Quick Hits

LSU closes out a four-game home stand with a three-game SEC series against the Ole Miss Rebels at Tiger Park. All three games will be streamed online on SEC Network+ through WatchESPN. Patrick Wright will call all of the action on ESPN 104.5/9 locally in Baton Rouge, with audio provided in the Geaux Zone. Game one of the series on Friday begins at 6 p.m., as the teams will play a doubleheader on Saturday beginning at 2 p.m. for the first game, then 30 minutes following the conclusion of the first contest. Saturday is the first of two scheduled doubleheaders for the team, with the other coming in two weeks at McNeese State. LSU remained unbeaten at home, defeating the ULM Warhawks 7-3 Tuesday night. The Tigers have won at least 25 games at home for the first time since the 2013 season and 13th time in program history. LSU is five wins shy of tying its entire win total from the 2014 season. The Tigers have outscored their opponents 193-28 in home games so far this season. At Tiger Park, LSU is averaging nearly nine hits and seven runs scored per contest. Of LSU's 241 RBI's 110 have come with two outs on the board. 101 of the team's 318 hits have come with two outs. Outscoring their opponents 69-9 in the first inning, LSU has not scored in the opening frame in each of their last four games. LSU swept Ole Miss last season in Oxford, outscoring the Rebels 26-6. The Tigers are 47-7 all-time against the Rebels in program history. Ole Miss comes into the game winners of their last seven games overall, including sweeps of both Mississippi State and Arkansas to sit at 5-7 in SEC play.

A Look Back - ULM

- LSU earned its second-straight win after defeating the ULM Warhawks 7-3 Tuesday night in Baton Rouge.
- With the win the team remained undefeated at home in 2015 and extended its unbeaten streak against non-conference opponents at home to 24.
- It was the second consecutive win over an opponent from the Sun Belt after defeating South Alabama last Tuesday in Baton Rouge.
- The win snapped ULM's five-game winning streak they entered the contest with.
- LSU has yet to drop a Tuesday game this year, moving to 5-0.
- The Tigers spotted the Warhawks a 2-0 lead in the very first inning before scoring six-straight runs over the course of the second and third inning to take the lead back.
- The Tigers got an insurance run in the sixth to make it 7-2, with ULM getting another run in the seventh and leaving the bases loaded.
- ULM outhit the Tigers 9-7 over the course of the game, being just the fifth team this year to outhit the team in a contest and the fourth to outhit the team and lose.
- The Tigers played error-free against ULM, improving to 17-0 when committing no errors, while ULM had one and used it to capitalize improving to 26-3 when the other team has at least one.
- Bailey Landry earned a career-high four RBI's and went 3-for-3 in the game, as all of her runs driven in came on two-RBI singles.
- Landry, who is on a five-game hitting streak, tied the game in the second, then gave LSU a 6-2 lead in the third on another hit.
- Savannah Jaquish hit her 14th home run of the season and drove in two runs and scored once against the Warhawks.
- Jaquish has hit each of LSU's last three home runs.
- Emily Griggs got her fourth hit in the last two games as she went 1-for-3 with an RBI and run scored.
- Constance Quinn tied her season and career high of two runs scored, as she went 1-for-3 against the Warhawks.
- Sandra Simmons and Kailey McCasland each produced sacrifice hits, as Simmons increased her team-leading number to seven while McCasland earned her first.
- A.J. Andrews drew three walks which was a season high, while stealing two bases for the third time this season.
- Kelsee Selman earned the start in the circle for LSU, getting two outs, but giving up both runs on three hits before being relieved by Carley Hoover.
- Hoover struck out the first batter she saw and 10 more after that, earning a new career high with 11 as she improved to 9-2 on the year.
- She threw strikes on each of her first 14 pitches, tossing 73 total on 97 pitches.
