SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU will ride a five-game winning streak into SEC action where the Tigers will face No. 20 Auburn for a Wednesday doubleheader at 5 p.m. in Tiger Park. It marks the program's annual "Gold Game" along with "Student Point Night."
- ▶ LSU holds a 43-12 series advantage over Auburn and has won 17 of the last 19 meetings going back to the 2006 season.
- ▶ LSU picked up 7-3 and 1-0 victories over Auburn last season as Ashley Langoni and Juliana Santos teamed up for a 7-for-14 performance and added six RBIs.
- ▶ Rachele Fico and Brittany Mack also put together solid pitching performances highlighted by Fico's three-hitter in the second game. Game recaps and box scores of the 2011 season series are available on page six.
- ▶ Going back to the 2006 season, LSU has been ranked in 87 of the last 94 editions of the *USA Today/NFCA* Top 25 polls. The Tigers are unranked in this week's editions of the polls.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- LSU has won 12 of its last 15 games dating back to Feb. 19. The Tigers will carry a 15-7 record and a five-game streak into Wednesday's SEC opener versus No. 20 Auburn.
- LSU and Auburn are the last two teams to open its 2012 SEC seasons after league play began last weekend.
- As a team, LSU is hitting .309 during its 15 wins compared to a .153 ratio in its seven losses. In those 15 wins, the Tigers also have outscored their opponents by a 92-13 margin sparked by 11 shutouts.
- After battling an injury and appearing in only three games in 2011, Ashley Applegate has started 21 of 22 games this season.
- As LSU's leadoff hitter, Applegate has recorded hits in her last three games [March 9-10]. She collected her first RBI of the season versus Mississippi Valley State [March 10].
- Allison Falcon has hit in the No. 2 hole during her last eight of her last nine appearances (Feb. 12-March 10) after starting the season at the bottom of the lineup. She missed an eight-game stretch (Feb. 25-March 4) due to injury.
- Falcon has garnered a .353 batting average. Her 12 hits are tied for fourth on the team.

- Falcon belted her first home run of the season, a two-run shot, during LSU's 6-3 victory over Troy (March 9)
- Simone Heyward has already found herself in four different positions in the lineup on the young season. She had been filling in for Falcon in the No. 2 slot at the Tiger Invitational (Feb. 25-26), but has missed LSU's last nine games due to injury.
- Heyward has scored seven times, including her four of her last seven games (Feb. 19-26). During her career, LSU is 29-4 when she crosses the plate.
- Ashley Langoni has contributed three of LSU's seven home runs and banded home a team-leading 16 RBIs on the season.
- Langoni has collected 26 career dingers. She is tied with former All-American Stephanie Hill (2003-06) and Anissa Young (2009-11) for seventh place on LSU's all-time list.
- Langoni has produced hits in five of her last seven outings (March 3-10) fueled by a quartet of multi-hit efforts. During the run, she has raised her batting average by 105 points to a .316 clip.
- Juliana Santos has notched hits in 13 of her 19 appearances en route to a 14 hits and seven RBIs.

AUBURN, Ala. - Ashley Langoni and Juliana Santos teamed up for a 7-for-14 performance and six RBIs as the No. 23 LSU softball team got back on the winning track with 7-3 and 1-0 triumphs over No. 25 Auburn at Jane B. Moore Field.

With the victories, LSU (28-15, 10-9 SEC) jumped Auburn (32-14, 11-11 SEC) to move into sole possession of second place in the SEC Western Division race. Rachele Fico and Brittany Mack also put together solid pitching performances to earn their 11th wins for the Tigers in the circle.

"Our kids were extremely focused at the plate and our pitchers threw well," head coach Yvette Girouard said. "The players were very confident, loose and mature at the plate. It was great to see Ashley Langoni, Juliana Santos and Tammy Wray swinging the bat aggressively. I was very wary of Auburn. They made a lot of nice plays, but we made a few more to get the wins."

Game One - No. 23 LSU 7, No. 25 Auburn 3

Langoni and Wray provided multi-hit performances to spark the LSU offense as the Tigers took control of the contest behind a five-run third inning.

Tiffany Shaw opened the frame and reached on a fielding error by Auburn pitcher Lauren Schmalz. Santos smacked a RBI double down the right field line to vault LSU to a 1-0 edge. After Anissa Young was hit-by-a-pitch, Langoni cleared the bases with a three-run bomb to centerfield to extend the lead to 4-0. Two batters later, Wray added a solo shot of her own to cap the five-run inning.

LSU pushed it to a 6-0 advantage as Langoni picked up her fourth RBI of the game on a squeeze bunt with two outs.

Auburn drew back to 6-3 after scoring runs during the fifth and sixth innings. Kyndall White connected for a two-run homer followed by a RBI single. With the bases loaded and two outs, Mack dug deep to escape a jam with a ground ball back to the circle.

"Mack was completely in control, but ran into a little trouble towards the end," Girouard said. "She made some great pitches to get herself out of that trouble, and I thought did a phenomenal job of fielding her own position."

LSU tacked on an insurance run in the seventh inning. With runners on the corners and one out, Morgan Russell stole second base. On an errant throw, pitch runner Katie Guillory scampered home for the final margin of 7-3.

Mack went the distance to secure her 11th win of the season to match her total for her freshman campaign. She garnered four strikeouts and was touched up for three runs, two earned, on six hits.

Game 2 - No. 23 LSU 1, No. 25 Auburn 0

Fico tossed a three-hitter and mixed in seven strikeouts to claim her 11th win of the season. She sat down 12 of the first 14 batters she faced and carried a no-hitter into the fourth inning.

With one out in the first inning, Santos cranked a double down the left field line. Two batters later, Langoni ripped a RBI single into the right centerfield gap for the game's only run.

Fico made the run stand up and stranded runners in scoring position during the third, fourth and fifth innings.

Lauren Guzman knocked a leadoff single for Auburn in the seventh inning. On the first pitch of the sequence, Elizabeth Eisterhold's bunt attempt went foul towards the backstop. LSU catcher Lauren Houston made a diving catch and alertly threw down to Santos covering second base. She tossed the ball back first to Jacee Blades for the double play.

"Rachele threw very hard and did a magnificent job of keeping Auburn off balanced," Girouard said. "The double play was huge in that game. Not only did Lauren make a fantastic catch, she made the right decision to throw down because she had the runner caught off the bag."

Santos, Langoni and Simone Heyward provided two hits apiece to fuel LSU's offense.

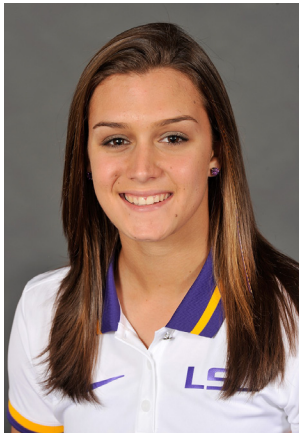

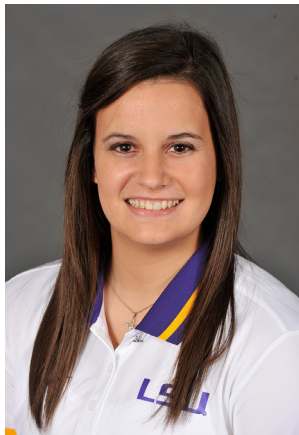
