Quick Hits

LSU closes out the 2015 regular season playing the first of four-straight at home with Southeastern Louisiana Wednesday at 6 p.m. The game will air on ESPN 104.5/104.9 locally in Baton Rouge with Patrick Wright. The Tigers are 30-1 at home in Tiger Park this season. It's the seventh time in program history the team has won at least 30 at home in a season, while looking to be just the fourth team to win more than 30 in year. The most wins at home in LSU history is 34 by the 2006 team. LSU avoided a sweep at the hands of Missouri by taking the finale 9-0 in five innings on Monday night. The nine runs by the Tigers were the most the team has scored since plating 13 at McNeese State, while their nine hits were the most since having 11 in the opener against Texas A&M, outhitting an opponent for the first time in five games. LSU has run ruled 17 opponents this season, with three of their last five coming against ranked opponents. The Tigers have hit 53 home runs this year, 12 shy of what they hit all of 2014. The four home runs the team had against Missouri is the second most for the squad in an SEC series, second to the seven the team had against Tennessee. 19 of the 53 long balls have come in the third inning alone. LSU is 19-1 against Southeastern Louisiana all-time, including earning an 11-3 win over the Lady Lions last season in six innings. The Tigers are 6-0 against in-state schools this season. SLU is the seventh game against an opponent from the Southland Conference this season, as LSU is 6-0 against teams from the league this year.

A Look Back - Missouri

- The Tigers dropped only its third series opener of the season against Missouri on Saturday, dropping the game 7-2.
- The game was delayed for 40 minutes due to rain in the third inning after Missouri had tied the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the third.
- LSU scored in the first and third inning to go up, but only registered one hit past the third inning for the rest of the game.
- Each of Missouri's nine hits came with two outs, including two, two-out two-run home runs to tie and take the lead.
- LSU was held to just to just four hits, as Kellsy Kloss hit her 11th home run of the season and four of the last six for LSU up to that point.
- Bianka Bell drove in the first run, while A.J. Andrews had a double and Constance Quinn had the last two.
- Carley Hoover suffered the loss, pitching six innings and allowing five runs, four earned, on nine hits with five walks and four strikeouts.
- The Tigers dropped its second game and third in a row in falling 10-2 to Missouri in game two of the series, falling in five innings.
- It was the first time all season that LSU has been run-ruled in a contest.
- LSU was held to two runs for the second time on the weekend, while being held to just three hits after being held to four on Saturday.
- Bianka Bell's 14th home run of the season was one of the three hits, with Emily Griggs and Sandra Simmons having the other two.
- LSU struck out seven times in game two after striking out nine times the day before.
- Allie Walljasper took the loss after allowing seven runs, four earned on five hits with two walks, while Kelsey Selman pitched 1.1 innings of relief allowing three unearned runs on two hits with a walk and a strikeout.
- LSU regrouped and breezed by Missouri in the finale, taking game three 9-0 in five innings on Monday.
- The Tigers scored all nine runs over the course of two innings, putting up five in the third and four in the fifth to earn the victory.
- The nine hits the team earned in the game were two more than they combined to have in game's one and two on the weekend.
- Eight of LSU's nine batters in the game had at least a hit.
- Sandra Simmons hit her second home run of the season, capping the third with a three-run home run to put LSU up five.
- Bianka Bell hit her 15th home run of the season on a solo shot in the game.
- Dylan Supak earned multiple RBI's, earning a two-RBI double as Bailey Landry, Kellsy Kloss and Emily Griggs all drove in runs on the night.
- Carley Hoover pitched her fourth shutout of the season in the win, scattering four hits with four strikeouts and a walk.
- Hoover stranded five Missouri runners on base in the game, only allowing two past second.
