Quick Hits

LSU continues its six-game road trip this weekend, opening a three-game SEC series against Tennessee Friday at 5:30 p.m. in Knoxville.

Game times for the series are 5:30 p.m., 4 p.m. and 1 p.m. CT on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

All three games can be heard on ESPN 104.5/9 locally in Baton Rouge and in the Geaux Zone.

Saturday's game will be televised on ESPN with Beth Mowins and Jessica Mendoza. Sunday's game will be streamed online on SEC Network+.

LSU is coming off of a 9-4 loss to Mississippi State on Wednesday night in Starkville, dropping a non-conference game for the first time this season.

The Tigers are 1-1 in games after losses this year.

LSU has not lost more than two games in a row this season.

The Tigers have earned 13 hits in each of their last two games, earning double-digit hits in three of their last five games overall and 18 times this season.

The Tigers took two of three games from Tennessee last season in Baton Rouge when UT was ranked second in the nation at the time.

Tennessee leads the all-time series 26-22 with one tie.

LSU is looking for its first series win at Tennessee in program history.

UT is 2-2 in their four SEC series' this year, earning series wins over Georgia and Missouri, while dropping two to South Carolina and Auburn.

A Look Back - Mississippi State

- LSU dropped its first non-conference game of the year, falling 9-2 to the Mississippi State Bulldogs on Wednesday night in Starkville.
- With the loss, LSU has now dropped its last two games against Mississippi State.
- The Tigers outhit the Bulldogs in the contest 13-11, falling for just the second time this season when outhitting the opponent in a contest.
- The 11 hits by MSU are the most given up by the LSU pitching staff this season.
- LSU is 5-2 when scoring three to five runs in a game this year.
- It was only the second time this year that LSU has given up more than five runs in a game, falling to 1-1 when opponents score five or more runs in a game this year.
- LSU stranded double-digit runners on base for just the third time this season leaving 10 on, falling to 0-3 when leaving double-digits stranded in contests.
- The Tigers struck out just twice on the night, and have only struck out five times in their last five games.
- Mississippi State scored three runs in the first two innings, scoring two more in the fourth to take a 5-0 lead over LSU after four.
- LSU scored two runs in the top of the fifth to pull within three at 5-2 midway through five.
- After two scoreless half innings, MSU exploded for four to go up 9-2, as LSU scored two more in the top of the seventh and eventually left the bases loaded in the loss.
- Bailey Landry went 3-for-4 with an RBI and two runs scored, extending her hitting streak to nine.
- Savannah Jaquish went 3-for-3 with two RBIs, setting the single-season record for multi-RBI games in a season with 18.
- Dylan Supak extended her hitting streak to a career-long four games, going 2-for-4.
- A.J. Andrews, Bianka Bell, Kelsi Kloss and Emily Griggs each had hits for the team on the night.
- Allie Walljasper suffered her second loss of the season in her shortest outing, allowing three runs, two earned, in 1.2 innings with a walk and two strikeouts.
- LSU used three of their four pitchers, as Carley Hoover and Baylee Corbello each came on in relief.
- Hoover pitched the bulk of the game lasting 3.1 innings, but not before allowing four runs, two earned, on four hits with four strikeouts and four walks.
- The four walks tied a season-high this year for Hoover.
- Corbello pitched one inning and allowed two unearned runs on two hits with a strikeout.
