NEXT UP

No. 2 LSU Opens SEC Slate at No. 9 Georgia

After posting the second-highest team score in the country with a 197.200 in the season opener against Centenary, the second-ranked Fighting Tigers of LSU are set to open up the Southeastern Conference schedule as the Tigers travel to take on No. 9 Georgia. The meet is slated to begin at 6:30 p.m. CT Friday in Stegeman Coliseum. Live audio will be available at www.LSUports.net/live with Mike Smith on the call. LSU is looking to maintain the momentum built at home in the opener when the Tigers tallied the top team, vault, beam and floor scores in the SEC so far. Junior Rheagan Courville recorded the highest all-around total in the country with a 39.600 against Centenary, and junior Jessie Jordan was not far behind at No. 3 nationally with a 39.500. The Tigers will need to count on the leadership of upperclassmen like Courville, Jordan, senior Sarie Morrison and junior Lloimincia Hall if the team is going to carry the momentum through Friday.

STORYLINES

- LSU set the school record for highest score in a season opener as the Tigers posted a 197.200, besting the 196.075 from last year.
- LSU's No. 2 national ranking is the highest team ranking for the Tigers since March 21, 2005 when LSU was also No. 2. The week before that (March 14, 2005) LSU was No. 1.
- LSU is riding a five-meet win streak against Georgia. LSU went 5-0 against the Gym Dogs last season.
- LSU is also looking for its first road win against Georgia in Athens since the SEC Championship in 1990. Last time LSU beat Georgia in Athens in a dual meet was the 1983 season opener, 177.200-174.000.
- Rheagan Courville (No. 1, 39.600) and Jessie Jordan (No. 3, 39.500) are the first LSU duo to be ranked in the Top 5 in the all-around since Ashleigh Clare-Kearney and Susan Jackson in 2009.

NOTEBOOK

Last Time Out

- LSU shattered the school record for highest score in a season opener with a 197.200 in a victory against Centenary. The previous record was a 196.075 set last year against NC State.
- Rheagan Courville captured the all-around (39.600), floor (9.95) and a share of the beam (9.925) titles. Sarie Morrison won vault (9.925) and bars (9.925), while Jessie Jordan also shared the beam title (9.925).
- LSU tallied a 49.425 on vault, 49.125 on bars, 49.250 on beam and 49.400 on floor to get to 197.200.

LSU Ranked No. 2 in the Nation - Highest Team Ranking Since 2005

- After posting the second-highest score in the nation with a 197.200 against Centenary, LSU climbed three spots to No. 2 in the GymInfo national standings.
- It is LSU's highest ranking since March 21, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 2 with a 197.010 regional qualifying score. The last time LSU was ranked higher than No. 2 was March 15, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 1 with a 196.990 RQS.

Rheagan Courville Ranked No. 1 Nationally in the All-Around

- Junior Rheagan Courville is ranked No. 1 in the national all-around standings after she posted a 39.600 in the all-around against Centenary, the highest all-around total in the country. It is the first time an LSU gymnast has earned the top spot in the all-around standings since Courville did it in the initial rankings last season.

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 37TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, three Super Sixes in the last six years and eight individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. In addition, six gymnasts racked up a school-record 15 All-America honors and three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Rheagan Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to

compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Now entering her 37th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 24 times in 36 seasons, finishing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and 2013 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 28 separate occasions, winning regional titles 12 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and the 2013 championship.

Under her leadership, LSU has captured nine individual national titles, 126 All-America honors and 51 All-SEC selections.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

LSU Shatters Season-Opener Scoring Record

- LSU started strong and maintained momentum throughout the meet against Centenary as the Tigers roared to a 197.200 team score, shattering the school record for highest score in a season opener.
- LSU's previous record was set just last year when the Tigers cracked the 196 mark in a season opener for the first time in school history with a 196.075 against North Carolina State on Jan. 4, 2013.
- LSU's Top 5 Season Opener scores: 1) 197.200 - 2014. 2) 196.075 - 2013 [Advanced to Super Six that season]. 3) 195.725 - 2008 [Advanced to Super Six]. 4) 194.900 - 2009 [Advanced to Super Six]. 5) 194.875 - 2004. 6) 194.600 - 2003.

Scouting the Opponent

- Georgia enters the meet coming off a tough stretch in which the Gym Dogs opened the season at Oklahoma last Friday and then turned around and competed at Stanford on Sunday. Georgia lost both meets but came away with solid scores of 196.500 at OU and 196.150 at Stanford.
- Georgia is led by Danna Durante who enters her second season as head coach.
- Georgia ranks ninth nationally with a 196.325 average, ninth on vault at 49.125, fourth on bars at 49.288, eighth on beam at 49.063 and 19th on floor at 48.850. Lindsey Cheek is tied for eighth nationally on vault at 9.90 and tied for 10th on bars at 9.90. Chelsea Davis is ranked ninth on bars with a 9.913 average.

Sarie Morrison Claims SEC Event Specialist of the Week

- LSU senior Sarie Morrison picked up where she left off last season by dominating in the two events she specializes in for the Tigers, scoring a 9.925 to win both the vault and bars titles against Centenary. For her outstanding performances, she was named the SEC Event Specialist of the Week.
- It marks the third time in her career Morrison has earned specialist of the week. She also earned it after the NC State meet on Jan. 4, 2013 and the Arkansas meet on Feb. 15, 2013.

LSU is Present Throughout the Rankings

- LSU is ranked No. 2 in the latest GymInfo Top 25 standings. It is the highest ranking for the Tigers since the 2005 season when LSU was No. 2 (March 21, 2005) and No. 1 (March 14). LSU's No. 5 preseason ranking was the highest in school history.
- LSU in the team rankings: No. 2 on vault (49.425), No. 10 on bars (49.125), No. 3 on beam (49.250), No. 3 on floor (49.400). LSU in individual rankings: Rheagan Courville 1st in the all-around (39.600), 1st on beam (9.925), 2nd on floor (9.95), 18th on vault (9.875). Jessie Jordan 3rd in the all-around (39.500), 1st on beam (9.925), 7th on vault (9.90). Sarie Morrison 3rd on bars (9.925), 4th on vault (9.925). Jessica Savona 9th on floor (9.90). Britney Ranzy 17th on bars (9.875) and 18th on vault (9.875). Ashleigh Gnat 18th on beam (9.85), 22nd on floor (9.875).
- LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 181 consecutive polls. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was nearly 13 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

Returning All-Americans and All-SEC Performers

- LSU returns seven All-Americans and five All-SEC performers in 2014.
- Rheagan Courville is an eight-time All-American, Sarie Morrison is a four-time All-American, Lloimincia Hall is a three-time All-American, Jessie Jordan is a two-time All-American, and Kaleigh Dickson, Maliah Mathis and Randii Wyrick all have one All-America honor.
- Courville, Hall, Jordan, Morrison and Jessica Savona are LSU's returning All-SEC performers, and Courville, Hall and Savona are also SEC champions.
- The Tigers did not lose any All-Americans off last season's roster.

Rheagan Courville - One of the Nation's Top All-Arounders

- Rheagan Courville currently ranks No. 1 in the nation with a 39.600 all-around in the opening weekend. It's the second-straight season she opened the year No. 1 in the all-around standings after she posted a 39.500 to lead the country in last year's opener.
- Courville entered her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a spectacular two seasons with the Tigers.
- As a sophomore in 2013, Courville led the nation with nine all-around titles during the year, and she capped the season by winning the NCAA vault national title, becoming LSU's sixth national champion gymnast.
- Courville leads LSU in individual titles with 48 in her career, including 14 all-around titles.

Sarie Morrison - LSU's Bars Title Record Holder

- Senior Sarie Morrison ranks as one of the top uneven bars performers in LSU history, and the proof is in the numbers.
- Morrison has already captured her first bars title of the season against Centenary in the opener. Morrison shattered the single-season school record with 12 bars titles last season, topping the previous record of nine by Susan Jackson in 2010.
- In her career Morrison has racked up 21 bars titles which ranks No. 1 in LSU history, and she has a chance to create some distance in the record book. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (2005-09) is second with 18 career bars titles.

Lloimincia Hall - One of the Nation's Most Electrifying Floor Performers

- Whether at home or away, the crowd always anticipates the performance they'll see when LSU junior Lloimincia Hall steps onto the floor mat.
- Not only is Hall one of the most entertaining performers on floor, she also ranks as one of the best in the country. Hall ranked No. 1 nationally in the event for most of the 2013 season, and she enters the 2014 season with high expectations.
- Hall tied the LSU single-season record with 10 floor titles last year, equaling the record held by Sandra Smith in 1980 and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney in 2009.
- Hall also ranks 4th in LSU history with 17 career floor titles, trailing Clare-Kearney/April Burkholder (27) and Smith (22).
- Hall is one of seven gymnasts in LSU history to score a perfect 10.0 on floor, and she is one of only three Tigers to do it multiple times as she scored a 10 twice in 2013 while Burkholder produced four 10's in her career and Nicki Arnstad had two.

Three Gymnasts Climbing the LSU All-Time Career Individual Title List

- Rheagan Courville, Sarie Morrison and Lloimincia Hall are all ranked in the Top 20 in LSU's career total individual title list
- Courville ranks No. 8 in school history with 45 career titles, just two shy of seventh place currently held by Angie Topham (1985-88).
- Morrison ranks 12th with 30 career titles, just two shy of 11th place currently held by Amy McClosky (1995-98).
