SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ No. 13 LSU steps out of SEC play for a pair of mid-week matchups versus Southeastern Louisiana and No. 25 South Alabama.
- ▶ Tuesday's first pitch versus the Lady Lions is slated for 6 p.m. at Tiger Park which will conclude LSU's 10-game homestand, while Wednesday's contest against the Jaguars will have a 7 p.m. first pitch from Mobile.
- ▶ LSU (27-6) has picked up wins in nine of its last 10 outings since March 10. The Tigers also have posted a combined 22-1 all-time mark versus Southeastern Louisiana and South Alabama.
- ▶ Southeastern Louisiana (18-10) is coming off a 1-2 weekend at McNeese State, while South Alabama (27-5) secured a sweep of Florida International over the weekend.

2013 STREAKS, STORYLINES AND SIDEBARS

- LSU has fired out to a 27-6 record and a 7-2 mark in SEC play highlighted by a 10-game winning streak (Feb. 13-23) in addition to a nine-game winning run (March 10-23).
- The Tigers enter this week's mid-week action winners of nine of their last 10 games (March 10-24) and 13 of their last 16 outings since March 1.
- LSU has picked up six wins over ranked opponents which include No. 22 North Carolina (8-0 • Feb. 10), No. 14 Arizona (3-0 • Feb. 23), No. 14 Michigan (14-6 • March 2) and No. 17 Kentucky (7-1 • March 15; 4-3 • March 16; 3-2 • March 17).
- LSU's offense has turned in a .299 team batting average compared to a .253 hitting clip through 33 games last season.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.1 runs per game compared to a 4.4 runs per game through 33 games last season.
- LSU has already cranked 29 home runs through 33 games which has doubled the team's total from the entire 2012 season. The Tigers have six players with three or more longballs.
- The Tigers have come away with double digit hits on nine occasions most recently an 11-hit effort in game one versus Georgia Southern (March 19). LSU collected a season's best 17 hits during a 14-6 victory over No. 14 Michigan. The 17 hits were the most for LSU since the Tigers posted 18 hits at Arkansas on April 21, 2007.
- After going 197 games without a ground slam dating back to the Arizona State game at the 2009 NCAA Tempe Regional, the Tigers have already hit a pair of slams this season which came eight

games apart versus BYU (Feb. 21) and No. 14 Michigan (March 2).
 • LSU also went 135 games in between a player connecting for two home runs in the same game. Bianka Bell and Tammy Wray accomplished this feat three games apart versus Georgia Southern (March 19) and South Carolina (March 23).
 • LSU's pitching staff has tossed 13 shutouts and recorded 242 strikeouts over 229.2 innings pitched. The 242 Ks enter this week's action ranked 2nd in the SEC.

FROM THE BATTER'S BOX

- A.J. Andrews is one of only two players to start in all 33 games and has batted leadoff in every game for the Tigers. She is second on the team with a .330 batting average.
- Andrews garnered a 4-for-4 effort during LSU's 14-6 win over No. 14 Michigan (March 2). She also knocked her first career home run, a solo shot, during the 14th inning of the Mississippi State opener (March 8).
- Andrews has registered a team-leading 38 hits which includes a team-high 10 multi-hit efforts. Her nine-game hitting streak (March 8-19) which equaled a career-long recently came to a close.
- Andrews has hit safely in 19 of her last 22 outings (Feb. 21-March 4) which includes seven of her nine SEC contests.
- With LSU trailing 2-1 in the sixth inning of the Kentucky series finale, Andrews deposited the go-ahead two-run, two out single to right field. She also notched the game-tying hit during LSU's 4-3

- Andrews has scored a team-high 23 runs and tallied multiple runs on eight occasions. LSU is 15-0 on the season when Andrews scores a run.
- Andrews has gone 10-for-10 in the stolen base department. Her 10 steals are not only a team-high but are just outside the SEC's Top 15.
- Jacee Blades has started LSU's last 30 games, mostly between left and right field. She also has occupied the two-hole in the lineup 30 times.
- Blades has compiled a team-leading .373 batting average. She is tied for the team lead with 38 hits and is fifth on the squad with 15 runs scored. LSU has won all 12 games this season when Blades has crossed the plate.
- Blades recently had a career-long eight-game hitting streak come to a close (March 8-19) in game two versus Georgia Southern. She has hit safely in 18 of her last 23 games (Feb. 21-March 24) which includes eight of nine SEC outings.
- Blades has collected a quartet of three-hit performances versus Virginia (Feb. 15), UNLV (Feb. 22), Syracuse (March 1) and South Carolina (March 23). She has garnered 10 multi-hit efforts, tied for the team lead.
- Blades provided the game-winning single during LSU's 4-3 nine-inning comeback win over Kentucky (March 16).
- Allison Falcon is one of only two players to start in all 33 games. She has split her starts between second base (24), shortstop (7) and designated player (2).
- Falcon, a 2012 NCAA College Station All-Regional and 2012 NCAA Columbia All-Super Regional pick, is fourth on the team with a .310 batting average, while her 31 hits are third on the squad.
- 12 of Falcon's 31 hits have gone for extra bases which includes a team-leading eight doubles.
- Falcon is third on the team with four home runs and has driven home 19 RBIs. She also is third on the team with eight multi-hit efforts and tops on the squad with six multi-RBI performances.
- Falcon started the season on a career-long eight-game hitting streak (Feb. 8-15). She hit a two-run home run in the first inning of LSU's 3-0 win over No. 14 Arizona (Feb. 23).
- Falcon notched LSWA Hitter of the Week (March 6) after she turned in four multi-hit efforts at the Diamond 9 Citrus Classic (March 1-3).
- Falcon scored two runs which included the game-winner in game two of the Georgia Southern doubleheader (March 19).
- Bianka Bell has started 31 of 33 games between shortstop (26) and second base (5). She has tallied a .311 batting average to go along with a team-leading six home runs and 20 RBIs.
- Bell has collected seven multi-hit games and 28 total hits, both fourth on the team. She produced a six-game hitting streak (Feb. 15-22) fueled by five of her multi-hit efforts.
- Bell came away with another six-game hitting streak (March

2-13) and knocked a three-run home run during the first inning of the Mississippi State finale (March 10).

- Bell cranked a leadoff double to spark LSU's three-run sixth inning against No. 17 Kentucky (March 17) which lead to a series sweep.
- Bell added her first career two homer game to open the Georgia Southern doubleheader (March 19) and provided the game-winning RBI double during the third inning of game two. She is the first LSU player since Anissa Young versus Fordham on Feb. 26, 2011 to hit a pair of dingers in the same game.
- Tammy Wray is one of three players to see action in all 33 games, starting 32 contests at third base. She has notched a .247 batting average to go along with a team-leading six homers and 20 RBIs.
- Wray has split her time between No. 5 and No. 7 slots in the lineup and put together a six-game hitting streak (Feb. 16-22). She also has hit safely in six of her last 10 outings (March 10-24).
- Wray belted a pair of three-run shots during LSU's wins over No. 22 North Carolina (Feb. 8) and Ole Miss (Feb. 13) along with a two-run homers versus BYU (Feb. 21), at Mississippi State (March 10) and South Carolina (March 23).
- Wray's two-homer performance during the South Carolina game was LSU's first against a SEC opponent since Rachel Mitchell versus Arkansas (April 27, 2008) at the original Tiger Park.
- 11 of Wray's 21 hits have gone for extra bases and produced a RBI. She also has drawn a team-leading 15 walks which includes six free passes over her last nine outings (March 13-24).
- Sandra Simmons has started 32 of 33 games at first base and has primarily batted in the No. 6 spot in the lineup. She has garnered a .291 batting average, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Her 17 RBIs are tied for fourth on the squad.
- Simmons has hit safely in 10 of her last 12 games (March 8-24). She also has registered three of her five multi-RBI performances during that stretch.
- Simmons is currently on a career-long five-game hitting streak (March 19-24), and the .291 hitting clip is at its highest point since the UNLV game (Feb. 22).
- Simmons cranked a two-run double during LSU's 7-1 series opening win over No. 17 Kentucky (March 15). She also knocked a two-run homer as part of LSU's 9-2 win over the Bulldogs in the series finale.
- With the score tied at 6-6 in the seventh inning, Simmons belted a grand slam to vault LSU to a 10-6 triumph over BYU (Feb. 21). It marked LSU's first grand slam since Ashley Langoni and Anissa Young accomplished the feat at No. 9 Arizona State (May 16, 2009) during the 2009 NCAA Tempe Regional, a span of 197 games.
- Kellsie Kloss has made the most of her 18 starts on the season with a .260 batting average, four home runs and 16 RBIs. Her four home runs are tied for third on the team.
- Eight of Kloss' 13 hits on the season have tallied RBIs. She knocked a solo home run for her first career hit which proved to be the game-winner during LSU's 1-0 win over Purdue (Feb. 8).

- Kloss added a 2-for-5 effort and racked up six RBIs sparked by a 7th inning grand slam in a 14-6 victory over Michigan (March 2). The six RBIs were the most by a LSU player since Vanessa Soto versus Centenary during the 2007 season.
- Kloss provided a two-out, two-run single to even the score at 2-2 during the first inning of game two versus Georgia Southern.
- Rikki Alcaraz has started 14 of LSU's last 18 games (Feb. 22-March 24) and emerged as the primary option at designated player spot. She has racked up an impressive .435 batting average, three home runs and 14 RBIs.
- All 20 of Alcaraz's hits have come during a stretch where she has hit safely in 13 of her last 16 outings (Feb. 15-March 24). Her three-hit effort versus UNLV (Feb. 23) and Georgia Southern (March 19) were career-highs.
- Alcaraz belted her first career home run, a two-run shot, in a 14-6 win over No. 14 Michigan (March 2). She added a RBI single to ignite LSU's three-run sixth inning versus No. 17 Kentucky (March 17) which led to a series sweep of the Wildcats.
- Alcaraz has added RBIs in four of her last six appearances (March 16-24). Her two-run home run put the Tigers on the scoreboard during LSU's 4-0 series opening win over South Carolina (March 22).
- Lauren Houston has checked in with 17 starts at catcher. She is batting .233 with one homer and 7 RBIs on the season. Her lone longball came on a two-run shot at Ole Miss (Feb. 13).
- Houston has recorded hits during three of her last six appearances (March 8-22). She also collected a two-run single to finish off an 8-0 five-inning win versus Georgia Southern (March 19).
- Simone Heyward has started 15 of LSU's last 18 games in the outfield (Feb. 24-March 24). She has picked up all 14 of her hits on the season during that stretch en route to a .311 batting average.
- Seven of Heyward's nine stolen bases have come during SEC play. The seven steals are tied for the conference lead in league play.
- Heyward has notched hits in nine of those 18 games (Feb. 24-March 24) highlighted by her first career three-hit performance to open the Kentucky series (March 15). She also turned in a 2-for-3 effort versus No. 16 UCLA (Feb. 24) and a 2-for-2 performance with two stolen bases against South Carolina (March 22).
- Heyward reached base in all four of her plate appearances and scored two runs during LSU's 14-6 win over Michigan (March 2).

- Alex Boulet has made 15 appearances which includes five starts in the outfield. She has provided a hit during her last three outings with a plate appearance (Feb. 22-March 19).
- Boulet has crossed the plate in seven of her last nine pinch running efforts (Feb. 15-March 17). She represented the game's tying run and scored on A.J. Andrews' squeeze bunt in the ninth inning of the middle game versus No. 17 Kentucky (March 16).
- Katie Guillory has started in 10 games at right field. She has totaled a .259 batting average, one home run and 4 RBIs.
- Guillory has already doubled her career hit total and connected for her first career longball versus North Dakota State (Feb. 15).
- Kailey McCasland has made 11 starts mostly at designated player spot. She has drawn 10 walks, third-most on the team, en route to a .405 on-base percentage.
- McCasland collected hits during the No. 22 North Carolina (Feb. 10) and BYU (Feb. 21) games.
- Hailey Smith has tallied four starts, three at designated player. She notched two hits and a RBI against Hampton (Feb. 9).

- Fico collected her second career no-hitter during the Ohio State game, her only other no-hitter was five-inning perfect game versus Southeastern Louisiana (Feb. 15, 2011).
- Fico become the fourth pitcher in program history to surpass 700 career strikeouts during the series opener versus No. 17 Kentucky (March 15). She joins the illustrious company of former All-Americans Britni Sneed, Kristin Schmidt and Emily Turner.
- Fico currently has totaled 722 Ks and has already passed former All-American Brittany Mack (2009-12) and Dani Hofer (2006-09) on the program's strikeout list during the 2013 season.
- Fico enters this weekend's action 56 strikeouts away from tying Turner (2004-07) for third place.
- Fico turned in a memorable performance for the ages and notched a program single-game record with 22 strikeouts versus Mississippi State (March 10). The 22 Ks also equaled former Tennessee All-American Monica Abbott's SEC single-game mark and enabled Fico to notch her second SEC Pitcher of the Week award of the season.
- Fico claimed her 69th career victory, a two-hit shutout of Georgia Southern (March 19), to move past Ashley Lewis (1999-2001) for fourth place on LSU's all-time list.
- Meghan Patterson has posted a 4-2 mark with a 1.70 ERA. She tossed a pair of complete game shutouts, a three-hitter versus Purdue (Feb. 8) along with a four-hitter against Nicholls State (Feb. 17).

- Patterson recorded a season's best eight Ks versus Nicholls State (Feb. 17) and Georgia Southern (March 19). She has been LSU's Saturday starter during the first two SEC weekends.
- Patterson was the tough-luck loser in a 2-1 decision at Mississippi State (March 9). In her second career SEC start, she was handed a no-decision after she allowed two runs on three hits and totaled five Ks over her 5.2 frames of action.
- Ashley Czechner has won all seven of her decisions and been used both as a starter (7x) and in relief (3x). She has collected wins over Hampton (Feb. 9), UNLV (Feb. 22), Syracuse (March 1), Penn State (March 2), Nicholls State (March 13), No. 17 Kentucky (March 17) and South Carolina (March 23).
- Czechner tossed a pair of one-hit shutouts versus Nicholls State (March 13) and South Carolina (March 23). She retired 11 of her last 12 batters she faced during the South Carolina game.
- Czechner also recorded a solid start to wrap up the series versus No. 17 Kentucky (March 17). She went the distance and held the Wildcats to two runs on two hits.
- In her last three starts (March 13-23), Czechner has posted three wins and limited her opponents to a paltry .068 batting average. She has allowed only two runs on four hits over 19.0 innings.

BATON ROUGE – Allison Falcon, Ashley Langoni and Morgan Russell each collected a pair of RBIs as the LSU softball team used a five-run first inning and never looked back during a 7-0 victory over Southeastern Louisiana at Tiger Park.

“The offense was great. I was proud of the way we came out and put five quick runs on the board,” head coach Beth Torina said. “I thought we hit some balls really well and used all parts of the field. A lot of credit goes to the Southeastern pitcher [Kenna Terry] because she made an adjustment after the first inning, and it really kept us off balance for five innings.”

LSU (5-4) won back-to-back games for the second time during the 2012 campaign and notched its fifth shutout on the young season. Russell along with Tammy Wray collected multi-hit performances to fuel a nine-hit attack for the Tigers.

LSU raced out of the gates with a five-run first inning. Ashley Applegate drew a leadoff walk and advanced to third base on an Allison Falcon sacrifice bunt aided by a throwing error by SLU first baseman Ariell Van Hook.

On a 3-2 offering, Langoni cleared the bases and belted a two-run double down the right field line for the game’s first runs. A Lady Lion fielding error on second baseman Megan McCollum allowed Langoni to cross the plate and push the Tiger advantage to 3-0.

With two outs and runners in scoring position, Russell ended a 1-for-15 stretch as she deposited a two-run single to right field to make it 5-0.

That would be more than enough run support for Brittany Mack. She bounced back after allowing six runs during her last outing Sunday against No. 3 California and twirled a three-hit shutout. The senior right-hander notched six strikeouts against one walk and moved to 2-3 for the season.

Southeastern Louisiana’s (1-8) Kenna Terry was tagged with the loss and has dropped all four of her decisions in 2012. She surrendered seven runs, four earned, on nine hits in 5.1 innings of work.

The Tigers added two more runs in the sixth inning for the final margin of 7-0. With two on and two out, Falcon smoked a single up-the-middle to extend her career-long hitting streak to six games.

“It is a process, and it is continuing to get better each day,” Russell said. “Extra work, extra hitting and extra fielding; everything we do we need to keep doing. I think we are doing a good job right now, and I think that if we can just continue getting better each game and progress, there is no doubt that we will be in the College World Series come June.”

LSU (7-4) also notched a 5-4 victory over South Alabama in its first game of the Tiger Invitational.

"It definitely was a great day," head coach Beth Torina said. "I thought we fought hard for the first win. South Alabama played really hard. We faced another quality opponent in McNeese State, so overall it was a great day. I liked how our kids played. I liked our offensive production today. I thought they looked very confident."

LSU raced out to a 4-0 edge in the first inning. With one out, Simone Heyward and Ashley Langoni struck for a single and double to put runners in scoring position.

Both runners came around to score on Juliana Santos' two-run single to left field, and Santos moved up to second base on South Alabama's throw to the plate.

After a passed ball allowed Santos to scoot to third base, Rikki Alcaraz drew a walk and stole second base. Dylan Supak delivered a timely, two-out centerfield to push the Tiger advantage to 4-0.

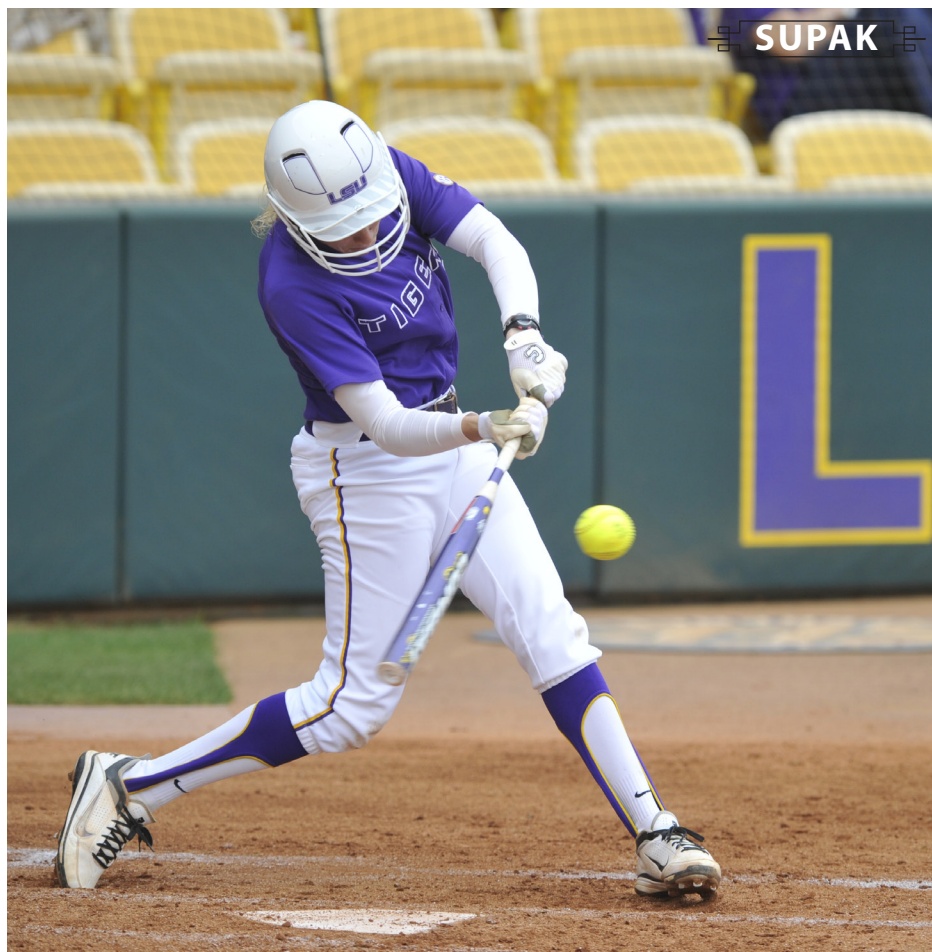

BATON ROUGE – Rachele Fico and Meghan Patterson fired a pair of shutouts as the LSU softball team ran its winning streak to six games with victories over South Alabama and Alcorn State to conclude the Tiger Invitational.

"I feel like we dodged two bullets today, but at the end of the day we're 4-0 on the weekend," head coach Beth Torina said. "You can't really be too upset about that. There are still a lot of things we have to do better, without question. We have tons of work to do this week. We'll continue to work and continue to grow."

LSU (9-4) emerged with a 1-0 victory over South Alabama. Fico sprayed seven hits and notched five strikeouts against three walks to improve to 5-1 on the season. It was the third consecutive shutout for the junior right-hander.

LSU's defense made three big plays to keep the Jaguars (6-5) off the scoreboard.

With one out and runners on the corners, South Alabama's Haley Hopkins missed on a squeeze bunt attempt. Alertly, catcher Morgan Russell made a snap throw to third base to pick off the lead runner.

The Jaguars attempted to score in the third inning on a Hopkins two-out single to left field. Ashley Langoni charged the ball and fired a textbook one-hopper to the plate to gun down South Alabama's Alyssa Linn to preserve the 1-0 score.

In the sixth inning with the bases loaded and one out, South Alabama's Haley Richards knocked a line drive to third baseman Tammy Wray. After making the catch, Wray turned around to tag the runner for the third out of the frame.

Fico escaped another bases loaded jam in the seventh and got Brittany Fowler to line out to second baseman Rikki Alcaraz, who made a running catch going to her right to secure the 1-0 win.

"I thought South Alabama out-played us in all aspects for the most part," Torina said. "We made some spectacular defensive plays that kept us in it, and Rachele Fico just continued to battle. It's easy to play defense behind somebody throwing that well."

LSU scored the game's only run during the second inning. Alcaraz smoked a leadoff double to centerfield fence and advanced to third base on a Dylan Supak sacrifice bunt. Two batters later, Hopkins attempted her own pickoff play on Alcaraz, but the ball scooted into left field to allow Alcaraz to cross the plate.
