Quick Hits

LSU opens its 19th season of softball on Friday afternoon against Memphis in the 2015 Tiger Classic.

LSU takes on Memphis at 4 p.m. before playing Eastern Illinois at 6:30 p.m. at Tiger Park. Memphis, Eastern Illinois, Tennessee State and N.C. State round out this season's opening tournament slate.

The Tigers are 14-4 in season openers all-time.

LSU is 16-2 all-time in home openers.

The Tigers are 3-0 against Memphis all-time as this is the first meeting since 2013.

This is the first meeting against Tennessee State in program history.

LSU is 1-0 against EIU, as this is the first meeting since 1998.

NC State is also first-time opponent for the Tigers, as LSU is a combined 22-6 all-time against current ACC member institutions.

The team will play 20 of their first 25 games at home in Tiger Park.

A Look Back - 2014 Season

- LSU was 38-24 last season, finishing the season in the final of the NCAA Tucson Regional
- The Tigers were 13-11 in the SEC, finishing in a tie for sixth place
- The team finished the season winning 19 of their final 28 games of the season
- The Tigers were 7-2 in neutral site games on the year, winning 19 of their games at home.
- LSU scored double-digit runs in eight of those games
- The .314 batting average by the team last year was the second-highest in program history
- The team's 65 home runs were the most ever by an LSU team in a single year
- LSU had six starters hitting above .300 last season, with seven earning that feat that played in at least 45 games
- The .412 on-base percentage for the team was the highest in program history, and the highest since 2010.
- LSU's .498 slugging percentage was a program single-season record, besting the .475 by the 1998 team.
- Tiger batters were issued a program-high 238 walks during the year, besting the previous record set in 2003
- LSU's 360 runs were the third most by any team in program history, and the most since the 2007 team had 334
- The Tigers had 512 hits as a team over the course of the season, the most since the 2007 team had 546
- The 323 combined RBI by the squad was the second-most ever by an LSU team in a single season
- LSU's pitching staff did not give up a triple during the year, the third time in program history that's happened and the first since 2007
- The defense's .970 fielding percentage was tied for the fifth highest by a unit in program history
