## LSU Ready to Compete at NCAA Championships

The 11th-ranked LSU gymnastics team is poised to compete in Semifinal I at the NCAA Championships, and the Tigers will fight to get back to the Super Six for the third time in school history. LSU will face UCLA, Oklahoma, Nebraska, Utah and Stanford for the right to advance to the Super Six with a top-three finish in the semifinal. LSU is making its 23rd appearance at nationals in school history, and the Tigers will compete in the afternoon session for the fourth straight appearance. LSU advanced to the Super Six from Semifinal I in 2008 and 2009 and finished sixth in the semifinal in 2010.

### STORYLINES

- LSU is competing in Duluth for the second time this season, scoring a 196.425 at the SEC Championship on March 24. No other team in LSU's session has competed in Gwinnett this season.

# D-D Breaux

## HEAD COACH • 35TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to shine as one of the nation's best programs, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, two Super Sixes in the last four seasons and seven individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2010, LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth-straight year and 22nd time in Breaux's career. Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture NCAA All-Around national title as she became LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 and 2009 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship in 2008. The Tigers finished fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish in program history since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to compete for the national title and one day later Breaux coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the

gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure.

Now entering her 35th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have finished among the nation's top-10 teams 22 times in 34 seasons, placing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 26 separate occasions, winning regional titles nine times in three different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009. Her teams have included eight individual national titles, 106 All-America honors and 45 All-SEC selections.

Additionally, Breaux's Tigers won the inaugural SEC Championship title in 1981 and have gone on to finish second four times and third five other times.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

## NOTEBOOK

### Last Time Out

- LSU used a gutsy 49.100 on beam in the final rotation to clinch a berth in the NCAA Championships with a second-place 196.075 at the NCAA Seattle Regional. Heading into the final rotation, LSU held the slimmest of margins over No. 23 Washington for second place, 146.975-146.950. A spot at nationals would be decided with LSU on beam and Washington on floor, and the Tigers cemented their spot with five straight hit routines after the first gymnast fell.

### NCAA Championship Semifinal I Rotation Draw

- For the first time this postseason LSU will begin the meet on the bye before bars. At both the SEC Championship and NCAA Regional LSU opened on the bye before floor.

### LSU's History at the NCAA Championships

- Since the first year the NCAA sanctioned gymnastics in 1982, LSU has advanced to the NCAA Championships 23 out of 31 years. LSU's highest finish came in 1988 when the Tigers took fourth place. LSU has advanced to the Super Six Finals twice (2008, 2009) since the Super Six format was adopted in 1993. LSU has finished in the top 10 at the NCAA Championships every time except in 1997 when the Tigers placed 12th.

### LSU at the SEC Championship: School Record Four LSU Gymnasts Named All-SEC

- LSU placed fourth at the SEC Championship with a 196.425, the third-highest road score of the season for LSU. Freshman Lloimincia Hall became the third LSU gymnast to win the SEC Floor Exercise title.
- Rheagan Courville, Lloimincia Hall, Jessie Jordan and Ashley Lee earned All-SEC honors this season, the most in a single season in LSU history, surpassing the 1981, 1998 and 2005 squads that placed three gymnasts on the All-SEC teams.
- Courville and Hall are First-Team All-SEC with Courville placing third in the all-around and Hall capturing the Floor Exercise title. Jordan and Lee are Second-Team All-SEC after Jordan finished sixth in the all-around and Lee was second on vault.
- Courville, Hall and Jordan also earned Freshman All-SEC honors, joining sophomore Sarie Morrison as current Tigers who have been named to the Freshman All-SEC team.

### Notables vs. West Virginia

- LSU tied its season high in a 196.850-194.900 victory against West Virginia in the home finale. The Tigers tied the season-high bars score with a 49.225 and posted the second-best floor (49.325) and beam (49.100) scores of the year.

• Freshman Rheagan Courville continued her outstanding gymnastics by matching her season-high all-around total with a 39.500, and she also won the vault title with a 9.925. Lloimincia Hall earned her sixth floor title of the season with a 9.975, making her the only gymnast in the country to score two 9.975's on floor.

### Courville Earns Her Third SEC Freshman of the Week Honor after West Virginia Meet

• Rheagan Courville became the first LSU gymnast to earn three SEC Freshman of the Week honors in one season since the SEC began awarding the honor in 2009. She won the all-around with a 39.500 and the vault with a 9.925, her seventh vault title of the season. She now holds 17 individual titles this season.

### LSU Notables at Iowa

• LSU picked up a solid 196.300 road score at Iowa as the Tigers defeated the Hawkeyes who earned a 195.700. LSU earned the second-best vault score of the year with a 49.375 and the third-highest bars (49.125) and floor (49.150) scores of the season.  
 • Lloimincia Hall won her first vault title with a season-high 9.95, and Sarie Morrison tallied her second-straight bars title with a 9.90. Jessie Jordan finished second in the all-around with a 39.350 and tied her season best on floor with a 9.85. Rheagan Courville placed second on vault (9.925), bars (9.875) and floor (9.875).

### Fifth Annual Etta James Memorial Meet a Huge Success

• For the fifth straight year the LSU gymnastics team and the local community worked together to raise money for former LSU football player and current NFL linebacker Bradie James' Foundation 56 to fight breast cancer in Baton Rouge.  
 • James lost his mother to breast cancer when he was a sophomore at LSU in 2001, and he created Foundation 56 in 2007 to raise awareness and promote screenings and research to fight the disease.  
 • A record \$100,000 was raised this year bringing the 5-year total to more than \$260,000 for Foundation 56 to fight breast cancer in Baton Rouge. Each year the attendance at the Etta James Memorial meet is one of the highest in school history. The first meet had 7,717 in attendance, the highest in school history. 2009 is 2nd (6,170 fans), 2010 is 3rd (5,641) and 2011 is 6th (4,460). This year, 5,159 people attended the meet, ranking 4th in school history.

### Hall Earns Her Second SEC Freshman of the Week Honor

• Lloimincia Hall won SEC Freshman of the Week honors for the second time this season after she captured the all-around title with a 39.425 against North Carolina State. She and Rheagan Courville have both won twice this year.  
 • Hall earned a 9.975 on floor, tying the top score nationally in the event. She became only the 10th gymnast in LSU history to post a 9.975 or higher on floor and the first since Maliah Mathis did it last year against Georgia.

### Notes from North Carolina State Meet

• LSU picked up a solid 196.550 home score in a victory over then 20th-ranked NC State in the Fifth Annual Etta James Memorial Meet in the Maravich Center. The Tigers posted a season-high 49.225 on bars and just missed the season high on floor with a 49.325.  
 • Lloimincia Hall won the all-around with a 39.425 and tied the nation's best score on floor with a 9.975 to win that title as well. Rheagan Courville picked up her team-leading 14th and 15th titles on vault (9.875) and bars (9.90) while Sarie Morrison tied Courville for the bars crown.

### Three All-Arounders in the National Top 25 for the first time since 2007

• Three LSU freshmen appeared in the national top 25 in the initial RQS ranking as Rheagan Courville was No. 8 with a 39.370 RQS, Lloimincia Hall was 14th at 39.250 and Jessie Jordan was 17th at 39.215.  
 • It is the first time three LSU gymnasts were listed in the all-around top 25 at the same time since Feb. 19, 2007 when Kelly Phelan (No. 12), Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (No. 14) and Nicki Butler (No. 16) appeared in the standings.

### LSU in the Rankings

• LSU heads into the NCAA Regional ranked No. 9 in the newest GymInfo rankings with a regional qualifying score of 196.570. The Tigers rank sixth on vault with a 49.345 RQS, 11th on beam with a 49.070 RQS, 10th on floor (49.220) and 14th on bars (49.095).  
 • Individually, Rheagan Courville is No. 3 on vault with a 9.930 RQS, No. 8 in the all-around (39.450), 19th on floor (9.890) and 24th on bars (9.875). Lloimincia Hall is No. 3 on floor (9.930) and 19th in the all-around (39.355). Jessie Jordan is 25th on beam (9.865) and 23rd in the all-around (39.305). Sarie Morrison is 24th on bars (9.875).  
 • LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 164 consecutive polls and 540 straight weeks. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was more than 11 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

### Notes from Alabama Meet

• LSU earned the second-best score of the season with a 196.575 against Alabama, and the Tigers added a season-high 49.350 on floor and a 49.100 on beam, tied for the second-highest score this season in the event.  
 • Rheagan Courville posted a 39.450 to win her second straight all-around title and her third of the season. Lloimincia Hall thrilled the crowd with a season-high 9.95 to win the floor title. Randi Lau had the best meet of her young career with 9.85's on vault and beam and a 9.80 on bars.

### Courville Named SEC Freshman of the Week Again

• Rheagan Courville won SEC Freshman of the Week honors for the second time this season after she captured the all-around title with a 39.450 against Alabama.  
 • She becomes the 1st LSU gymnast since Gloria Johnson in 2009 to be named SEC Fr. of the Week twice in one season.  
 • Courville finished 2nd on VT and FX with 9.90's, and her 9.825's on UB and BB were the 2nd-best for LSU in each event.

### LSU Earns Two Wins at Washington

• LSU picked up its first road victories of the season with a 196.450 in Seattle against Washington (194.975) and Seattle Pacific (190.800). It marked LSU's third straight 196 score, and it's the Tigers 3rd road score of 196 or higher this season.



- LSU tied the season high on floor with a 49.150, and the Tigers also posted the second-best vault (49.375) and beam (49.100) scores of the season.
- Rheagan Courville earned a season-high 39.500 in the all-around to win the title, and she also claimed the vault (9.90) and floor (9.90) crowns as well. Fellow freshman Jessie Jordan set a personal best of 39.400 in the all-around as she won the vault (9.90) and beam (9.875) titles.

### Meet Notes at Florida

- LSU produced a 196.850 in a loss at then No. 4 Florida on Feb. 10. It marked the highest score LSU has ever earned in Gainesville. The Tigers' previous best was a 196.325 in the 2008 dual meet with the Gators.
- It is also LSU's highest team score in a meet since the Tigers tallied a 197.150 on March 12, 2010 against Iowa, and it is LSU's best score against an SEC foe since Feb. 8, 2008 when the Tigers posted a 197.050 to defeat Auburn and West Virginia in a home tri-meet.
- It is the highest score on the road against an SEC opponent since March 2, 2007 when LSU scored a 196.875 at Alabama.
- LSU earned a season-best 49.150 on bars and a 49.350 on beam, the highest beam score in a meet for LSU since 2005.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall scored a 39.450 all-around total, tying Rheagan Courville for the top all-around mark this season for LSU. Courville won the beam title with a 9.925 while Hall tied her season high on floor (9.90) for the third time this season. LSU hit on 23 of 24 routines with 3 scores of 9.90 or higher and 11 of 9.85 or better against Florida.

### LSU Earns Highest Team Beam Total Since 2005 Season

- LSU tallied a 49.350 on beam at Florida, counting Rheagan Courville's 9.925, Lloimincia Hall and Jessie Jordan's 9.875 scores, a 9.85 from Ericka Garcia and a 9.825 by Kaleigh Dickson.
- Not only was the 49.350 a season high, but it also marked the highest team beam total in a meet since March 13, 2005 when LSU scored a 49.550 at Texas Woman's.

### LSU Nabs 49.000 Or Higher on All Four Events at Florida

- LSU tallied a 49.350 on beam, 49.300 on vault, 49.150 on bars and 49.050 on floor at No. 4 Florida. It is the first meet with a 49.0-plus on all four events since Feb. 18, 2011 when LSU did it against Georgia.
- It was also the first time LSU scored a 49.0 or higher in all four events on the road since March 19, 2010 at Centenary, and the first time LSU did it on the road against an SEC opponent since Feb. 13, 2009 at Alabama.

### LSU vs. Kentucky Notes

- LSU earned its second win of the season with a 196.125-195.050 victory against Kentucky.
- The Tigers tallied a season-high 49.150 on floor and scored a 49.200 on vault, 48.925 on bars and 48.850 on beam.
- Freshman Rheagan Courville won four of five individual titles - vault (9.90), bars (9.875), beam (9.925) and the all-around (39.450). Freshman Lloimincia Hall won the floor title with a 9.875 to give LSU a clean sweep of the event titles.

### Courville Wins SEC Freshman of the Week vs. Kentucky

- Courville helped lead No. 14 LSU to a 196.125-195.050 victory over Kentucky by winning four of five individual titles in the meet. She became the first LSU gymnast to win at least four titles in one meet since Susan Jackson won four against Iowa on March 12, 2010.
- Courville won the all-around, vault, bars and beam titles against the Wildcats, setting season highs on beam and the all-around.
- She scored a 9.925 to win the beam title, and her beam score is the highest on the event by any freshman in the SEC this season. It is the first time an LSU freshman scored a 9.925 or higher on beam since Lisa Rennie earned a 9.95 at the SEC Championship on March 20, 2004.

### LSU at Georgia Notes

- LSU made small mistakes that cost the Tigers a chance at a 196 score at No. 7 Georgia as LSU fell 197.250-195.750.
- Freshman Jessie Jordan won the first all-around title of her career with a 39.250, beating teammate Lloimincia Hall by the smallest margin of .025 as both Hall and Georgia's Noel Couch finished with 39.225 scores.
- Hall won her second floor title of the season with a 9.90, and Rheagan Courville posted a 9.95 on vault to win her third vault title of the year.

### Jordan Named SEC Co-Freshman of the Week at Georgia

- Jessie Jordan captured the all-around title with a 39.250 score at No. 7 Georgia, and she set season highs on vault (9.875) and bars (9.750) on the way to her first individual title at LSU.
- Jordan's 39.250 was the highest all-around score by a freshman in the SEC last weekend, beating out teammate Lloimincia Hall who finished .025 behind Jordan for the all-around title at Georgia with a 39.225.
- It also marked the first time an LSU gymnast won the all-around crown away from Baton Rouge since Susan Jackson won the NCAA All-Around title with a 39.625 at the 2010 NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla.

### First Road All-Around Title for a Tiger Since 2010

- Jessie Jordan's all-around title at No. 7 with a 39.250 marked the first time an LSU gymnast won the all-around crown away from Baton Rouge since Susan Jackson won the NCAA All-Around title with a 39.625 at the 2010 NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla. The title was the first of Jordan's young career.

### Freshmen All-Arounders Make LSU History

- For the first time in LSU history three freshmen scored a 39.300 or higher in the all-around when Rheagan Courville (39.375), Lloimincia Hall (39.325) and Jessie Jordan (39.300) accomplished the feat on Jan. 20 at No. 3 Arkansas.
- It also marked the first time that three LSU gymnasts scored a 39.3 or better in a single meet since Feb. 20, 2009 in a tri-meet against North Carolina and Illinois-Chicago in Baton Rouge. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney scored a 39.625, Susan Jackson earned a 39.500 and Staci Schwitkis went 39.350.

- Until this freshmen trio accomplished the feat, the last time three LSU gymnasts went 39.3 or better in an SEC road meet was March 2, 2007 at Alabama when Ashleigh Clare-Kearney scored a 39.500, Kelly Phelan scored a 39.425 and Nicki Butler scored a 39.400.

### LSU Posts a 196.325 in a Loss at No. 3 Arkansas

- LSU earned a season-high 196.325 at No. 3 Arkansas, the highest team score for LSU since the Tigers went 196.350 against Georgia at home last season.
- LSU tallied a 49.500 on vault, the highest vault score since the Tigers went 49.625 in the NCAA Central Regional in 2008.
- The 49.5 is tied for the sixth-best vault score in LSU history.
- All three freshmen all-arounders went 39.300 or better and scored season highs at Arkansas: Rheagan Courville (39.375), Lloimincia Hall (39.325), Jessie Jordan (39.300).

### Hall Earns SEC Freshman of the Week vs. Auburn

- LSU freshman Lloimincia Hall was named SEC Freshman of the Week after scoring a 39.200 and winning the all-around against Auburn. She also shared the floor title with Rheagan Courville as both tallied a 9.90.
- Hall's 39.200 all-around total was the highest total last week by a freshman in the SEC, and it is the highest score for an LSU gymnast since Sarie Morrison earned a 39.575 on Feb. 18, 2011 against Georgia.

### Record for Rheagan

- No freshman in the history of LSU gymnastics has scored a 39.175 in the all-around in her first meet as a Tiger until Rheagan Courville accomplished that feat in the Cancun Classic. The previous best was a 38.700 by former great April Burkholder in 2003.

### LSU Takes Fifth in Cancun Classic

- LSU started strong at the Cancun Classic with a 49.200 on vault and struggled after the bye before bars with a 47.975 on bars and a 46.525 on beam. The Tigers rallied for a 48.800 on floor and settled for a 192.500 total, the lowest team score since 1998.
- Despite the team struggles, freshman Rheagan Courville put together a solid meet with freshman season-opening record 39.175 in the all-around, highlighted by a 9.875 on vault and a 9.825 on bars.
- Freshman Lloimincia Hall posted a 9.90 on vault, her first event at LSU. It was the first and only 9.90 of the meet for the Tigers, and it was good enough for second place in the event.

### D-D Breaux Enters Year 35 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is going into its 38th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has only missed the first three seasons as she enters her 35th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 599-379-8 in 34-plus seasons, winning 61 percent of the time.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 106 NCAA All-Americans, 106 NACGC/W Scholastic All-Americans, 47 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 144 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, eight NCAA individual national champions, 28 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and two NCAA Super Six appearances.

### Opening on the Road

- This is the third time in the last five seasons that LSU will open up the season at the Cancun Classic and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tigers will begin the year away from Baton Rouge.
- The only season in the last five in which LSU opened at home was 2010 when the Tigers hosted Maryland.
- LSU has won three of the last five season openers, taking the Cancun Classic titles in 2008 and 2009 and beating Maryland in 2010. The Tigers lost at Oregon State last season 195.400-193.350 and finished in 5th in Cancun in 2012.

### Returning All-Americans

- LSU returns two All-Americans in 2012. Senior Ashley Lee picked up First-Team All-America honors on vault in 2010 while sophomore Kaleigh Dickson earned Second-Team All-America recognition in the all-around. Dickson's All-America honor was the 106th in LSU history as she became LSU's 10th All-American in the all-around dating back to 1986.
- The Tigers lost one All-American from 2011 as Sam Engle graduated.
