Quick Hits

LSU hits the road for the first time this season, traveling to California to participate in the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs.

Live stats will be available for every LSU game during the classic, available at LSUsports.net/livestats.

The Tigers will play five games in three days, playing San Diego State, Cal State Fullerton, No. 13 Arizona, Nebraska and Northwestern.

LSU is 11-0 on the season, matching the start from the 2007 season which is the second best start to a season in program history.

The team is three wins shy of tying the record for the longest winning streak to open a season which was set by the 2006 team.

The Tigers came back to defeat the Louisiana Tech Lady Techsters 7-5 Tuesday night.

LSU defeated Cal State Fullerton 8-1 in last year's tournament and Northwestern 4-0 in the Tiger Invitational last season.

The Tigers battled with the Arizona Wildcats in last year's regional, making it to the regional final before falling in the finale.

LSU is 1-1 against Nebraska all-time as this is the first meeting since 2002.

This will be the second all-time meeting against San Diego State, as LSU is 1-0 in the first meeting since 1998

A Look Back - Louisiana Tech

- LSU moved to 11-0 on the season after earning a comeback, 7-5 win over the Lady Techsters Tuesday night.
- It was LSU's first true comeback victory of the season.
- The Tigers have never lost to Louisiana Tech in program history and moved to 14-0 all-time against the Lady Techsters.
- LSU is 153-13 all-time against in-state opponents.
- LSU finished with 11 hits against Louisiana Tech, the eighth time this season the team has earned double-digit hits in a game this year.
- The Tigers have scored fewer than six runs just three times in 11 games so far in 2015.
- LSU has outscored their opponents 70-13 this year.
- The Tigers scored two runs in the first inning against Louisiana Tech, giving the team 18 runs in the opening frame this year. The most of any inning on the season.
- LSU has scored double-digit runs in four of seven total innings in 2015.
- The Tigers are 6-0 when scoring in the first inning and 8-0 when scoring first.
- LSU has been out-hit just once this year.
- Savannah Jaquish hit the first walk-off home run to end a regulation game since Bianka Bell against Tennessee last season.
- Three of Jaquish's four home runs are of the three-run variety.
- Constance Quinn hit her first home run of the season, coming in the second inning to make it 3-0 LSU at that point.
- Eight different LSU players ended the game with at least one hit against the Lady Techsters.
- The Tigers already have 100 hits on the season already, as 35 are for extra bases.
- LSU's three errors against Louisiana Tech is the most in a single game for the team, committing five over the last two.
- The Tigers used three pitchers in one game for the first time all season.
- The five runs for LaTech are the most an opponent has scored against LSU so far this season.
