## Quick Hits

LSU opens the 2015 Baton Rouge Super Regional on Saturday, taking on No. 16 Arizona with a berth in the Women's College World Series at stake. Game times this weekend are 2 p.m. Saturday and 4 p.m. Sunday, with the if-necessary game set for 7 p.m. Sunday. The opener will be streamed on ESPN3, with coverage possibly on ESPN, ESPNU or ESPNNews. Game's two and three will be on ESPN and if necessary, ESPN2.

Pam Ward and Cheri Kempf will call the action in the TV booth.

All three games can be heard on ESPN 104.5/104.9 locally in Baton Rouge, or at LSUsports.net in the Geaux Zone.

LSU advanced out of the opening round of the tournament for the first time since 2012.

The program is hosting its first-ever Super Regional in Baton Rouge.

The Tigers went 4-1 in the Baton Rouge Regional last week, defeating Texas Southern, Nebraska and Arizona State.

LSU is in a Super Regional for just the fourth time since the new format was adopted in the 2005 season.

LSU is 3-5 in Super Regional games all-time.

Two of those wins came in the 2012 Columbia (Mo.) Super Regional, leading to the team's third WCWS berth.

With the four wins last weekend, LSU is now 53-34 all-time in the postseason.

LSU is 21-11 at home during the NCAA tournament.

The team is two wins away from winning 50 games in a season for the first time since 2007. It has been done nine times in program history

The Tigers and Wildcats are playing for the fifth time in the last two seasons, including the 2014 NCAA Tucson Regional and one game in the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in February.

LSU won that game in February 4-3 in Palm Springs.

The Tigers are 4-10 all-time against Arizona in program history, with a 2-4 record in postseason meetings.

This is the second meeting between the two teams in a Super Regional. The last time was in Tucson in 2007 with Arizona taking two of three.

Arizona is third only to Arizona State and Louisiana Lafayette in number of games LSU's played in the NCAA Tournament.

## A Look Back - 2015 NCAA Baton Rouge Regional

- LSU opened its first home regional since 2013 by going 4-1 in the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional, earning wins over Texas Southern, Nebraska and Arizona State twice.
- The Tigers opened with a 15-0 win over TSU, before falling to ASU 1-0 in the first Saturday game.
- The team staved off elimination by defeating Nebraska 3-2 in 10 innings, before defeating ASU 5-0 and 4-3 in nine Sunday.
- LSU was the 19th team ever to win both games in a regional final to advance to a Super Regional.
- The Tigers earned their 19th win via run-rule and 20th shutout of the season against Texas Southern in the opener.
- The 15 runs are the most for an LSU team in postseason history, as the 10 runs the squad scored in the opening inning is also a postseason record.
- It's the second consecutive year LSU has scored double-digit runs in a regional game.
- All nine LSU starters earned a hit in the win, pounding out 11 over the course of the game.
- Bianka Bell hit her 17th home run of the season and Bailey Landry hit her first, as the only two players with multiple hits on the night.
- Bell and A.J. Andrews tied the postseason record for runs scored with three each, while Bell was one RBI shy of tying the program record with four.
- Kelsee Selman tossed the 18th shutout in LSU postseason history, striking out seven in five innings and scattering just three hits.
- In the winner's game on Saturday, LSU fell to Arizona State in a close battle, earning four hits as ASU scored in the first and it would be all the Sun Devils needed to move on to Sunday.
- Andrews, Landry, Sandra Simmons and Sydney Bourg had all four hits for LSU.
- Carley Hoover suffered the loss, allowing the run on three hits with three walks and a strikeout.
- In the final elimination game of the day on Saturday, LSU earned a rematch with Nebraska from an earlier regular season contest that LSU won 10-2 in five innings.
- It would take 10 innings to break a 1-1 tie between the two teams, the first extra inning game this season for the team.
- LSU took the lead on a Simmons single before NU tied the game, as Kellsie Kloss and Savannah Jaquish each had RBI singles in the 10th to give LSU a 3-1 lead.
- Nebraska fought back to pull within one, before Hoover came in to close the door.
- Allie Walljasper earned the win after pitching 9.1 innings and allowing two runs on eight hits with three strikeouts, while Hoover picked up her third save of the season.
- The win set up a do-or-die Sunday for LSU against ASU, beginning with earning the second shutout of the weekend in game one.
- Hoover struck out eight and walked three in seven innings, scattering four hits.
- Jaquish went 3-for-4 with an RBI and two runs scored, while Constance Quinn drove in three on two hits.
- The Tigers went to extras for the second day in a row, eventually defeating ASU 4-3 in nine to move on.
- LSU pounded out 13 hits, with five players earning multiple hits
- Bell drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth to send LSU through on her second hit of the day.
- Andrews went 3-for-4, while Landry went 2-for-4 and drove in the game-tying run in the seventh.
- Walljasper earned the start, pitching 6.1 innings and allowing three runs, one earned, on eight hits with three strikeouts.
- Hoover earned her second victory of the day in relief, pitching the final 2.2, allowing nothing with a strikeout.
