Quick Hits

LSU continues a four-game home stand with the No. 6 Oklahoma Sooners this weekend in Baton Rouge. Game times for the two-game set are 6 p.m. both days. Friday's game will be televised on ESPNU with Holly Rowe and Jessica Mendoza, while Saturday will be streamed live on SEC Network+. ESPN 104.5/9 will carry both games locally in Baton Rouge and in the Geaux Zone. The Tigers improved to 28-1 on the season after a 6-1 win over Nicholls Tuesday night in Baton Rouge. LSU has won the last 24 non-conference home games dating back to the 2014 season. The Tigers have already eclipsed last year's home win total of 19, as they have won at least 20 home games for the first time since 2013 and the 17th time in team history. LSU is hitting .377 in games at Tiger Park so far this season, outhitting its opponents 198-82, averaging 9.43 hits to the visitor's 3.90. The Tigers are outscoring their opponents 232-46 on the season, as at home they have outscored teams 167-23 and scoring on average 7.95 runs per game to 1.10. The Tigers are 6-7 all-time against Oklahoma in the series, dropping both games last year in heartbreaking fashion 2-1 and 3-2. This is the third time that the Sooners will be playing in Baton Rouge and only the second time ever in the regular season. Oklahoma is riding a 14-game winning streak after defeating Wichita State on Tuesday 8-2. OU played six games in four days after hosting a home tournament over the weekend. Head coach Patty Gasso won her 1,000th game at OU this past weekend, as she is the seventh opposing head coach to come to the new Tiger Park with 1,000 career wins. The Co-National Players of the Week will be squaring off this weekend in LSU's Bianka Bell and OU's Shelby Pendley. Oklahoma is hitting .403 as a team, with a 1.99 combined pitching staff ERA. OU's Lauren Chamberlain is four home runs away from tying the all-time home run record and five away from breaking it.

A Look Back - Nicholls

- LSU won its first game as the No. 1 team in the country in a 6-1 victory over the Nicholls State University Colonels Tuesday night.
- The Tigers improved to 28-1 all-time against Nicholls in the series history.
- Nicholls was just the eighth team this season to score first on LSU.
- For the second consecutive game, LSU came back unabated by scoring six unanswered runs from the third inning on to cruise to the win.
- LSU had eight hits on the night, as they only have four games this season with fewer than seven hits in a contest.
- The Tigers have outhit their opponents in each of the last 11 games, and have only been outhit by the opponent just three times.
- Of LSU's eight hits on the day, five were for extra bases as all were doubles. Its the most the team has had in one game this season.
- It was the sixth time this season that the Tigers had five hits for extra bases in a contest.
- It was also the sixth time the LSU offense has had one strikeout or less in a game.
- The most hits LSU pitching has given up this season is nine twice, however, they have held their opponents to four hits or less in a game 19 times.
- Nicholls was the 22nd team this season to be held to one run or less in a game this year by LSU.
- The Tigers produced another clean sheet with no errors in the game, improving to 14-0 when not committing a miscue.
- Opponents are 1-22 when committing at least one or more errors against the Tigers this year.
- Bianka Bell earned her second four-hit game of her career, her second in the last four games, while having four RBI's going a perfect 4-for-4 with a double in the contest.
- Bailey Landry extended her hitting streak to 21 games in the win, scoring three times to tie her career high from earlier this season.
- Kellsie Kloss extended her hitting streak to a career-long seven games with a double against Nicholls on Tuesday.
- Emily Griggs hit the second double of her career against Nicholls, scoring once on the night.
- Kailey McCasland was the final player to earn a hit for LSU on the night, roping a double in one of her two at-bats on the night.
- Baylee Corbello earned her seventh win of the season and her fifth complete-game win of the season, striking out six.
- Corbello retired the side in four of the seven innings on the night, as Nicholls got a runner past second base just twice on the night.
- She has four games with at least six strikeouts and five games with two or fewer walks in a contest.
- Nicholls struck first in the top of the third inning to take a 1-0 lead after two hits in the inning, as LSU came back in the bottom of the third to tie it up on a Bell base knock.
- Bell came back with a two-RBI single to break the tie and give LSU the 3-1 lead in the fifth.
- Andrews earned her fourth sac fly of the night to bring in a run to make it 4-1, with a wild pitch scoring another to give LSU a 5-1 lead.
- Bell capped the night with a single to score Landry, who earned a walk and moved to second and third after wild pitches to score the final run of the game.
