No. 3 LSU Carries Momentum Into NCAA Championships

No. 3 LSU advanced to the NCAA Championships for the 25th time in school history, and the Tigers did it this year in record fashion. LSU posted the nation's highest regional score with a 198.325, a total that also ranks as the highest score in school history. It is the third time this season that LSU has broken the school record high score, and it is the second 198 this year and in program history. The Tigers tallied the highest vault total in program history with a 49.650, the second-best beam total at 49.600 and the third-best floor score at 49.650 to easily outdistance the competition. Junior Lloimincia Hall recorded her third perfect 10.0 of the season and the fifth of her career on floor. Junior Rheagan Courville earned a 39.725 to capture the all-around title, and she also won the vault (9.95) and beam (9.975) titles. Freshman Ashleigh Gnat and senior Sarie Morrison shared the vault title too with 9.95s. LSU will attempt to earn a spot in the NCAA Super Six Finals for the second-straight season and the fourth time overall when the Tigers tangle with Oklahoma, Georgia, Michigan, Stanford and Illinois at 1 p.m. CT on Friday. STORYLINES

- LSU is coming off arguably the best meet in school history: a program-record 198.325 total, record 49.650 on vault, second-highest beam at 49.600, third-highest floor at 49.650.
- LSU is making its 25th appearance at nationals and seeking its fourth Super Six appearance.
- LSU is competing in BJCC Arena for the second time this season. The Tigers went 197.325 to finish third at the SEC Championship.
- LSU will start on the bye before floor. The last time the Tigers had this rotation was the 2010 NCAA Semifinal I when LSU scored a 196.025.
- Rheagan Courville is a reigning NCAA Vault Champion. She is looking to become LSU's third multi-time national champion (Ashleigh Clare-Kearney, Susan Jackson).
- LSU is facing OU for the third time this year (1-1), Georgia for 3rd time (1-1) and Stanford for the 2nd (1-0).

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 37TH SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accolades that include nine NCAA Championships appearances in the last 10 seasons, three Super Sixes in the last six years and eight individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU gymnasts have begun to reach new heights in individual and team success.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish. In addition, six gymnasts racked up a school-record 15 All-America honors and three gymnasts won five individual SEC titles in Rheagan Courville (VT, BB, AA), Lloimincia Hall (FX) and Jessica Savona (FX).

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth, beating out rival Alabama, for the best finish since the current NCAA format was implemented in 1993.

In 2009, LSU made a repeat trip to the Super Six to

compete for the national title, and one day later Breaux and staff coached senior Ashleigh Clare-Kearney to two individual national titles on vault and floor.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 30 years.

Now entering her 37th season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, the fire in Breaux's eyes burns as brightly today as it did on her first day on the job.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 24 times in 36 seasons, finishing a program-best fourth in 1988, fifth in 2008 and 2013 and sixth on four separate occasions.

LSU has also placed among the top three in regional competition on 28 separate occasions, winning regional titles 12 times in four different decades, including back-to-back first-place regional finishes in 2008 and 2009 and the 2013 championship.

Under her leadership, LSU has captured nine individual national titles, 138 All-America honors and 54 All-SEC selections.

For her dedication to the sport and her teams' numerous accomplishments, Breaux has been recognized by her peers time and time again. In the summer of 2009, Breaux received one of the highest honors as she was voted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame.

Last Time Out: LSU Claimed 13th Regional Title in Record Fashion

- LSU posted a school-record 198.325 to easily win the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional, the 13th regional title in program history.
- The Tigers scored a school-record 49.650 on vault, a 49.425 on bars, a 49.600 on beam and a 49.650 on floor.
- Lloimincia Hall tallied her fifth career perfect 10.0 on floor, breaking the school record for most career 10s on floor, while Rheagan Courville won the all-around (39.725), vault (9.95) and beam (9.975) titles. Ashleigh Gnat and Sarie Morrison also shared the vault title with 9.95s.

NCAA Semifinal I Rotation Schedule - LSU Starts on the Bye Before Floor

LSU's History at the NCAA Championships

- Since the first year the NCAA sanctioned gymnastics in 1982, LSU has advanced to the NCAA Championships 25 out of 33 years. LSU's highest finish came in 1988 when the Tigers took fourth place. LSU has advanced to the Super Six Finals three times (2008, 2009 and 2013) since the Super Six format was adopted in 1993. Since 1993, LSU has finished in the Top 10 at the NCAA Championships every time the team made it except in 1997 when the Tigers placed 12th.
- LSU is searching for its fourth Super Six appearance and second straight when the Tigers compete on Friday.

Breaking Down LSU's Best Score in School History: 198.325 in the NCAA Regional

- LSU broke the school record for the third time this season with a 198.325 in the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional. Not only did it clinch LSU's 13th regional title and a berth in the NCAA Championships, but it also marked the third-highest regional score in NCAA history. Georgia has the highest with a 198.575 in the 1998 Athens Regional, and Florida is second with a 198.400 at the 2013 Gainesville Regional.
- In reaching the school-record total, LSU also established three of the best event scores in program history: a school-record 49.650 on vault, the second-best beam total with a 49.600 and the third-highest floor score with a 49.650.
- Lloimincia Hall earned her own school record: a fifth perfect 10.0 on floor, breaking the tie with April Burkholder who had four 10s on floor during her career (2003-06).
- Overall, LSU posted 16 scores of 9.90 or higher in the meet with five on vault, four on beam and floor and three on bars.

Tigers Set School Record with 11 Straight Scores of 197 or Higher

- LSU broke the school record, previously set in 2004, for consecutive scores of 197 or higher by earning a 197.800 against Kentucky on March 14. It marked the ninth consecutive meet in which the Tigers exceeded a 197 team score. The previous record was eight straight meets during the 2004 season.
- LSU recently added to the record with the 11th straight 197 or higher, a 198.325 at the NCAA Regional on April 5.

LSU Has Tallied Seven of the Top 15 Scores in School History This Season

- It can be argued that LSU is having the best season in school history, and the proof is in the numbers.
- LSU has recorded seven team scores that rank in the Top 15 in program history, including the Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 5 scores.

LSU Has Also Established Some of the Best Scores in All Four Events

- Not only has LSU tallied great overall team scores, the Tigers have done it by establishing record scores in all four events.
- In 2014, LSU has earned the top vault (49.650) and floor (49.700) scores in school history as well as the No. 2 bars (49.600) and beam (49.600) totals.
- Overall, LSU has posted four of the top six vault scores in school history, two of the top six bars scores, two of the top six beam scores, and two of the top five floor scores.

Lloimincia Hall Won Her Third Straight SEC Floor Exercise Title - A First in LSU History

- By scoring a 9.95 at the SEC Championship on March 22, junior Lloimincia Hall captured her third-straight SEC Floor title.
- Hall is the first gymnast in LSU history to win three SEC Floor titles in a career. Sandra Smith and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney each won two conference floor titles during their careers.
- Hall's title is not only her third SEC title, it is also the 28th SEC title by an LSU gymnast.

Best Beam Scores Since 2005

- LSU had not posted a 49.400 or higher on beam since 2005.....until now.
- LSU earned the second-best beam total in school history with a 49.600 in the regional, trailing only the record 49.725 at Oklahoma in 2005.
- Before that, the Tigers roared to a 49.450 on beam against Kentucky on March 7, the highest beam score in a meet for LSU since March 13, 2005 when the Tigers recorded a 49.550 at Texas Woman's.
- The 49.450 is tied as the fifth-best beam score in school history, meaning LSU has earned at least one Top 5 score in all four events this season.

LSU Joins Elite Company with Program Record 198 Score

- For the first time in school history, LSU reached the 198 plateau with a 198.050 against Missouri. LSU became only the ninth program in history to earn multiple 198s after the Tigers went 198.325 at the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional.
- The Tigers became just the 13th program in NCAA history to score a 198, joining UCLA (12 198s), Georgia (10), Florida (10), Utah (5), Arizona State (4), Alabama (4), Oklahoma (4), Nebraska (3), Stanford (1), BYU (1), Washington (1) and Iowa State (1).

LSU Earns School Record on Vault with a 49.650 in a Bizarre Turn of Events

- LSU tallied an impressive 49.650 at the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional to shatter the school record in the event. The previous best was a 49.625 at Centenary in 2004 and at the BR Regional in 2008.
- What made the record score more impressive was that it was accomplished by only five gymnasts in the lineup. Kaleigh Dickson injured her foot during the touch warm-up. When it was time for Dickson to leadoff the event, she realized she could not run, so she was forced to take a 0.000.
- Jessie Jordan then acted as a leadoff performer and went 9.90, followed by a 9.90 from Britney Ranzy. Ashleigh Gnat, Sarie Morrison and Rheagan Courville all went 9.95 to wrap up the lineup and earn the school-record total.

Another School Record Falls: Tigers Post 49.700 on Floor

- Not only has LSU set the overall team score record twice this season, but the Tigers also delivered a new program record on floor exercise with a 49.700 against Missouri on Feb. 28.
- The score breaks the previous record high of 49.675 set against Ohio State on March 5, 2004.
- All six gymnasts scored a 9.90 or higher, including Lloimincia Hall's 9.975 in the anchor spot.
- It marks only the second time LSU has ever scored a 49.7-plus in an event. The Tigers went 49.725 on beam at Oklahoma in 2005.

LSU Rose to the Top: The Tigers Reached No. 1

- LSU was No. 1 in the national rankings for three straight weeks after climbing to the top initially on Feb. 24. It was the first time the Tigers have held the top spot in the national standings since 2005.
- LSU has been ranked No. 1 six weeks in school history: Feb. 21, 2005, March 14, 2005, April 21, 2005, Feb. 24, 2014, March 3, 2014 and March 10, 2014.

Another First in School History: Three LSU Gymnasts Ranked No. 1 in Feb. 24 Standings

- For the first time in school history three LSU gymnasts were ranked No. 1 in the national rankings for Feb. 24.
- Rheagan Courville was the nation's No. 1 all-arounder performer with a 39.595 regional qualifying score (RQS), Sarie Morrison was No. 1 on bars with a 9.935 RQS, and Jessie Jordan was No. 1 on beam with a 9.915 RQS. Lloimincia Hall was tied for the highest RQS in the nation on floor with a 9.945, but she ranked No. 2 in the standings. Courville was No. 2 on beam.

Three Gymnasts Climbing the LSU All-Time Career Individual Title List

- Rheagan Courville, Sarie Morrison and Lloimincia Hall are all ranked in the Top 15 in LSU's career total individual title list
- Courville is No. 5 in school history with 69 career titles, five shy of fourth place.
- Morrison ranks ninth with 43 career titles, four away of eighth place currently held by Angie Topham (1985-88).
- Hall ranks 13th with 29 career titles and is three away from tying Amy McClosky for 12th.

Rheagan Courville - One of the Nation's Top All-Arounders; One of the Best in LSU History

- Rheagan Courville currently ranks No. 2 in the nation with a 39.620 all-around average. She ranked No. 1 after the first week of competition, the second-straight season she opened the year No. 1 in the all-around standings after she posted a 39.500 to lead the country in last year's opener.
- Courville entered her junior season as one of the top all-arounders in the country, following a runner-up finish in the all-around at the NCAA Championships last season.
- As a sophomore in 2013, Courville led the nation with nine all-around titles during the year, and she capped the season by winning the NCAA vault national title, becoming LSU's sixth national champion gymnast.
- Courville is the team leader in individual titles with 69 in her career, including 21 all-around titles.
- She is the first LSU gymnast since Ashleigh Clare-Kearney in 2008 to record a 39.600 or higher in the all-around in at least six meets. Courville has done it seven times in 2014, matching Clare-Kearney's total in 2008.

Sarie Morrison - LSU's Bars Title Record Holder

- Senior Sarie Morrison ranks as one of the top uneven bars performers in LSU history, and the proof is in the numbers.
- Morrison captured her first bars title of the season against Centenary in the opener, and she is up to eight titles this season.
- Morrison shattered the single-season school record with 12 bars titles last season, topping the previous record of nine by Susan Jackson in 2010. She ranks third this season with eight.
- In her career Morrison has racked up 28 bars titles which ranks No. 1 in LSU history, and she keeps creating some distance in the record book. Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (2005-09) is second with 18 career bars titles.

Lloimincia Hall - One of the Nation's Most Electrifying Floor Performers

- Whether at home or away, the crowd always anticipates the performance they'll see when LSU junior Lloimincia Hall steps onto the floor mat.
- Not only is Hall one of the most entertaining performers on floor, she also ranks as one of the best in the country. Hall ranked No. 1 nationally in the event for most of the 2013 season, and she is No. 3 in the current 2014 standings.
- Hall tied the LSU single-season record with 10 floor titles last year, equaling the record held by Sandra Smith in 1980 and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney in 2009.
- Hall ranks third in LSU history with 24 career floor titles, trailing Clare-Kearney/April Burkholder (27).
- Hall is one of seven gymnasts in LSU history to score a perfect 10.0 on floor, and she is LSU's all-time record holder for most career 10s on floor with five.

LSU is Present Throughout the Rankings

- LSU is ranked No. 3 in the latest GymInfo Top 25 standings with a 197.720 regional qualifying score. LSU's No. 5 preseason ranking was the highest in school history.
- LSU in the team rankings: No. 1 on vault (49.550), No. 5 on bars at 49.430, No. 4 on beam at 49.295 and No. 4 on floor at 49.490.
- LSU in individual rankings: Rheagan Courville: 2nd All-Around (39.620), 7th Vault (9.940), 13th Bars (9.915), 9th Beam (9.905), 11th Floor (9.935). - LSU has been ranked in the Top 25 in 192 consecutive polls. The last time the Tigers were not ranked in the top 25 was more than 13 years ago - Feb. 26, 2001.

A 10.0 is Not So Uncommon for These Tigers

- LSU is one of a handful of teams this season with more than one perfect 10.0 score. LSU has earned four 10s this year.
- Lloimincia Hall has scored three 10s this season, all on floor, and Rheagan Courville has one on vault. Hall has five 10s in her career, while Courville has two.
- Overall, LSU has three gymnasts on the roster with a 10 in her career: Lloimincia Hall (5 on floor), Rheagan Courville (2 on vault) and Sarie Morrison (1 on vault).
- Hall is now in third place in LSU history with five 10s, trailing Jennifer Wood (9) and April Burkholder (8). She is tied with Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (5).
- With two 10s in her career, Courville is one of only four Tigers with multiple 10s on vault, joining Wood (9), Clare-Kearney (4) and Burkholder (2).

Three Tigers in the All-Around National Top 10 for First Time in History

- On Jan. 27, junior Rheagan Courville was ranked No. 1 in the all-around national standings, and junior Jessie Jordan and senior Kaleigh Dickson were tied at No. 7 in the standings. It was the first time in LSU history that three gymnasts were ranked in the all-around Top 10 at the same time.
- It was the first time LSU has had three gymnasts ranked in the all-around standings at the same time since April 9, 2007 when Ashleigh Clare-Kearney was No. 1, Kelly Phelan was No. 23 and Nicki Butler was No. 25.
- Courville is currently No. 2 in the all-around, while Jordan is No. 9 and Dickson is No. 15.

LSU Sets School Record With Five Straight 197 Scores at Home; Now Up to Nine Straight

- LSU broke the school record with five straight home meets with at least a 197 team score, and the Tigers are up to nine consecutive 197s or higher at home after doing it in the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional.
- The Tigers posted a 197.050 against Georgia on March 1, 2013, then a 197.500 against Alabama on March 8, 2013, then a 197.200 in the season opener against Centenary, followed by a 197.175 vs. Auburn, a 197.650 vs. Alabama, a 198.050 against Missouri, a 197.500 vs. NC State, a 197.800 against Kentucky and a 198.325 in the NCAA Regional.
- The previous best was four straight during the 2004 season when the Tigers scored a 197.375 against Kentucky on Feb. 20, 2004, scored a 197.525 versus Auburn on Feb. 27, 2004, 197.525 vs. Ohio State on March 5, 2004, and then earned a 197.500 in the NCAA Regional in Baton Rouge on April 2.
- It also marked the first time in school history LSU scored a 197 or higher in every home meet in a season.

"Bugs" (Ashleigh Gnat) Continues Outstanding Freshman Campaign

- LSU freshman Ashleigh Gnat, affectionately known as "Bugs" because of her last name, captured the first individual title of her young career with a 9.90 on vault at Arkansas on Feb. 7.
- Gnat has competed on vault, beam and floor in 11 of 13 meets this season, scoring season highs of 9.95 on vault twice, 9.95 on beam three times and 9.925 on floor.
- Gnat's 9.95 on beam against NC State on March 7 is the highest beam score of any freshman in the SEC this season, and it is the best beam score by an LSU freshman since Lisa Rennie scored a 9.95 at the SEC Championship in 2004.
- Gnat posted a 9.95 on beam for the second straight week when she did it against Kentucky on March 14. She is the first LSU freshman to score at least a 9.95 on beam in back-to-back meets since April Burkholder scored a 9.95 and 9.975 in two straight weeks as a freshman in 2003.
- Gnat earned SEC Freshman of the Week twice this season, the first time after great performances during LSU's double-meet weekend at Arkansas and at Oklahoma and the second after the meet against Kentucky.

Jessie Jordan is the SEC Gymnast of the Week After the Missouri Meet

- Junior Jessie Jordan earned SEC Gymnast of the Week after she led the Tigers to a 198.050 against Missouri.
- Jordan shattered her career high in the all-around with a 39.600, and she also won vault with a 9.925 and established a career high on floor with a 9.925.
- It is her first gymnast of the week honor and the second SEC weekly honor of her career. She was freshman of the week once in 2012.

Morrison Earns Her Third SEC Weekly Honor After the Florida Meet

- Senior Sarie Morrison was named SEC Specialist of the Week for the third time this season after her performance at Florida.
- Morrison captured her sixth bars title of the season (and fifth straight) with a 9.95 against the Gators, and she added a 9.90 on vault. It is the fifth time this season Morrison has scored a 9.9-plus on vault and bars in the same meet.

Rheagan Courville is the SEC Gymnast of the Week After the Metroplex Challenge

- LSU junior Rheagan Courville earned her first SEC weekly honor of the season and the sixth of her career (3 Gymnast of the Week, 3 Freshman of the Week) when she was named SEC Gymnast of the Week following her great performance at the Metroplex Challenge.
- Courville tied the nation's highest all-around total (and her career high) with a 39.750 to win the title, and she added a perfect 10.0 on vault to win the title and lead LSU to a school-record 197.875 score.

LSU Upset No. 2 Oklahoma in a Dual Meet in Norman

- On Feb. 9, LSU competed for the second time in three days, but it did not faze the Tigers who earned a 197.650 to beat No. 2 Oklahoma in Lloyd Noble Center. At the time, the 197.650 ranked as the nation's top road score by any team.
- It marked LSU's first win in Norman to improve the record to 1-1. The Tigers only other meet at OU was the 1997 season opener.

Sarie Morrison and Ashleigh Gnat Take Home SEC Weekly Honors after Double-Meet Weekend

- LSU senior Sarie Morrison was named the SEC Specialist of the Week while Ashleigh Gnat earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors after both Tigers excelled during the double-meet weekend at Arkansas (Feb. 7) and at Oklahoma (Feb. 9).
- Morrison won three titles in the four events she competed, including a season-high 9.975 on vault at OU. Gnat won the first two individual titles of her young career, scoring a 9.90 on vault at Arkansas and a 9.90 on beam at Oklahoma to help the Tigers capture two big road wins.
- It marks the fourth time Morrison has earned specialist of the week in her career, and it is Gnat's first SEC honor.

Lloimincia Hall Named SEC Specialist of the Week After Her Third Career 10.0

- Junior Lloimincia Hall notched the third perfect 10.0 score of her career, all on floor, in the final performance in the victory against Alabama, and she was named SEC Specialist of the Week after her strong outing.

LSU Posts Highest Score in the SEC Road Opener Since 2005

- LSU recorded a 196.875 at Georgia, which marks the best team total in the first SEC road meet of the season since the Tigers tallied a 197.050 at Alabama on Jan. 21, 2005.
