## SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ The No. 23 LSU softball team concludes a stretch of seven games over an eight-day stretch with a Tuesday twinbill at SEC frontrunner and No. 3 Florida.
- ▶ Florida has notched victories in 12 of its last 13 outings with its lone setback coming versus in-state foe UCF back on April 11. The Gators are second in the SEC in a majority of offensive categories, including a .314 team batting average, 281 runs scored, 56 home runs and 264 RBIs.
- ▶ LSU holds a 28-18 series advantage over Florida, but the Gators have won 11 of the last 12 meetings since the 2008 season. The Tigers lone victory came during a 9-1 triumph in the semifinals at the 2010 SEC Tournament.
- ▶ Going back to the 2006 season, LSU has been ranked in 91 of the last 99 editions of the NFCA/USA Softball Top 25 polls. The Tigers have been ranked in both polls in three straight weeks. This week, LSU checks in at No. 23 in both polls.

**STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS**

- LSU has reeled off a 22-8 mark going back to March 7 highlighted by season's best 12-game winning streak [March 16-April 4]. The Tigers also posted a six-game run [March 7-14] during the stretch but have dropped seven of their last 11 since April 6.
- LSU will carry a 32-15 overall record and 13-7 SEC mark into its Tuesday twinbill at No. 3 Florida. A series history and player career stats versus the Gators can be seen at the bottom of the page.
- LSU currently holds sole possession of second place in the SEC Western Division standings and is currently four games behind Alabama in the loss column.
- Last time out, LSU picked up a series win over Ole Miss and maintained its fourth-place position in the overall SEC standings.
- The Tigers won the first two games of the series by 4-0 and 2-1 margins. Rachele Fico tossed a three-hit shutout in the series opener, while Ashleigh Kuhn provided a RBI groundout to break a 1-1 tie during game two.
- LSU wore teal jerseys to celebrate survivors and spread awareness during the program's inaugural "Strikeout Ovarian Cancer" event on April 21.
- Betty Dieter, mother of head coach Beth Torina and two-year ovarian cancer survivor, threw out the ceremonial first pitch.
- Three weekends ago, LSU became only the second team during the 2012 season to defeat No. 2 Alabama. The victory halted a 13-game winning streak by the home team in the LSU-Alabama rivalry and marked the Tigers first win in Tuscaloosa since 2006.

- The Tigers used a solid effort in all three phases of the game during a 3-2 triumph in-front of a then Rhoads Stadium record crowd of 3,521 fans.
- Ashley Langoni provided a two-run home run in the first inning, Rachele Fico notched nine strikeouts for a complete game in the circle and Tammy Wray recorded the game's final out firing a strike to Allison Falcon on a chopping bunt attempt to get the speedy Kayla Braud by a step.
- Four weeks ago when LSU notched a sweep of South Carolina [March 23-25], it marked the fourth straight season that the Tigers have posted a weekend shutout of an SEC opponent: South Carolina [2009, 2010, 2012] and Ole Miss [2011].
- 12 of LSU's 15 losses have come against ranked opponents which include No. 15 Michigan [Feb. 11], No. 3 California [Feb. 19], No. 8 Oklahoma [March 2 & 3], No. 23 Oklahoma State [March 4, No. 20 Auburn [March 14], No. 2 Alabama [April 6 & 8], No. 10 Tennessee [April 13, 14 & 15] and No. 22 Florida State [April 18]. DePaul [Feb. 18] is receiving votes in both editions of the Top 25 polls.
- As a team, LSU is hitting .290 during its 32 wins compared to a .141 ratio in its 15 losses.
- In those 32 wins, LSU has outscored their opponents by a 167-31 margin sparked by 18 shutouts. The Tigers have come away with wins in 16 of their last 23 outings with seven shutouts since the Mississippi State opener [March 16].
- A.J. Andrews and Jacee Blades have batted 1-2 in the lineup dur-

- Andrews, an All-SEC Freshman candidate, has garnered hits in 14 of her last 25 outings [March 9-April 21] highlighted by six multi-hit performances. 20 of Andrews' 24 hits have come during the stretch, and she contributed a .264 hitting clip.
- Andrews has recorded nine of her team-leading 10 stolen bases and scored 12 of her 15 runs during the stretch.
- Andrews has tallied a .306 hitting clip [15-for-49] and has produced seven of her eight RBIs during SEC action.
- Jacee Blades has registered hits in 12 of her last 21 outings since being inserted into the starting lineup for the Mississippi State opener [March 16]. She has garnered 15 of those 21 starts at the designated player position [March 20-April 22].

- Langoni has produced hits in 11 of her last 18 outings [March 24-April 22] fueled by a quartet of multi-hit efforts. She has produced a team-leading .375 batting average [15-for-40] in conference play.

- Falcon has found herself in five different spots in the batting order after starting the season at the bottom of the lineup, most recently 18 straight appearances in the No. 5 position [March 23-April 22]. She did not play versus Nicholls State [April 4].
- Falcon missed an eight-game stretch [Feb. 25-March 4] due to injury. She has tallied a .292 batting average and notched 17 RBIs to rank third on the team.
- Falcon recently produced a career-long six-game hitting streak [March 28-April 7]. She ripped a RBI single in the third inning of LSU's 3-2 win over No. 2 Alabama [April 7] which proved to be the game-winning hit.
- Falcon blasted a solo home run during the second inning of the Tennessee series finale [April 15] to give LSU a 1-0 edge.
- After battling an injury and appearing in only three games in 2011, Ashley Applegate has started 45 of 48 games this season with 41 of those starts coming in right field.
- Applegate equaled a career-long six-game hitting streak [March 25-April 4] being used in the lineup's No. 6 spot. She cranked a two-run single during the sixth inning to vault LSU to a 3-2 comeback win in the Arkansas finale [April 1].
- However, Applegate is looking to break out of a 2-for-27 run over her last 11 appearances [April 6-22].
- In her 22 starts at catcher, Lauren Houston has reached base in 14 of those games. She has compiled a .435 on-base percentage being hit-by-a-pitch on 13 occasions, which is tied for second-best in the SEC rankings.
- Houston is looking to end a 0-for-12 stretch at the plate over her last six outings [March 31-April 21].
- Tammy Wray has provided a hit during five of her last seven games [April 14-22]. She plated LSU's first run on a two-out, RBI single versus Ole Miss [April 20].
- During the streak, Wray has seen her average climb 33 points and reach its highest point since the Alcorn State game [Feb. 26].
- Dylan Supak has produced hits in 11 of her 27 starts on the season, but has tallied a 4-for-33 clip during her last 15 games since SEC action began [March 14-April 22].
- Supak delivered a two-run single which proved to be the game-winner during LSU's eight-run third inning versus Mississippi State [March 16].
- Supak's five-RBI performances are third on the team only behind Langoni and Santos. She is fifth on the squad with 11 total RBIs.
- Simone Heyward missed a 15-game stretch due to injury [March 2-21] and has returned to action by making 10 appearances as a pinch hitter and two starts in centerfield [March 23-April 22]. She is 1-for-13 at the plate since returning to action.
- Heyward drew a leadoff walk and scored the game-winning run in LSU's 1-0 walk-off win over Arkansas [March 30]. She has scored nine times in 2012, and LSU is 31-4 over the last two seasons when she crosses the plate.
- Off the bench, Alex Boulet has scored during seven of her last 11 pinch running appearances [March 18-April 22]. She has notched seven of her team-leading 10 steals since April 4, including four straight outings [April 18-22].
- Rikki Alcaraz has scored runs and drawn a quartet of walks in her last three outings as the starting second baseman [March 18-20, April 4]. She ignited LSU's five-run fifth inning versus Nicholls State [April 4] with a leadoff double.
- Earlier this season, Alcaraz put together a five-game hitting streak [Feb. 21-26] and claimed Tiger Invitational All-Tournament honors.
- Jacee Blades, Ashleigh Kuhn and Heidi Pizer have registered a combined 8-for-10 clip as pinch hitters. The rest of the LSU team has garnered a 2-for-28 mark.
- Kuhn has driven home 11 of her 13 RBIs during her last 13 outings [March 7-28, April 4-22]. She has tallied a 2-for-23 clip at the plate in SEC action.
- Kuhn, whose mother is a 10-year cervical cancer survivor, broke a 1-1 tie with a RBI groundout during LSU's inaugural "Strikeout Ovarian Cancer" event versus Ole Miss [April 21]. She also notched a RBI single to plate LSU's only run during the seventh inning versus No. 22 Florida State [April 18].

- Fico has tossed 10 overall shutouts to rank in a eighth-place tie nationally. She has fired a quartet of one-hitters against Louisiana Tech [Feb. 12], Utah State [Feb. 19], McNeese State [Feb. 25] and Troy [March 10].
- For her career, Fico has totaled 19 shutouts to rank fifth in program history. She is one shutouts away from Dani Hofer [2006-09] for the No. 4 spot.
- Fico became only the second pitcher during the 2012 season to defeat No. 2 Alabama [April 7]. She accomplished the impressive feat on the biggest of stages in-front of a then Rhoads Stadium record crowd of 3,521 spectators.
- Fico finished the game in-style by recording six of her nine strikeouts and retiring nine of the final 11 batters she faced over the final three innings.
- Fico's sparkling pitching performance ended a 13-game winning streak by the home team in the series and gave LSU its first win in Tuscaloosa dating back to the 2006 season.
- Fico had an impressive run of seven straight victories [March 16-April 8] come to a close at No. 10 Tennessee [April 14].
- Fico has limited opponents to a .187 hitting clip and notched 144 strikeouts to rank sixth in both categories among the SEC leaders.
- Fico's 488 career strikeouts places her sixth on LSU's all-time list. The junior right-hander recently moved past Cody Trahan [2008-2011] with three Ks in relief versus No. 22 Florida State [April 18].
- Brittany Mack is 13-8 with a 2.54 ERA. She ended her four-game losing skid, all coming against Top 25 opponents [April 6-18], with an 11-strikeout performance versus Ole Miss [April 21].
- Earlier in the season, Mack produced nine consecutive wins [March 3-April 1] which came to a close during the series opener

- at No. 2 Alabama [April 6].
- During the nine-game run, Mack carried a no-hitter one out into the seventh inning at South Carolina [March 24]. In the process, she became the fifth pitcher in LSU history to eclipse 500 career strikeouts and the sixth hurler to reach the 50-win plateau. The senior right-hander picked up SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week [March 26] for her efforts.
- Mack was selected as the No. 1 pick during the National Pro Fast-pitch's Collegiate Draft [March 7]. It marks the third straight year the SEC has had the No. 1 pick in the NPF Draft.
- Against Mississippi State [March 16-17], Mack recorded two strikeouts in a relief appearance during the series opener to earn her first save of the season. The senior right-hander followed that up with a 10-strikeout performance in game two.
- Meghan Patterson is 4-0 and has racked up 40 strikeouts in her 38.1 innings of work, including a career-best 13 Ks against Alcorn State [Feb. 26].
- Patterson has been touched up for two runs on 18 hits in her last 32 frames of action [Feb. 26-April 17]. She made her SEC season debut at South Carolina [March 25].
- Patterson garnered consecutive complete game victories versus Nicholls State [April 4] and McNeese State [April 17].

**BATON ROUGE** - The No. 21 LSU softball team opened SEC action with a pair of 8-1 and 5-0 setbacks to No. 2 Florida Wednesday in-front of a season-best 1,267 fans at Tiger Park.

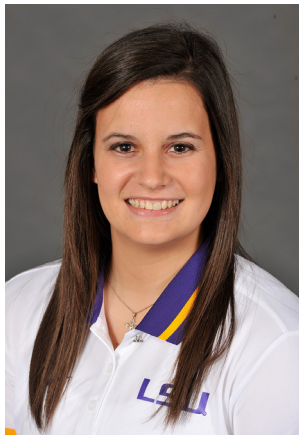
