Quick Hits

LSU opens the final three weekends of league play on Saturday, hosting the Texas A&M Aggies for a three-game series at Tiger Park. The series takes place on Saturday, Sunday and Monday with all three games scheduled for 6 p.m. in Baton Rouge. Saturday's game is scheduled for SEC Network+, while Sunday and Monday's games will both be on the SEC Network. Adam Amin and Amanda Scarborough will call the game for the network. Patrick Wright will call all three games over the weekend on ESPN 104.5/9, with audio available in the Geaux Zone on LSUsports.net.

This is the first of two consecutive weekends for LSU with the Saturday-Monday schedule, doing the same against Missouri next weekend in Columbia.

The series opener on Saturday is the fourth-annual "Strikeout Ovarian Cancer" game, with the third-annual Geaux Teal walk taking place earlier that morning at the field.

LSU will be wearing special teal jerseys in honor of the occasion, as the Tigers are undefeated in this game since its inception in 2012.

Last year's game featured a walk-off triple to defeat Georgia.

In the short history of the event, LSU has won all three games by scores of 2-1, 8-0 and 5-4 since 2012.

LSU is one win away from winning 40 games for the first time since 2013 and third time under head coach Beth Torina.

It would be the 16th time an LSU team has won no less than 40 games in a season.

The team is two SEC wins away from tying its entire league win total from last year.

The Tigers are 6-3 against Texas A&M all-time.

This is the first meeting between the two sides as SEC foes in Tiger Park, as LSU won the first-ever league series at A&M in

A Look Back - McNeese State

- LSU closed out its season-long road trip with a 13-4 win over the McNeese State Cowgirls at Cowgirl Diamond in Lake Charles on Wednesday.
- With the win LSU eclipsed its entire win total from 2014 and finished the road swing 3-2 and is now 6-5 in games away from Tiger Park this season.
- McNeese was the 16th win by run rule for LSU this season.
- It was the second time in the last seven games that the Tigers have run-ruled an opponent, with the last coming against Ole Miss.
- It was the 12th double-digit scoring game for LSU this season, with the last coming against Oklahoma in March.
- The 12 hits by the team was the 19th time this year that LSU has earned double-digit hits in a game.
- The team has only dropped one game this season when earning 10 or more hits.
- LSU is a combined 38-3 when holding opponents to five runs or fewer in games this year.
- The Tigers were walked a season-high 10 times in the game, as McNeese used four pitchers in the game.
- LSU spotted the Cowgirls two runs in the opening inning after committing two errors, but went on to score all 13 runs over the course of the second, third and fourth innings.
- The Cowgirls didn't score again until hitting a two-run home run in the bottom of the fifth, only earning two hits total on the day.
- Eight different LSU players earned hits, with four having multiple hits.
- Bailey Landry extended her hitting streak to 13 games, going 2-for-2 with two RBIs and a run scored.
- Landry has reached base in 41 consecutive games.
- Bianka Bell went 2-for-3 with two RBIs and a walk, while Savannah Jaquish went 2-for-2 with a run scored and two walks and Sandra Simmons went 2-for-2 with three runs scored and two walks.
- Alayna Falcon earned new career highs in RBIs and runs scored, going 1-for-2 by hitting the team's fifth grand slam of the year.
- It was Falcon's first career home run, hitting it over the scoreboard in left field.
- Taylor Lockwood earned her first collegiate hit, while Kelsi Kloss had one hit to extend her hitting streak to seven games which ties her career high and Kailey McCasland also earning a hit.
- Allie Walljasper earned her 11th win of the season by holding McNeese to two unearned runs on one hit in four innings with three walks and a strikeout.
- The one hit allowed was a season low for the freshman in a start.
- Baylee Corbello pitched the final inning, allowing two runs on one hit with a walk and a strikeout.
- Corbello and fellow Lake Charles native Layna Savoie both saw time in the game, with Savoie coming on to pinch run and scoring a run.
