

# LSU FOOTBALL POSTGAME NOTES

#4/3 LSU vs. #10/11 Florida

October 6, 2012 – Ben Hill Griffin Stadium (Gainesville, Fla.)

## Team Notes

1. LSU's game captains were 18 **Bennie Logan**, 30 **Drew Alleman**, 88 **Chase Clement**, 72 **Alex Hurst**, 46 **Kevin Minter**, 1 **Eric Reid**.
2. Florida won the toss and deferred to the second half. LSU received the opening kickoff.
3. This is LSU's first regular-season loss since falling 31-23 at Arkansas on Nov. 27, 2010. It snapped a nation-leading streak of 18 consecutive regular-season wins.
4. The loss snaps LSU's seven-game winning streak against teams from the SEC Eastern Division. It was the longest streak in school history. LSU's last loss to an SEC East team was against Florida in 2009. It is also LSU's first road loss to an SEC East opponent since 2008 at Florida.
5. LSU is 24-10 in road games under **Les Miles**, including a 20-10 mark in SEC road games.

## Individual Notes

6. LB **Kevin Minter** had the best game of his career as he finished one tackle short of tying the LSU single-game record of 21 set by Al Richardson against South Carolina in 1982.
  - a. **Minter** earned a career-high 20 total tackles, 17 of which were solo, and added career highs of three tackles for a loss, 2.0 sacks and a forced fumble.
  - b. **Minter's** forced fumble is the second of his career and first since the Florida game last season.
7. PK **Drew Alleman** drilled field goals of: 31 yards with 10:48 left in the first quarter and 21 yards with 24 seconds left in the second quarter.
  - a. **Alleman**, who sits in 10<sup>th</sup> place in LSU career made field goals, is now 8-of-11 for the season and 24-of-29 for his career.
8. LB **Kwon Alexander** recorded his first career fumble recovery in the first half.
9. DT **Bennie Logan** earned his first sack of the season and forced a fumble in the process in the final three minutes of the first half. It was his second career forced fumble and first since last year's SEC Championship Game against Georgia.
10. DE **Barkevious Mingo** recorded his second career fumble recovery and first since his redshirt freshman season in 2010 in the season-opener against North Carolina.
