Quick Hits

LSU travels for the first time in league play, taking on top-ranked and defending national champion Florida Gators this weekend in Gainesville. Games two and three of the series will be shown live on the SEC Network and available through SEC Network+ through WatchESPN. ESPN 104.5/9 will carry all three games on the weekend with Patrick Wright on the call. LSU moved up to a tie for No. 3 in the NFCA poll and No. 2 in the USA Softball poll. This is the highest regular season ranking for LSU in the NFCA poll since being third in 2004, while this is the first time LSU has been No. 2 in the USA Softball poll since May 2004. LSU is 3-0 against ranked teams at the time of competition already this season. This is only the second time LSU has played away from Baton Rouge this season, although this is the first true road series for the group as the other was the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs. This is the second consecutive season that LSU has played Florida when the Gators have been ranked No. 1 in the country at the time of competition. It's the first time LSU will play No. 1 Florida in Gainesville, as the other two instances have both been in Baton Rouge. Of the 22 times LSU has played the No. 1 team in the country, Florida has been the team played the most with six, and after this weekend nine. The next closest team is Arizona with four games. The Tigers are 7-15 all-time against No. 1-ranked teams, as LSU will be looking for its first win over a top-ranked team on the road since May 26, 2006. LSU holds a 30-22 record over Florida in the all-time series history. The Tigers and Gators split the last meeting in Gainesville in 2012, although the Gators won an SEC tournament game in Alabama later in the season. Of those three meetings that season, each game was decided by just one run. Florida took two of the three games in Baton Rouge last season, as the first two games of that series was decided by only one run. LSU enters the series with the third best offense in the SEC at .375, while Florida clocks in with the lowest ERA at 0.76.

A Look Back - Arkansas

- LSU improved to 25-0 on the year and 3-0 in SEC play with a sweep of Arkansas over the weekend.
- This is the first time since Georgia in 2008 that LSU has swept an opening series conference opponent.
- The Tigers outscored the Razorbacks 23-1 over the course of the series, outhitting Arkansas 26-10.
- The one run given up on Sunday snapped a 27-inning shutout streak for the Tigers on the week.
- LSU hit .371 in the series, as nine of the team's 23 hits were for extra bases.
- The Razorbacks hit just .143 against LSU pitching, as the Tigers used just three pitchers all weekend, while Arkansas used two each contest.
- The LSU pitching staff held a spotless earned run average over the weekend, while Arkansas' was 8.75.
- In game one, LSU defeated the Razorbacks 10-0 in five innings, scoring the second-most runs in an SEC home opener and run-ruling an SEC hope opening opponent for just the second time in team history.
- The Tigers scored all 10 runs over the course of the third and fourth inning, while preserving the shutout in the very next frame to end the game.
- Bianka Bell went 3-for-3 with a double, triple, RBI and two runs scored in the contest, while Bailey Landry tied her career high in RBIs with three on two hits with two runs scored.
- Carley Hoover pitched the entire game and allowed just two hits, one in the first and one in the fifth, striking out nine with a walk.
- The Tigers clinched the series on Saturday, scoring in the first, third and sixth inning in a 6-0 win.
- Arkansas committed two errors and earned just four hits, while LSU committed none and had nine hits.
- In her first at-bat of the game, Bell set the all-time career home run mark with a solo shot in the first for the 34th of her career. She went 2-for-4 in the game with three RBIs and a double.
- Bailey Landry set the new program hitting streak record, extending it to a program-best 16 games.
- A.J. Andrews and Emily Griggs each had two hits in the contest.
- Allie Walljasper earned her eighth win of the season, striking out four with a walk in her seventh complete game of the year and fourth shutout.
- The Tigers needed just two innings to plate seven runs, earning the sweep with a 7-1 win on Sunday.
- LSU was only up two, before exploding for five runs in the fourth to go up seven and seal the victory.
- Bell was intentionally walked twice in the game and three times overall, as on the second time to load the bases, Savannah Jaquish hit her second grand slam of the season to make it five runs in the inning and 7-0.
- Jaquish was also intentionally walked twice on the weekend.
- Jaquish went 2-for-4 with four RBIs and a run scored.
- Landry was the only other player to earn multiple hits in the contest, extending her hitting streak to 17 games going 2-for-3 with an RBI and run scored.
- Kelsee Selman earned a season-high nine strikeouts in the win to move to 5-0, allowing an unearned run on four hits with two walks in her longest outing of the season.
