Quick Hits

LSU opens the 2015 Baton Rouge Regional on Friday at 6 p.m. against Texas Southern, champions of the Southwestern Athletic Conference, at Tiger Park.

The game will be televised live on ESPN2, with ESPN providing coverage throughout the rest of the weekend.

LSU is hosting a regional for the first time since 2013 and eighth time in program history.

The Tigers are the No. 5 national seed, the highest seeding for the team in program history and highest since 2007 when they were seeded 10th.

The regional features LSU, Arizona State, Nebraska and Texas Southern.

Arizona State and Nebraska open the regional at 3:30 p.m. on ESPN3 Friday afternoon.

This is LSU's 17th appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

The program is on a run of 10 consecutive postseason appearances which is the longest streak in team history.

LSU is 49-33 all-time in the postseason, with a 40-23 mark in regional play, holding a 17-10 mark at home.

Last season LSU went 3-2 in the postseason, falling in the NCAA Tucson Regional final to Arizona.

The winner of the Baton Rouge Regional will face the winner of the Tucson Regional, which features Arizona, Minnesota, New Mexico State and St. John's.

LSU is 2-0 all-time against Texas Southern in program history, with a 2-1 record against Nebraska and 4-8 record against Arizona State.

The Tigers could potentially have a rematch against the Cornhuskers, a team LSU defeated 10-2 in five innings in February at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Palm Springs.

The last time LSU squared off with the Sun Devils was in the 2012 Women's College World Series in a 6-0 loss.

A Look Back - SEC Tournament

- LSU opened the second round of the SEC Tournament at home last Thursday, falling to the Tennessee Lady Volunteers 7-5.
- Tennessee was the fifth seed and defeated Kentucky, the 12 seed, on a walk-off on Wednesday to advance to Thursday's game.
- LSU came into the game having earned a series win over the Lady Vols back during the regular season, but have dropped the last two to UT in order.
- It was the fourth time in the last five years that LSU has dropped its first game in the tournament, coming into this year's event as the four seed with an opening round bye.
- The game started past its original start time, after a delay in the first game pushed the game back over an hour.
- The Tigers held leads at two different points in the game, up 2-0 and then 5-3, before Tennessee scored four consecutive runs in the sixth and seventh.
- Tennessee scored all seven of its runs after the third inning.
- LSU was out-hit in the game 11-7, as all seven hits came from just four players.
- The Tigers did not commit an error in the game, losing for just the second time this year when not having a defensive miscue.
- The Tigers stranded 10 runners on base over the course of the game to Tennessee's seven.
- LSU has not won a game this year when trailing after six innings.
- There were a total of eight hits combined for the two sides in the game, with Tennessee having six on the night.
- Bianka Bell finished the game going 2-for-4 with two RBIs and a runs scored against UT.
- Bell had both of LSU's extra-base hits, hitting her 19th double of the season and her 16th home run of the year, that coming in the fifth to help tie the game at 3-3.
- Sydney Bourg earned the first multi-hit game of her career in the game, going 2-for-3 with an RBI.
- Emily Griggs earned her ninth multi-hit game of the year, going 2-for-4 with an RBI.
- The only other hit came from the bat of Constance Quinn who went 1-for-2 with an RBI and two runs scored.
- The LSU offense was given eight walks in the game, with A.J. Andrews, Kells Kloss and Quinn having two each.
- Carley Hoover earned the start for LSU, pitching 4.2 innings and allowing three runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts
- Allie Walljasper came on in relief and suffered the loss in the end, allowing four runs on five hits with four strikeouts in 2.1 innings to fall to 13-5 on the season.
- The Lady Vols hit three home runs against LSU pitching, while earning three doubles.
- Seven different UT players had at least one hit in the game, with five driving in at least one run.
- Tennessee eventually went on to defeat top-seeded Florida on Friday to earn a spot in the title game, falling in extras to second-seeded Auburn on Saturday night.
