POSTGAME NOTES

West Virginia Notes:

WVU fell to 0-5 all-time and 0-2 in NCAA Tournament play versus LSU and 8-10 all time in the NCAA Tournament.

The Mountaineers set a school record for blocked shots in an NCAA Tournament game with five, topping their previous high in an NCAA game of four against Ohio State (2004), Texas (2012) and this past Sunday against Albany.

WVU shot 30.2% for the game (19-of-63); the Mountaineers' lowest previous NCAA Tournament field-goal percentage came against another SEC team when they shot 29.3% versus Vanderbilt in 2008.

Asya Bussie was 13-of-15 from the free-throw line in her 21-point performance Tuesday night. She set the WVU NCAA Tournament game record for free throws made and attempted, originally set by Rosemary Kosiorek at Virginia in 1992 who made 11-of-14 attempts.

Bussie's 21-point game was WVU's third of the NCAA Tournament this season over 20 points, and the 12th time a WVU player has scored 20 or more in an NCAA Tournament game.

The Mountaineers finish the season with a school-record 30-5 record.
