## SETTING THE SCENE

- ▶ LSU concludes its eight-game road swing to start the month of April and meets McNeese State Wednesday for the only meeting between the two teams during the 2013 season.
- ▶ LSU (35-9) has won seven of its last nine games since March 30 highlighted by a mid-week win at Florida State along with road series victories over Arkansas and No. 10 Texas A&M.
- ▶ McNeese State (32-10) has posted a 19-3 mark going back to March 10. The Cowgirls have tallied a NCAA Top 10 staff ERA fueled by Jamie Allred and Meagan Bond, a pair 15-game winners.
- ▶ LSU has won 24 of 26 meetings over the Cowgirls. However, all three meetings were decided by two runs or less last season.

2013 STREAKS, STORYLINES AND SIDEBARS

- LSU has collected a 35-9 record and a 11-4 mark in SEC play highlighted by a 10-game winning streak (Feb. 13-23) in addition to a nine-game winning streak (March 10-23).
- The Tigers enter this week's action at McNeese State winners of seven of their last nine outings (March 30-April 14) and 17 of their last 21 games (March 10-April 14).
- LSU has picked up eight wins over ranked opponents which include No. 22 North Carolina (8-0 • Feb. 10), No. 14 Arizona (3-0 • Feb. 23) and No. 14 Michigan (14-6 • March 2).
- The Tigers swept No. 17 Kentucky (7-1 • March 15; 4-3 • March 16; 3-2 • March 17) and won two games at No. 10 Texas A&M (9-6 • April 13; 10-2 • April 14).
- The Tigers have won all five of their SEC series to start the season. The last time LSU accomplished that feat was when the 2007 team won its first nine series en route to the program's seventh SEC Western Division title.
- LSU's offense has turned in a .291 team batting average compared to a .246 hitting clip through 44 games last season.
- The Tigers are averaging 5.3 runs per game compared to a 4.0 runs per game through 44 games last season.
- LSU has already cranked 35 home runs through 44 games which has more than doubled the team's total from the entire 2012 season. The Tigers have six players with three or more longballs.
- The Tigers have come away with double digit hits on 11 occasions most recently an 11-hit effort in game one of the Arkansas series (April 5).
- LSU collected a season's best 17 hits during a 14-6 victory over No. 14 Michigan. The 17 hits were the most for LSU since the Tigers posted 18 hits at Arkansas on April 21, 2007.
- After going 197 games without a ground slam dating back to the Arizona State game at the 2009 NCAA Tempe Regional, the Tigers have already hit a trio of slams this season. The first two came eight games apart versus BYU (Feb. 21) and No. 14 Michigan (March 2) followed by one at No. 25 South Alabama (March 27).
- LSU also went 135 games between having a player connect for two home runs during the same game. Bianca Bell and Tammy Wray have accomplished this feat three games apart versus Georgia Southern (March 19) and South Carolina (March 23).

• LSU's pitching staff has tossed 15 shutouts and recorded 311 strikeouts over 302.1 innings pitched. The 311 Ks enter the McNeese State game ranked 2nd in the SEC.

FROM THE BATTER'S BOX

- A.J. Andrews is one of only two players to start in all 44 games and has batted leadoff in every game for the Tigers. She has posted a .355 batting average, second on the squad.
- Andrews has registered a team-high 54 hits, good enough for ninth place on the SEC leaderboard. She also has tallied a team-leading 14 multi-hit efforts which includes a 3-for-3 effort and a career-high three RBIs at Florida State (April 3).
- Andrews has collected hits in eight of her last nine outings (March 30-April 14). During that run, she has produced a .469 hitting clip (15-for-32) with 10 runs scored and nine RBIs.
- Andrews has garnered a pair of career-long nine-game hitting streaks (Feb. 21-March 2, March 8-19) during the season. She has registered a hit during 28 of her last 33 games (Feb. 21-April 14) which includes 12 of her 15 SEC contests.
- Andrews has scored a team-high 34 runs and tallied multiple runs on 11 occasions which includes a career-high three runs at Arkansas (April 5). LSU is 22-0 on the season when Andrews scores a run.
- Andrews has gone 17-for-18 in the stolen base department. Her 17 steals are tied for ninth in the SEC rankings. She had a streak of 22 straight steal attempts broken at No. 10 Texas A&M (April 14).
- With the score tied at 6-6, Andrews provided the go-ahead RBI single on a bunt down the first base line during LSU's three-run eighth inning at No. 10 Texas A&M (April 13).
- Andrews played a major role as LSU erased a four-run deficit at Arkansas (April 7). She knocked an infield single and scored a run during the team's three-run fifth followed by the game-tying RBI triple with two outs in the sixth inning. Andrews scampered home with the game-winning run after an Arkansas wild pitch.
- With LSU trailing 2-1 in the sixth inning of the Kentucky series finale, Andrews deposited the go-ahead two-run, two out single to right field. She also notched the game-tying hit during LSU's 4-3 comeback win over No. 17 Kentucky (March 16).
- Andrews garnered a 4-for-4 effort during LSU's 14-6 win over No.

- Jacee Blades has started LSU's last 41 games, mostly between left and right field. She also has occupied the two-hole in the lineup 41 times.
- Blades has compiled a team-leading .358 batting average, while her 49 hits are second on the squad. Her 49 hits also are tied for 14th place among the SEC leaders.
- The 49 hits for Blades has more than doubled her career total entering her junior season. She has garnered 13 multi-hit efforts to rank second on the team, five of those performances have come over LSU's last 14 games (March 22-April 14).
- Blades had a career-long eight-game hitting streak come to a close in game two versus Georgia Southern (March 8-19). She has hit safely in 26 of her last 34 games (Feb. 21-April 14) which includes 12 of 15 SEC outings.
- Blades has collected a quartet of three-hit performances versus Virginia (Feb. 15), UNLV (Feb. 22), Syracuse (March 1) and South Carolina (March 23).
- Blades tacked on a RBI single as part of LSU's three-run eighth inning during a 9-6 win at No. 10 Texas A&M (April 13).
- Blades provided the game-winning single during LSU's 4-3 nine-inning comeback win over Kentucky (March 16). She also added a RBI single to spark the Tigers to erase a four-run deficit in the series finale at Arkansas (April 7).
- Bianka Bell has started 41 of 44 games between shortstop (37) and second base (5). She has tallied a .331 batting average to go along with a team-leading 10 home runs and 39 RBIs.
- Over her last 17 games (March 17-April 14), Bell has secured a .370 batting average (20-for-54) to go along with seven home runs and 24 RBIs. She cranked her first career grand slam at No. 25 South Alabama (March 27).

- Bell cranked a leadoff double to spark LSU's three-run sixth inning against No. 17 Kentucky (March 17) which lead to a series sweep.
- Allison Falcon is one of only two players to start in all 44 games. She has split her starts between second base (35), shortstop (7) and designated player (2).
- Falcon, a 2012 NCAA College Station All-Regional and 2012 NCAA Columbia All-Super Regional pick, is fourth on the team with a .285 batting average and 35 total hits.
- Falcon's five home runs are third on the team. She has driven home 25 RBIs, already passing her season total from 2012. The 25 RBIs also are third on the squad.
- Falcon has hit safely in six of her last nine outings (March 30-April 14). She is fourth on the team with eight multi-hit efforts and tied for second on the team with seven multi-RBI performances.
- Falcon started the season on a career-long eight-game hitting streak (Feb. 8-15). She hit a two-run home run in the first inning of LSU's 3-0 win over No. 14 Arizona (Feb. 23).
- Falcon notched LSWA Hitter of the Week (March 6) after she turned in four multi-hit efforts at the Diamond 9 Citrus Classic (March 1-3).
- Falcon ripped a two-run homer during the first inning of the Texas A&M finale (April 14). For Falcon, it was her first dinger since the Mississippi State game (March 10).
- Sandra Simmons has started 43 of 44 games at first base and has moved into the No. 5 spot during LSU's last nine games (March 30-April 14) after primarily batting in the No. 6 hole.
- Simmons has garnered a .269 batting average, three home runs and 24 RBIs. Her 24 RBIs are fourth on the squad.
- Simmons has hit safely in 16 of her last 23 games (March 8-April 14) and her career-long seven-game run (March 19-27) came to a close during game one of the Samford twinbill.
- Simmons has racked up seven multi-RBI performances, tied with Allison Falcon for second on the squad. She collected three RBIs at Arkansas (April 5) and drove home a team-leading four RBIs during the Texas A&M series (April 12-14).

- Fico currently has totaled 763 Ks and has already passed former All-American Brittany Mack (2009-12) and Dani Hofer (2006-09) on the program's strikeout list during the 2013 season.
- Fico enters the Texas A&M series action 15 strikeouts away from tying Turner (2004-07) for third place.
- Fico turned in a memorable performance and notched a program single-game record with 22 strikeouts versus Mississippi State (March 10). The 22 Ks also equaled former Tennessee All-American Monica Abbott's SEC single-game mark and enabled Fico to notch her second SEC Pitcher of the Week award of the season.
- Fico claimed her 69th career victory, a two-hit shutout of Georgia Southern (March 19), to move past Ashley Lewis (1999-2001) for fourth place on LSU's all-time list.

**BATON ROUGE** – Rachele Fico fired her third one-hitter of the season, while Morgan Russell garnered a 2-for-3 performance with two RBIs as the LSU softball team extended its winning streak to four games with a 2-0 victory over McNeese State at Tiger Park.

“It definitely was a great day,” head coach Beth Torina said. “I thought we fought hard for the first win. South Alabama played really hard. We faced another quality opponent in McNeese State, so overall it was a great day. I liked how our kids played. I liked our offensive production today. I thought they looked very confident.”

For Fico, she improved to 4-1 on the season. She garnered six strikeouts against one walk and her ERA dropped to 0.45 for the season.

McNeese State (9-5) put runners on the corners to open the game off of Fico as Claire Terracina knocked a leadoff triple, while Kim Kennedy was hit-by-pitch.

Fico buckled down and got three consecutive ground balls, including one to shortstop Juliana Santos. She alertly threw home to Russell, who tagged Terracina at the plate to keep the game scoreless.

“Getting out of that first inning after giving up the leadoff triple gave her a lot of fire, and she was really excited about that,” Torina said. “After that, she just continued to dominate the rest of the way. I thought she was really solid, and it was another great performance from her.”

Fico proceeded to find her groove and retired 19 consecutive batters before a one-out walk in the seventh inning.

“All of her pitches were working,” Russell said. “Her curve ball was breaking great. Everything she can throw was working at its best. I was really proud of her and the way she came through. I could tell she really wanted the win.”

LSU used a two-out rally in the fourth inning for the game’s first run. Rikki Alcaraz and Dylan Supak ripped singles to centerfield to set the table for Russell. She took a 3-1 offering and deposited a RBI-single to vault LSU ahead, 1-0.

On her next plate appearance during the sixth inning, Russell ripped a solo home run for an insurance run to make it 2-0.

“It’s awesome because we have worked so hard these past couple of weeks,” Russell said. “We have hit some bumps, but now we are starting to come together as a team. We are doing our job and doing the right things. It is a great feeling.”

**LAKE CHARLES** - Brittany Mack fired a four-hitter as the LSU softball team extended its season's long winning streak to eight games, and the Tigers claimed their fourth straight shutout, a 4-0 victory over McNeese State at Cowgirl Diamond.

LSU (24-8) also has won 21 of its last 25 games dating back to Feb. 19 and ended McNeese State's (20-9) run of five consecutive wins.

Mack, the reigning SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week, won her eighth straight decision since March 3 and improved to 11-4 on the season. She fanned six batters versus two walks to secure LSU's 16th shutout of the season.

After a leadoff triple during the first inning, Mack sat down 10 batters in a row. Five of the seven McNeese State runners she stranded were in scoring position.

"We definitely faced a quality opponent tonight in McNeese State, and we knew they were someone we couldn't take lightly," head coach Beth Torina said. "We put Brittany Mack on the mound, approached it like one of the tougher games on our schedule and we found a way to win."

Offensively, LSU was fueled by Allison Falcon's 2-for-3 effort at the plate. Ashley Applegate, Jacee Blades and Ashleigh Kuhn also recorded hits for the Tigers.

"Allison is a tough out at the plate," Torina said. "I feel that she always has quality at-bats and is going to make something happen by putting the ball in play hard. There's no doubt that she's a difference maker in our lineup."

LSU broke through for a trio of runs during the fourth inning. Falcon smashed a one-out single to centerfield, while Applegate followed with a double into the right centerfield gap.

After Lauren Houston was hit-by-a-pitch to fill the bases, Falcon crossed the plate with LSU's first run via a wild pitch, and Applegate alertly scored from second base after a throwing error by MSU catcher Ashley Modzelewski. The Tigers made it 3-0 on a Katie Roux fielding miscue.

LSU tacked on another run in the fifth inning. With runners on the corners, Ashley Langoni and Falcon executed a double steal to perfection to push the lead to 4-0. Falcon got caught in a rundown in between first and second base, which allowed Langoni to sprint home and slide around the tag.

Tiffany Denham was tagged with the loss and fell to 7-3 for the season. She was touched up for four runs, one earned, on five hits.

"Coming off a great weekend at South Carolina, we knew we had to be focused for McNeese State," Falcon said. "We had to play at our best to come in and get the job done. This win contributes to the momentum we are building. Our defense is doing well, our pitching is phenomenal and our hitting is coming along."

**BATON ROUGE** – The No. 23 LSU softball team put a season’s long four-game losing streak in the rear view mirror and notched a 2-1 victory over McNeese State at Tiger Park.

In the process, the Tigers (30-13) emerged with their 30th victory of the season for the 16th consecutive time since softball was reinstated in 1997. LSU also claimed its sixth straight victory over McNeese State (25-13).

Offensively, Ashley Langoni turned in a 2-for-3 performance for her team-leading 11th multi-hit effort of the season. Juliana Santos and Cassie Troclair picked up the RBIs for the Tigers.

“We are lucky to have those two (Santos and Langoni), and they really showed their senior leadership,” head coach Beth Torina said. “They found a way to get it done for us tonight. I can’t say enough about those two and how important they were tonight. Cassie is a very talented player too. She is one that could make the lineup at any time, but she has battled injuries all year. It is nice to see her get an opportunity and get it done.”

Meghan Patterson posted her second straight complete game outing and improved to 4-0 on the season. She sprayed one run on seven hits and worked around a career-high six walks versus three strikeouts.

The Tigers grabbed a 1-0 advantage during the four inning with a two-out rally. Ashley Langoni and Juliana Santos provided consecutive doubles on back-to-back pitches for the game’s first run. Langoni laced her two-bagger into the right centerfield gap, while Santos ripped her double down the left field line.

LSU tacked on an all-important insurance run in the fifth inning. Tammy Wray crushed a leadoff double off the left field wall, inches away from escaping the park. Pinch runner Tammy Vermeulen scooted over to third base on a wild pitch. Two batters later, Cassie Troclair deposited a 1-2 offering into centerfield for a RBI single to enable LSU to increase its lead to 2-0.

“It is all about adjustments,” Troclair said. “We just had to let the ball get deep. We were only up 1-0 with a runner on third, so I just had to put the ball in play and get the run in.”

McNeese State drew back to within 2-1 during the seventh inning after pinch hitter Tiffany Denham placed a two-out, RBI single to left centerfield.

Patterson regrouped and got Dani Price to pop out to Troclair at second base to secure the 2-1 victory. The sophomore right-hander stranded 12 Cowgirl base runners, seven of them in scoring position.

“I think the key to her [Patterson’s] night is that she finished better than she started,” Torina said. “I thought she started really rough but was able to figure some things out. She was able to finish a lot stronger than she started and threw a lot more strikes. It was a lot tougher to hit there at the end. I was happy to see that she continued to improve as the game went on.”

McNeese State’s Bianca Lilly was dealt the loss and dropped to 1-1 for the season. She retired 11 straight LSU hitters to open the game before Langoni and Santos struck for back-to-back doubles. The freshman southpaw tallied two strikeouts against zero walks.
