Quick Hits

LSU closes the non-conference tournament schedule this weekend, hosting the Purple and Gold Challenge at Tiger Park Fri.-Sun. The Tigers open with Stephen F. Austin and will play them twice, taking on Ball State, Florida Atlantic and Northwestern State just once. However, LSU will play Northwestern State in a single game next Tuesday back in Tiger Park. Live stats will be available for every LSU game during the classic, available at LSUsports.net/livestats. This is the Tigers' second-to-last non-conference weekend of the season, hosting a two-game series against Oklahoma in March. This is the 24th time in program history that LSU has earned at least one double-digit winning streak during the course of a season and the first since 2012. This is the 10th winning streak of 15 games or longer, and the longest since the 2010 team rattled off 24-straight, which is still the program record. The 1999 team is the only squad in program history to have three double-digit winning streaks in the same season. This is the fourth 16-game win streak for any LSU team, the first since the 2004 season. Every team that has won 15 or more games in a row on the season has won no less than 44 games, with five winning more than 50. LSU will be looking to keep its home mark unblemished which currently stands at 11-0. Ball State's head coach is former LSU standout and Zachary, Louisiana, native Tyra Perry. This is the third all-time meeting against BSU, the first since 2008 with LSU leading the series 2-0. LSU is 7-1 all-time against Stephen F. Austin, as this is the first meeting since 2006. Florida Atlantic is 13-1 on the season, as this is only the third-ever meeting between the Tigers and Owls. It's the first since the 2008 season. The Tigers defeated Northwestern State 5-3 last season in Natchitoches and is 23-0 all-time against the Lady Demons.

A Look Back - Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic

- LSU is 16-0 on the season after going 6-0 last weekend with wins against Louisiana Tech and at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs.
- LSU jumped up seven spots to No. 7 in the NFCA poll and USA Softball poll, the first time the Tigers have been in the top 10 since April of 2013.
- LSU is off to its best start in program history, surpassing the 14-straight wins the 2006 team earned to open that season.
- This is the longest winning streak in Beth Torina's coaching history, surpassing the 12-game one she had during her first season at LSU in 2012.
- This is the first winning streak for an LSU that has lasted longer than 15 games since the 2010 group set the record for consecutive wins at 24.
- LSU earned wins over San Diego State, Cal State Fullerton, No. 13 Arizona, Nebraska and Northwestern over the weekend.
- The matchup against Arizona was the third top 25 contest for LSU and is currently 3-0 in those games.
- LSU outscored all six opponents 45-11 over the weekend. In the Mary Nutter games alone, LSU outscored the five opponents 38-6.
- Of LSU's 49 hits last weekend, 16 were for extra bases with eight doubles, two triples and six home runs.
- LSU is hitting .352 as a team on the year, hitting .363 last week. 44 of LSU's 45 runs were driven in as RBIs against their opponents.
- The Tigers have three double-digit scoring games this season, including having two on Saturday against the Cornhuskers and Wildcats.
- The Tigers have earned double-digit hits nine times this year.
- Six wins have come via run-rule for LSU. The Tigers sported a 1.32 earned run average against opponents last week, with an opponent batting average of .238.
- On the season the team has an ERA of 1.03. 12 of the pitching staff's 16 combined victories have come from complete-game efforts, including seven shutouts and three saves.
