# D-D Breaux

## HEAD COACH • 37TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, three Super Sixes in the last six years and eight individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. In addition, six gymnasts racked up a school-record 15 All-America honors and three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Rheagan Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to

compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Now entering her 37th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 24 times in 36 seasons, finishing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and 2013 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 28 separate occasions, winning regional titles 12 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and the 2013 championship.

Under her leadership, LSU has captured nine individual national titles, 126 All-America honors and 51 All-SEC selections.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

## STORYLINES

- LSU enters the competition riding the momentum of four straight wins over then No. 14 Auburn, No. 7 Alabama, No. 11 Arkansas and No. 2 Oklahoma.
- LSU posted the nation's highest road score with a 197.650 to defeat Oklahoma on Feb. 9.
- This marks LSU's third appearance at the Metroplex Challenge. The Tigers also competed here in 2011, finishing third, and in 2013, finishing second behind Oklahoma.
- LSU has only scored below a 197 once this season with a 196.875 at Georgia. The Tigers are one of only three teams to accomplish that: Florida (196.650), Oklahoma (196.675).
- Sarie Morrison (SEC Specialist of the Week) and Ashleigh Gnat (SEC Freshman of the Week) enter the meet coming off sensational performances at Arkansas and at Oklahoma last week.
- LSU has posted at least one season high in each meet this season. Against OU, the Tigers earned a season high team total, vault and beam. Can LSU continue the streak?

## NOTEBOOK

### Last Time Out

- LSU earned the nation's highest road score with a 197.650 to beat No. 2 Oklahoma.
- LSU tallied a 49.600 on vault, 49.225 on bars, 49.325 on beam and 49.500 on floor. The 49.600 ties as the nation's best vault total this season, and it ranks as the third-best vault score in school history.
- Jessie Jordan won the all-around title with a career-high 39.525, while Sarie Morrison won vault with a 9.975 and bars with a 9.925. Ashleigh Gnat earned the beam title with a season-high 9.90.

### LSU Posted the Nation's Best Road Score

- Two days after beating Arkansas in Fayetteville, LSU went in to Norman, Okla., and defeated the Sooners by posting the nation's best road score with a 197.650.
- The 197.650 also ties LSU's season high. The Tigers also managed a 197.650 at home against Alabama on Jan. 31.
- Oklahoma owns the nation's second-best road score with a 197.575 at Arizona on Jan. 25.
- LSU's 197.650 also ranks as the nation's fifth-highest score overall: 1) Florida 198.050, 2) Florida 197.875, 3) Utah 197.825, 4) Oklahoma 197.700, 5) LSU 197.650 (twice)

### LSU Making Its Third Trek to Metroplex Challenge

- This marks the third time in four seasons that LSU will compete at the Metroplex Challenge. The Tigers competed in the 2011 meet (scoring a 195.550), and LSU was at the 2013 meet last season (scoring a 197.100).
- Last season's Metroplex competition was LSU's first 197 score of the season and the first the Tigers had earned since 2010.
- Just like last season, LSU will open the Metroplex Challenge on bars and will rotate to beam, floor and finally vault.

## LSU Keeps Racking Up 197's; On Pace to Set the School Record

- LSU has posted four straight 197 scores this season, and the Tigers have earned a 197 in five of six meets this year.
- Last season LSU posted four straight 197s (197.700 at SEC's, 197.275 at NCAA Regional, 197.325 at NCAA Semifinal, 197.050 at Super Six).
- The school record for consecutive 197s is eight set in 2004, and the school record for most 197s in a season is eight in 2004 and 2013. LSU has a minimum of seven meets left to tie or break the school record.

## LSU Earned Highest Score in a Dual Meet At Arkansas

- On Feb. 7, LSU tallied a 197.225 in a victory at Arkansas. It marked the highest score the Tigers have ever earned in a dual meet at Arkansas.
- The previous best score at Arkansas was a 196.775 in LSU's first dual meet in Fayetteville in 2004.
- LSU's 197.225 also ranks as the best score in a dual meet against Arkansas, beating out the 196.925 at home in 2005.

## Sarie Morrison and Ashleigh Gnat Take Home SEC Weekly Honors after Double-Meet Weekend

- LSU senior Sarie Morrison was named the SEC Specialist of the Week while Ashleigh Gnat earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors after both Tigers excelled during the double-meet weekend at Arkansas (Feb. 7) and at Oklahoma (Feb. 9).
- Morrison won three titles in the four events she competed, including a season-high 9.975 on vault at OU. Gnat won the first two individual titles of her young career, scoring a 9.90 on vault at Arkansas and a 9.90 on beam at Oklahoma to help the Tigers capture two big road wins.
- It marks the fourth time Morrison has earned specialist of the week in her career, and it is Gnat's first SEC honor.

## "Bugs" (Ashleigh Gnat) Won Her First Individual Title at Arkansas

- LSU freshman Ashleigh Gnat, affectionately known as "Bugs" because of her last name, captured the first individual title of her young career with a 9.90 on vault at Arkansas on Feb. 7.
- Gnat has competed on vault, beam and floor in all five meets this season, scoring season highs of 9.90 (twice) on vault, 9.85 on beam and 9.875 (twice) on floor

## Three Tigers in the All-Around National Top 10 for First Time in History

- On Jan. 27, junior Rheagan Courville was ranked No. 1 in the all-around national standings, and junior Jessie Jordan and senior Kaleigh Dickson were tied at No. 7 in the standings. It was the first time in LSU history that three gymnasts were ranked in the all-around Top 10 at the same time.

- Courville is currently No. 6 in the all-around, while Jordan is No. 7 and Dickson is No. 17.

## LSU Sets School Record With Five Straight 197 Scores at Home

- LSU broke the school record with five straight home meets with at least a 197 team score.
- The Tigers posted a 197.050 against Georgia on March 1, 2013, then a 197.500 against Alabama on March 8, 2013, then a 197.200 in the season opener against Centenary, followed by a 197.175 vs. Auburn, and lastly a 197.650 vs. Alabama.
- The previous best was four straight during the 2004 season when the Tigers scored a 197.375 against Kentucky on Feb. 20, 2004, scored a 197.525 versus Auburn on Feb. 27, 2004, 197.525 vs. Ohio State on March 5, 2004, and then earned a 197.500 in the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge on April 2.
- It also marked the first time in school history LSU had earned a 197 in the first three home meets in a season.

## Lloimincia Hall Named SEC Specialist of the Week After Her Third Career 10.0

- Junior Lloimincia Hall notched the third perfect 10.0 score of her career, all on floor, in the final performance in the victory against Alabama, and she was named SEC Specialist of the Week after her strong outing.
- With three 10s on floor, Hall ranks second in LSU history for most 10s on floor in a career, trailing only April Burkholder who had four 10s in her career from 2003-06.

## LSU is Present Throughout the Rankings

- LSU is ranked No. 3 in the latest GymInfo Top 25 standings with a 197.296 average. LSU was No. 2 earlier this season, the highest ranking for the Tigers since the 2005 season when LSU was No. 2 (March 21, 2005) and No. 1 (March 14). LSU's No. 5 preseason ranking was the highest in school history.

- It is also the second straight season LSU posted a 196.875 in the first SEC competition of the season. The Tigers scored a 196.875 on Jan. 11, 2013 to beat Florida in Baton Rouge.

### LSU Has Been Ranked No. 2 in the Nation - Highest Team Ranking Since 2005

- LSU is ranked second in the national top 25 standings for the second-straight week after scoring a 196.875 at Georgia.
- It is LSU's highest ranking since March 21, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 2 with a 197.010 regional qualifying score. The last time LSU was ranked higher than No. 2 was March 15, 2005 when the Tigers were No. 1 with a 196.990 RQS.

## Rheagan Courville - One of the Nation's Top All-Arounders

- Rheagan Courville currently ranks No. 6 in the nation with a 39.462 all-around average. She ranked No. 1 after the first week of competition, the second-straight season she opened the year No. 1 in the all-around standings after she posted a 39.500 to lead the country in last year's opener.
- Courville entered her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a runner-up finish in the all-around at the NCAA Championships last season.
- As a sophomore in 2013, Courville led the nation with nine all-around titles during the year, and she capped the season by winning the NCAA vault national title, becoming LSU's sixth national champion gymnast.
- Courville is the team leader in individual titles with 56 in her career, including 17 all-around titles.

## Sarie Morrison - LSU's Bars Title Record Holder

- Senior Sarie Morrison ranks as one of the top uneven bars performers in LSU history, and the proof is in the numbers.
- Morrison captured her first bars title of the season against Centenary in the opener. Morrison shattered the single-season school record with 12 bars titles last season, topping the previous record of nine by Susan Jackson in 2010.
- In her career Morrison has racked up 24 bars titles which ranks No. 1 in LSU history, and she has a chance to create some distance in the record book. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (2005-09) is second with 18 career bars titles.

## Lloimincia Hall - One of the Nation's Most Electrifying Floor Performers

- Whether at home or away, the crowd always anticipates the performance they'll see when LSU junior Lloimincia Hall steps onto the floor mat.
- Not only is Hall one of the most entertaining performers on floor, she also ranks as one of the best in the country. Hall ranked No. 1 nationally in the event for most of the 2013 season.
- Hall tied the LSU single-season record with 10 floor titles last year, equaling the record held by Sandra Smith in 1980 and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney in 2009.
- Hall also ranks 4th in LSU history with 18 career floor titles, trailing Clare-Kearney/April Burkholder (27) and Smith (22).
- Hall is one of seven gymnasts in LSU history to score a perfect 10.0 on floor, and she is one of only 3 Tigers to do it multiple times as she scored a 10 twice in 2013 and once in 2014 while Burkholder produced four 10's in her career and Nicki Arnstad had two.

## D-D Breaux In Year 37 as Head Coach

- LSU gymnastics is in its 40th year of existence, and D-D Breaux has been at the helm for nearly all of it as she is in her 37th year as head of the program. Breaux holds a career record of 629-396-8.
- In her time as coach, LSU has produced 126 NCAA All-Americans, 116 NACCG/W Scholastic All-Americans, 51 All-Southeastern Conference selections, 164 SEC Academic Honor Roll members, nine NCAA individual national champions, 30 AIAW or NCAA Championships appearances and three NCAA Super Six appearances.
