Quick Hits

LSU hits the road for the final time in the regular season by traveling to take on the Missouri Tigers in Columbia. The Tigers are playing in their second consecutive Saturday-Sunday-Monday series of the season. Saturday and Sunday's games are going to be shown online on SEC Network+, with Monday's game airing on the SEC Network at 6 p.m. Adam Amin and Amanda Scarborough will call the action on the Network. All three games will be aired on ESPN 104.5/9 locally in Baton Rouge and online through the Geaux Zone with Patrick Wright. LSU has won five of its six SEC series this season, sitting a half-game out of first place in the league standings with two weekends left to play. LSU is 7-3 in its last 10 games overall. The Tigers are 13-5 against Top 25 teams this season and 21-6 against teams ranked in the top 50 of the RPI. LSU is 6-5 in road games this year. For just the second time in program history LSU has three players with double-digit home runs, the first time since 2008. The Tigers were outhit in each of the last two games, the first time that has happened all season. LSU has committed at least one error in each of the last nine games, 16 total, accounting for 12 unearned runs crossing the plate. The team is 19-0 when committing no errors in a game and 22-6 when committing one or more. LSU is 6-3 all-time against Missouri in program history. This is the third three-game series featuring the two sides since 2012, as LSU upset Missouri in the Super Regional there in 2012. The Tigers last defeated Missouri 6-0 last year in the team's opening game of the SEC tournament. Missouri claimed the last three-game series against LSU in 2013, taking two of three in Baton Rouge.

A Look Back - Texas A&M

- LSU earned its fifth SEC series victory of the year, taking two of three against the Texas A&M Aggies at home in Tiger Park over the weekend.
- The Tigers continued their best start in program history, while jumping out to the second best start in league history as well.
- LSU took the first two games by scores of 6-1 and 6-3, before dropping the finale 5-2 on Monday.
- By winning the first two, LSU tied the longest home winning streak in program history at 30, while becoming the first team to do it in a calendar year.
- The Tigers have now taken the last two series against the Aggies.
- In the series opener, LSU scored five straight runs in the final three innings to pull ahead of the Aggies and cruise to the win.
- Texas A&M stranded eight runners on base over the course of the contest.
- Eight of nine LSU batters earned at least one hit on the night, with the top of the order in A.J. Andrews, Bailey Landry and Bianca Bell having two each for the team's 11 total.
- All of the team's RBIs came from the middle and bottom of the order.
- Carley Hoover earned the complete-game win after holding Texas A&M to one run on five hits with six strikeouts on 143 pitches.
- In game two, LSU started the scoring early by scoring all six of their runs in the first four innings, while thwarting off a few Aggie rallies in the process.
- This time, Texas A&M stranded seven runners on base to LSU's five, outhitting LSU 9-8 in the game.
- Emily Griggs led LSU going 2-for-3 with an RBI and run scored.
- Landry went 1-for-4 in the game, earning a triple and driving in three RBIs.
- Kellsie Kloss hit her 10th home run of the season, a new career-best mark in a single year.
- Allie Walljasper also went the distance, allowing three runs, two earned, on nine hits with four strikeouts.
- Walljasper held off Texas A&M in the final few frames as the Aggies had two runners in scoring position in one inning and a bases-loaded opportunity in the next.
- The team dropped its second consecutive finale, as Texas A&M broke a 2-2 tie in the top of the seventh with a three-run home run.
- LSU was held hitless through four, earning most of their five in-game hits during the fourth and fifth innings.
- All five hits came through the team's four through eight hole hitters.
- Savannah Jaquish tied her single-season home run mark with her 17th of the year in the game, while driving in her 64th RBI to set a new program record for RBI in a year.
- Kloss extended her hitting streak to a career-best 10 games, while Alayna Falcon extended hers to four which is also a career best.
- LSU used three pitchers in the game, with Kelsee Selman getting the start and allowing two unearned runs on one hit with four walks and two strikeouts in 2.1 innings of work.
- Baylee Corbello suffered the loss, going four innings and allowing three runs on four hits with five strikeouts and four walks.
