Quick Hits

LSU closes a four-game home stand on Tuesday, hosting the South Alabama Jaguars at 6 p.m. at Tiger Park. The game will be shown live on the SEC Network with Trey Bender and Michelle Smith. Radio coverage will begin 15 minutes before the game on ESPN 104.5/9 and in the Geaux Zone. LSU improved to 30-1 after taking two games over the weekend against No. 6 Oklahoma in Baton Rouge. The team is 7-1 in games against teams in the Top 25. LSU is 25-0 against non-conference opponents in 2015. The Tigers are 23-0 at home and have won 24 consecutive games against non-conference opponents at home. LSU has outscored its opponents 66-7 in the first inning of games this year. The Tigers have scored multiple runs in 54 innings this season. The team is 22-1 when scoring first in games this year. LSU is 24-0 when holding opponents to two runs or less. The Tigers have run-ruled 13 opponents this season. When scoring 10 or more runs in a game, LSU is 11-0. LSU is 6-2 all-time against South Alabama in program history. The two teams split a pair of games last year, with the Jaguars earning a 2-1 victory last February, with a 6-1 win by the Tigers that April. Tuesday marks the return of former LSU All-American pitcher Rachele Fico, who is now an assistant coach at South Alabama. LSU will play Sun Belt teams in consecutive weeks with USA Tuesday and ULM next week.

A Look Back - Oklahoma

- LSU took both non-conference games against Oklahoma over the weekend, earning the team's third series win of the season in a row.
- The Tigers have now played eight games against teams ranked in the Top 25 at the time of competition, with five of those games against teams in the Top 10.
- LSU outscored the Sooners 11-2 over the course of the weekend, holding the high-powered OU offense to a .152 batting average and just seven hits.
- LSU earned 12 hits against Sooner pitching, as the Tigers outslugged OU .583-304 with five home runs among their 12 hits to their two.
- The two home runs for Oklahoma came from players other than Lauren Chamberlain, who is currently chasing the all-time home run record and Shelby Pendley who had seven last weekend in Norman.
- Although both teams came in with two of the top five offenses in the country, game one featured just four hits and one run scored in a 1-0 win for LSU.
- The Tigers were the first team this season to shut out Oklahoma, holding the Sooners to its lowest hit output all year.
- Bianka Bell had the go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the sixth inning to give LSU the only lead it would need for the rest of the game.
- Constance Quinn had the only other hit for LSU in the contest.
- Carley Hoover pitched her third two-hitter of the season and her second shutout by striking out five OU batters and allowing just one runner to second base and three total in the game
- Both teams combined for six home runs in game two, but LSU blew past Oklahoma to put up crooked numbers in multiple innings to win 10-2 in six, the first time OU has been run ruled this season.
- The Tigers scored six runs in the final two innings to end the contest, putting up multiple runs in three of the six innings.
- LSU had four home runs as a group, tying the most for the Tigers in a game this year.
- It was LSU's third double-digit scoring and double-digit hitting game in its last four overall.
- Bianka Bell had two of the home runs, as it was her first multi-home run game this season and just second for an LSU player this year.
- She drove in four RBIs for the third time this season.
- Bell and Savannah Jaquish had back-to-back home runs for the first time this season and the first time the Tigers have had this happen all year.
- Jaquish and Bell are both tied for the team lead in home runs with 12.
- Kellsie Kloss was the last one to homer for the Tigers, hitting her fifth of the season on a solo shot.
- Bell, Jaquish and Kloss were the only LSU players with multiple hits.
- Allie Walljasper only gave up two runs, both on solo home runs, while allowing five hits in the win and striking out six on the day.

New to Poll: No. 24 Mississippi State
