## No. 3 LSU Ready to Face No. 7 Alabama in Top 10 SEC Showdown

The third-ranked LSU gymnastics team is back in the Maravich Center for the second straight week against an SEC rival as the Tigers face No. 7 Alabama in a matchup of Top 10 teams. It actually marks the fifth-straight contest between the two in which both are ranked in the Top 10 dating back to last season. LSU and Alabama competed four times last season (home and away dual meets, at the SEC Championship and at the Super Six), and the Tigers fell in all four meetings. This season LSU enters the meet as the higher ranked team with three gymnasts ranked inside the Top 10 in the all-around standings for the first time in school history. Rheagan Courville ranks No. 1 nationally while Jessie Jordan and Kaleigh Dickson are tied for seventh. Sarie Morrison, Britney Ranzy, Lloimincia Hall and Jessica Savona are also ranked in the Top 25 in different events to lead the Tigers. As a team LSU ranks in the Top 10 in all four event standings, including No. 3 rankings on vault and beam. LSU is also fifth on floor and seventh on bars. Meanwhile, Alabama is fourth on vault and bars, fifth on beam and 12th on floor. CSS will televise the meet on a tape delay basis with the first airing on Feb. 4 at 8 p.m. CT. LSUports.net will have live video for Geaux Zone members and free live stats.

### STORYLINES

- LSU has posted four straight 197s at home dating back to last season. It's the first time LSU has done that since 2004. LSU has never had five straight home meets with a 197.
- LSU is seeking its first win against Alabama since upsetting the No. 1 Crimson Tide, 196.475-196.050, on Feb. 5, 2010 in the Maravich Center.
- Rheagan Courville (No. 1), Jessie Jordan (No. 7) and Kaleigh Dickson (No. 7) are all ranked in the Top 10 nationally in the all-around. It is the first time since 2007 LSU has had three in the Top 10.
- LSU is 10-2 at home since the 2012 season, and the only two home losses have come at the hands of Alabama.
- In three previous dual meets against Alabama, Rheagan Courville has won the all-around twice: home meets in 2012 and 2013. Courville did not win the AA at Alabama in the first dual meet in 2013.
- LSU posted a 49.525 on floor against Auburn last week, the 10th-best floor score in school history, to rally for the victory.

# D-D Breaux

## HEAD COACH • 37TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, three Super Sixes in the last six years and eight individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. In addition, six gymnasts racked up a school-record 15 All-America honors and three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Rheagan Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to

compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Now entering her 37th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 24 times in 36 seasons, finishing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and 2013 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 28 separate occasions, winning regional titles 12 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and the 2013 championship.

Under her leadership, LSU has captured nine individual national titles, 126 All-America honors and 51 All-SEC selections.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

## NOTEBOOK

### Last Time Out

- LSU rallied to defeat Auburn, 197.175-196.850, to mark LSU's fourth-straight home meet with a 197 score.
- LSU tallied a 49.400 on vault, 49.075 on bars, 49.175 on beam and 49.525 on floor.
- Rheagan Courville won the all-around with a 39.600, her third all-around title in as many meets this season. Courville also won floor with a 9.95, and Jessie Jordan won beam with a 9.925.

### Three Tigers in the All-Around National Top 10 for First Time in History

- Junior Rheagan Courville is ranked No. 1 in the all-around national standings, and junior Jessie Jordan and senior Kaleigh Dickson are tied at No. 7 in the standings. It is the first time in LSU history that three gymnasts are ranked in the all-around Top 10 at the same time.
- It is the first time LSU has had three gymnasts ranked in the all-around standings at the same time since April 9, 2007 when Ashleigh Clare-Kearney was No. 1, Kelly Phelan was No. 23 and Nicki Butler was No. 25.

### LSU With Four Straight 197 Scores at Home; Going for No. 5 Against Alabama

- LSU has tied the school record with four straight home meets with at least a 197 team score. The Tigers posted a 197.050 against Georgia on March 1, 2013, then a 197.500 against Alabama on March 8, 2013, then a 197.200 in the season opener against Centenary, and lastly a 197.175 last week against Auburn.
- The first and only other time LSU has had four straight 197s was in 2004 when the Tigers scored a 197.375 against Kentucky on Feb. 20, 2004, scored a 197.525 versus Auburn on Feb. 27, 2004, 197.525 vs. Ohio State on March 5, 2004, and then earned a 197.500 in the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge on April 2.
- LSU has never had a 197 in five straight home meets. Friday could mark the first time.

### LSU-Alabama Series History

- LSU trails Alabama in the all-time series 15-92-2, and the Tigers are 10-16-2 at home against the Crimson Tide.
- LSU is seeking the first win against Alabama since Feb. 5, 2010 when the Tigers upset No. 1 Alabama in the Maravich Center.

### LSU Posts Highest Score in the SEC Road Opener Since 2005

- LSU recorded a 196.875 at Georgia, which marks the best team total in the first SEC road meet of the season since the Tigers tallied a 197.050 at Alabama on Jan. 21, 2005.
- It is also the second straight season LSU posted a 196.875 in the first SEC competition of the season. The Tigers scored a 196.875 on Jan. 11, 2013 to beat Florida in Baton Rouge.

## LSU Has Been Ranked No. 2 in the Nation - Highest Team Ranking Since 2005

- LSU is ranked second in the national top 25 standings for the second-straight week after scoring a 196.875 at Georgia.
- It is LSU's highest ranking since March 21, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 2 with a 197.010 regional qualifying score. The last time LSU was ranked higher than No. 2 was March 15, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 1 with a 196.990 RQS.

## LSU Shatters Season-Opener Scoring Record

- LSU started strong and maintained momentum throughout the meet against Centenary as the Tigers roared to a 197.200 team score, shattering the school record for highest score in a season opener.
- LSU's previous record was set just last year when the Tigers cracked the 196 mark in a season opener for the first time in school history with a 196.075 against North Carolina State on Jan. 4, 2013.

## Sarie Morrison Claims SEC Event Specialist of the Week Against Centenary

- LSU senior Sarie Morrison picked up where she left off last season by dominating in the two events she specializes in for the Tigers, scoring a 9.925 to win both the vault and bars titles against Centenary. For her outstanding performances, she was named the SEC Event Specialist of the Week.
- It marks the third time in her career Morrison has earned specialist of the week. She also earned it after the NC State meet on Jan. 4, 2013 and the Arkansas meet on Feb. 15, 2013.

## LSU is Present Throughout the Rankings

- LSU is ranked No. 3 in the latest GymInfo Top 25 standings with a 197.083 average. LSU was No. 2 last week, the highest ranking for the Tigers since the 2005 season when LSU was No. 2 (March 21, 2005) and No. 1 (March 14). LSU's No. 5 preseason ranking was the highest in school history.
- LSU in the team rankings: No. 3 on vault (49.417), No. 7 on bars at 49.133, No. 3 on beam at 49.167 and No. 5 on floor at 49.367. LSU in individual rankings: Rheagan Courville 1st in the all-around (39.525), 16th on vault (9.892), 13th on bars (9.875), 10th on beam (9.883) and 24th on floor (9.875). Jessie Jordan: 7th in the all-around (39.425), 5th on beam (9.90). Sarie Morrison: 4th on vault (9.917), 8th on bars (9.883). Jessica Savona: 17th on floor (9.892). Britney Ranzy: 25th on vault (9.875). Dickson: 7th in the all-around (39.425), 13th on floor (9.90).
- LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 183 consecutive polls. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was nearly 13 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

## Three Gymnasts Climbing the LSU All-Time Career Individual Title List

- Rheagan Courville, Sarie Morrison and Lloimincia Hall are all ranked in the Top 20 in LSU's career total individual title list
- Courville ranks No. 7 in school history with 52 career titles.
- Morrison ranks 11th with 33 career titles, just four shy of 10th place currently held by Rachelle Fruge' (1988-91).

## Returning All-Americans and All-SEC Performers

- LSU returns seven All-Americans and five All-SEC performers in 2014.
- Rheagan Courville is an eight-time All-American, Sarie Morrison is a four-time All-American, Lloimincia Hall is a three-time All-American, Jessie Jordan is a two-time All-American, and Kaleigh Dickson, Maliah Mathis and Randii Wyrick all have one All-America honor.
- Courville, Hall, Jordan, Morrison and Jessica Savona are LSU's returning All-SEC performers, and Courville, Hall and Savona are also SEC champions.

- The Tigers did not lose any All-Americans off last season's roster.

### Rheagan Courville - One of the Nation's Top All-Arounders

- Rheagan Courville currently ranks No. 1 in the nation with a 39.525 all-around average. She ranked No. 1 after the first week of competition, the second-straight season she opened the year No. 1 in the all-around standings after she posted a 39.500 to lead the country in last year's opener.
- Courville entered her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a runner-up finish in the all-around at the NCAA Championships last season.
- As a sophomore in 2013, Courville led the nation with nine all-around titles during the year, and she capped the season by winning the NCAA vault national title, becoming LSU's sixth national champion gymnast.
- Courville leads LSU in individual titles with 52 in her career, including 16 all-around titles.

### Sarie Morrison - LSU's Bars Title Record Holder

- Senior Sarie Morrison ranks as one of the top uneven bars performers in LSU history, and the proof is in the numbers.
- Morrison has already captured her first bars title of the season against Centenary in the opener. Morrison shattered the single-season school record with 12 bars titles last season, topping the previous record of nine by Susan Jackson in 2010.
- In her career Morrison has racked up 21 bars titles which ranks No. 1 in LSU history, and she has a chance to create some distance in the record book. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (2005-09) is second with 18 career bars titles.

### Lloimincia Hall - One of the Nation's Most Electrifying Floor Performers

- Whether at home or away, the crowd always anticipates the performance they'll see when LSU junior Lloimincia Hall steps onto the floor mat.
- Not only is Hall one of the most entertaining performers on floor, she also ranks as one of the best in the country. Hall ranked No. 1 nationally in the event for most of the 2013 season, and she enters the 2014 season with high expectations.
- Hall tied the LSU single-season record with 10 floor titles last year, equaling the record held by Sandra Smith in 1980 and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney in 2009.
- Hall also ranks 4th in LSU history with 17 career floor titles, trailing Clare-Kearney/April Burkholder (27) and Smith (22).
- Hall is one of seven gymnasts in LSU history to score a perfect 10.0 on floor, and she is one of only 3 Tigers to do it multiple times as she scored a 10 twice in 2013 while Burkholder produced 4 10's in her career and Nicki Arnstad had 2.

### D-D Breaux In Year 37 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is in its 40th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has been at the helm for nearly all of it as she is in her 37th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 626-396-8.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 126 NCAA All-Americans, 116 NACCG/W Scholastic All-Americans, 51 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 164 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, nine NCAA individual national champions, 30 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and three NCAA Super Six appearances.

### LSU's Schedule Rated Among the Nation's Toughest

- LSU's 2014 schedule has been ranked as the No. 3 toughest schedule according to CollegeGymFans.com and the No. 4 toughest by RoadToNationals.com.
- The Tigers face ranked opponents in every road meet this season: No. 8 Georgia, No. 11 Arkansas, No. 3 Oklahoma, No. 17 Arizona, No. 21 Kentucky and No. 1 Florida.
- LSU will square off against several ranked opponents at home too: No. 13 Auburn, No. 2 Alabama and Kentucky.
