldogs a 6-5 edge. The Tigers alertly cut a runner down behind the play at second base and received a ground out to escape the inning.

"Mack did a phenomenal job of shutting the door," Girouard said. "She came in under a tough situation. After a ground ball that had eyes against a drawn in infield, she mowed them down and did an excellent job of matching the pitch counts that I gave her before each inning."

LSU immediately fired back with the equalizer in the fifth inning. Lauren Houston collected a one-out single to right field and moved into scoring position on a Morgan Russell ground ball. On the first pitch of the at-bat, Blades slapped an infield single. Houston scampered home on a throwing error by MSU third baseman Chelsea Raines to even the tally at 6-6.

The Tigers manufactured a run to open the scoring during the first inning. Simone Heyward dropped a leadoff bunt single and advanced to second base on a Santos sacrifice bunt. Young ripped a RBI double into the left centerfield gap to stake LSU to a 1-0 edge.

LSU tacked on an unearned run in the third inning and took advantage of a pair of MSU errors to make it 2-0. The Bulldogs dented the scoreboard during the home half of the frame via a Courtney Nesbit RBI single to make it 2-1.

The Tigers struck for three additional runs in the fourth inning. LSU put runners on the corners with one out and Tiffany Shaw knocked a ground ball to MSU shortstop Ali Bainbridge. She elected to throw home, but pinch runner Alex Boulet used some nifty base running to slide around the tag.

A Bainbridge fielding error scored Shaw before Young connected for a RBI single to plate Heyward after she reached on the miscue for the 5-1 lead.

Blades, Shaw and Young garnered multi-hit performances to fuel LSU's nine-hit attack. For Blades, it moved her hitting streak to a career-best six games.

STARKVILLE, Miss - Anissa Young cranked a two-run home run during the first inning, while Brittany Mack racked up 10 strikeouts to fuel the No. 21 LSU softball team to a 3-1 triumph and a series sweep of Mississippi State at the MSU Softball Field.

In the process, LSU (33-15, 16-9 SEC) won its 20th game during its last 23 outings dating back to March 19. The Tigers also won their 17th straight contest over Mississippi State (23-29, 9-16 SEC) since 2005.

LSU raced out to a 2-0 advantage in the first inning. With one out, Juliana Santos smacked a triple down the left field line. The next batter, Young, connected for a two-run blast over the left centerfield fence on a 1-1 offering. It was Young's team-leading ninth dinger, and 11th multi-RBI performance of the season. The Tigers have gone 15-1 this season when posting a first-inning run.

"We had an offensive plan and executed it the entire weekend," Young said. "It's always good to start the game off with a couple of runs. I know we talk about getting early runs for our pitchers all the time. On the home run, I was trying to see something up in the zone and get a barrel on it. She [MSU pitcher Stephanie Becker] didn't give me much. I just sat back and made good contact."

That would be more than enough run support for Mack, who sat down 18 of the first 22 batters she faced. The junior right-hander was touched up for one run on three hits and recorded 10 strikeouts against one walk to improve to 16-5 on the season. She has picked up at least seven Ks during eight of her last 10 starts going back to April 2.

"It was a phenomenal start to the game for us," head coach Yvette Girouard said. "Juliana really hustled out of the box to get that triple, and Anissa crushed the ball to send a statement right away. Mack threw magnificently, was in total control and got out of a little trouble during that last inning. She did a wonderful job of baffling their hitters for a third straight day. I thought all of her nasty stuff was working and it's extremely tough to hit when it works on all cylinders like that."

The Tigers added an insurance run during the seventh inning. Morgan Russell ripped a leadoff single followed by a Jacee Blades double. Two batters later, Simone Heyward connected for a sacrifice fly to plate pinch runner Cassie Trosclair to make it 3-0.

MSU took advantage of a walk, a single and a wild pitch to send the tying to the plate in the home half of the frame. Chelsea Raines collected a RBI ground out before Mack secured the 3-1 victory with a fly ball.

"That insurance run really helped us," Girouard said. "Like in basketball, you know the home team is going to make a run at some point. I had a feeling that Mississippi State wasn't going to have goose eggs on the board for all seven innings, but Mack made the big pitches to finish them off."

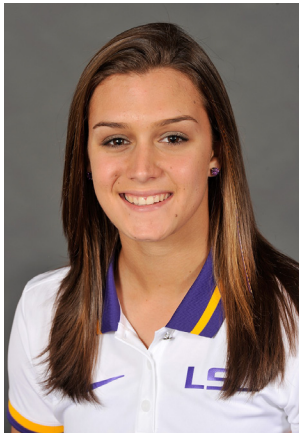

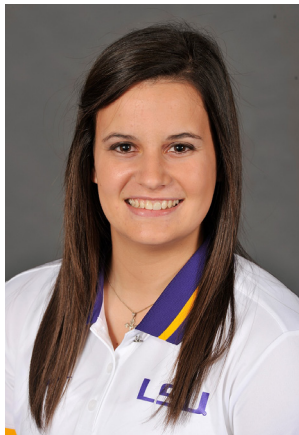
