Tigers Take Unbeaten Streak into SEC Tournament Quarterfinals

The LSU Tigers (12-4-4, 5-4-2 SEC) took a big step toward NCAA Tournament qualification on Monday afternoon with a 2-1 win over Kentucky in the opening match of the 2015 SEC Women's Soccer Tournament as they extended their unbeaten streak to five-straight games with the result. The Tigers and Wildcats had met only four days before in their regular-season finale with LSU also coming out with the win with a 3-2 victory at the Bell Soccer Complex in Lexington. While facing a 1-0 deficit coming out of halftime, the Tigers struck quickly as senior midfielder **Natalia Gomez-Junco** fired home from outside the box with a curling strike that found the net inside the top-left corner with her fifth goal of the season to draw LSU level in the 47th minute of play. Freshman **Gabriela Maldonado** then scored what proved to be the winner with her third goal of the season in the 54th minute from an LSU corner kick. The win pushed LSU's unbeaten streak to five-straight matches as they take a 4-0-1 mark during that span into Wednesday's quarterfinal match with No. 2 seed Missouri as they will kick off at Noon CT on the SEC Network. The victory also snapped a three-game losing skid by the Tigers in the SEC Tournament as they won their first match in Orange Beach since the 2010 season when they scored a 1-0 extra time win over Tennessee in the first round. They also earned their first trip to the SEC quarterfinals for the first time since 2010. They had lost each of their three first round matches from 2011-13 before Monday's 2-1 win over Kentucky. In Missouri, the Tigers will face a team that finished in second place on the final SEC table with a 7-2-2 mark and 23 points in league play for their best SEC finish since joining the league in 2012. But it was LSU that scored the 2-1 win over Missouri in the regular-season match between the two teams in Baton Rouge back on Oct. 9. LSU has enjoyed great success against Missouri over the last four seasons as it has posted a strong 3-1 mark in four regular-season matches between the two sides. Wednesday's quarterfinal match will be the first ever meeting between the two Tigers in the postseason as they open the action with the first match of the day. The winner will advance to play the winner of No. 3 seed Ole Miss and No. 6 seed Texas A&M in Friday's semifinals.

STORYLINES

- LSU has held the upper hand in its history with Missouri with a 3-1 edge in the series that dates back to LSU's 3-1 win over 16th-ranked Missouri in Columbia on Oct. 21, 2012. The Tigers have also won twice at home with a 1-0 win in 2013 and 2-1 win in their last match back on Oct. 9 of this year.
- The Tigers finished a home schedule unbeaten for just the second time in 21 seasons with an 8-0-4 mark this season. They are now 4-4 with three-straight wins away from home in 2015 after Monday's first-round win.
- LSU has featured a potent attack throughout the season while scoring 38 goals in its 20 matches in 2015 for an average of 1.90 goals per game. That output has eclipsed the 26 goals scored by the Tigers in their 20 matches for an average of 1.30 goals per game in the 2014 season.
- The Tigers got All-SEC striker **Summer Clarke** back in the lineup on Monday afternoon against Kentucky as she played 74 minutes in LSU's 2-1 win in her first action since suffering an ankle injury at Florida on Oct. 11. Despite Clarke missing the last four SEC matches of the regular season, the Tigers finished the regular season unbeaten at 3-0-1 s in their last four SEC matches to finish in seventh place in the SEC standings. With Clarke watching from the sidelines, LSU picked up wins over Mississippi State at home and Arkansas and Kentucky on the road as well as a draw against South Carolina at home.
- The Tigers are looking to advance to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the fifth time under head coach **Brian Lee** as they made four-straight semifinal trips from 2007-10. LSU is 5-5-4 in Orange Beach under Lee.
- LSU's star striker **Jorian Baucom** has found her scoring boots once again as she has found the back of the net in three of the team's last five matches after being held scoreless in four previous matches in SEC play. Baucom scored the winner in a 1-0 win at Arkansas on Oct. 15 before scoring the equalizer in a 1-1 draw with South Carolina and two second-half goals in a 3-2 win at Kentucky to close the regular season. She finished the regular season as the No. 2-ranked goal scorer in the SEC and No. 6-ranked scorer in the NCAA.
- The Tigers feature an experienced squad in 2015 with nine seniors leading the way, including five fifth-year seniors on the roster. Among LSU's fifth-year seniors are **Alex Arlitt**, **Lexi Gibbs**, **Natalia Gomez-Junco**, **Emma Meckfessel** and **Catalina Rubiano**.

Series Notes:

While LSU and Missouri have met four previous times in the regular season, the stakes will be raised in Wednesday's quarterfinal match at the 2015 SEC Women's Soccer Tournament with a trip to the semifinals on the line to face either No. 3 seed Ole Miss or No. 6 seed Texas A&M on Friday. LSU has held the upper hand in the series while winning three of the four meetings all-time with Missouri, including a 2-1 home win in their last match on Oct. 9 of this season. The Tigers won the inaugural meeting between the two sides with a 3-1 win at 16th-ranked Missouri on Oct. 21, 2012, while they also scored a 1-0 home win during the 2013 regular season. Missouri's lone win in the series came on Sept. 19, 2014, in Columbia where it defended its home field with a 3-1 win in the regular season.

NOTEBOOK

Tigers Enjoy SEC Tournament Success Under Brian Lee

LSU has now earned a spot in the field for the SEC Women's Soccer Tournament nine times in the 11 seasons under the direction of head coach **Brian Lee**, highlighted by four-straight trips to the semifinal round from 2007-10. Lee even coached the Tigers to their first ever SEC Tournament Final on Nov. 8, 2009, when they dropped a dramatic 8-7 decision in penalty kicks to South Carolina after the two sides played to a 1-1 draw in regulation and extra time. The Tigers are 5-5-4 in 14 matches played at the SEC Tournament since Lee's first season as head coach in 2005. They snapped a three-game losing skid at the SEC Tournament with Monday's 2-1 comeback win over Kentucky to level their record in Orange Beach under Lee. LSU is also 1-3 in four penalty kick shootouts all-time at the SEC Tournament, all coming since 2007.

Tigers Building Impressive NCAA Tournament Resume

The Tigers find themselves in a strong position at No. 39 in this week's release of the NCAA's Ratings Percentage Index as they are already building a strong NCAA Tournament resume heading into the homestretch of the season. LSU boasts wins over three RPI Top 50 teams this season, including ACC power No. 14 Duke, Big Ten contender No. 36 Minnesota and No. 50 Missouri. LSU also boasts two wins over No. 53 Kentucky in Lexington and in Orange Beach in the last week. The Tigers also boast a 1-1 draw with No. 25 South Carolina in Baton Rouge. They are now 6-3-3 in 12 matches against the RPI Top 80 heading into Wednesday's SEC Tournament quarterfinal against Missouri.

Tigers Pick Up Key Results Without Stars in Lineup

The Tigers nearly pulled off the comeback in a 2-1 defeat at 12th-ranked Florida back on Oct. 11, despite star striker **Summer Clarke** being forced off just four minutes into the match with an ankle injury suffered on a 50-50 tackle near the center circle. While Clarke missed each of the previous four matches prior to Monday's 2-1 win over Kentucky, the Tigers were unbeaten while picking up 10 points to move up to seventh place on the SEC table thanks to a 1-0 away win at Arkansas, a 1-0 win over Mississippi State and 1-1 draw with 17th-ranked South Carolina at home, and 3-2 away win at Kentucky in their regular-season finale. The Tigers welcomed Clarke back to the lineup on Monday afternoon as she played 74 minutes in the SEC First Round. Twice before this season they were missing key members of their starting 11, only to pick up two of their biggest wins of the campaign in their push for a return to the NCAA Tournament. After senior team captain and central defender **Alex Arlitt** was sent off with a red card at Alabama on Sept. 11, junior left back **Megan Lee** moved to the middle with senior **Gracie Campbell** filling in on the left while keeping a clean sheet in a 1-0 home win over then 15th-ranked Duke on Sept. 13. When hosting SEC runner-up Missouri on Oct. 9, the team's leading scorer **Jorian Baucom** was suspended due to yellow card accumulation on the season after picking up her fifth booking against Vanderbilt on Oct. 2. Sophomore **Debbie Hahn** and freshman **Gabriela Maldonado** stepped up as each scored a goal and served up an assist in LSU's 2-1 win over Missouri to snap a brief three-game winless streak for the team in SEC play.

Tigers Unbeaten at Home, Turn Tables on Road in SEC Play

The Tigers proved unbeatable on their home field this fall as their 1-0 win over Mississippi State and 1-1 draw with 17th-ranked South Carolina in their final home weekend pushed their unbeaten run to 12-straight matches at the LSU Soccer Stadium this fall. LSU finished its home schedule unbeaten for just the second time in 21 seasons in the program's history while posting an 8-0-4 record in 12 matches in Baton Rouge in 2015. The Tigers were also unbeaten at home for the first time in 2007 with a 5-0-3 mark in eight home matches. This season has featured the third-longest home unbeaten streak in team history as the Tigers were also unbeaten in 18 matches at 14-0-4 from Oct. 15, 2006 to Oct. 19, 2008, and 15 matches at 12-0-3 from Aug. 28, 2009 to Oct. 8, 2010. They have also turned around their fortunes away from home with three-straight wins on their travels while picking up a 1-0 win at Arkansas on Oct. 15, a 3-2 win at Kentucky last Thursday night and then a 2-1 win over Kentucky in Orange Beach on Monday. LSU is now 4-4 away from home this season.

Baucom Wins Second SEC Player of the Week Award After Kentucky Win

LSU's sophomore striker **Jorian Baucom** led the Tigers to a 3-2 win over Kentucky in their regular-season finale with two goals in the 64th and 70th minutes of the second half en route to being named the SEC's Offensive Player of the Week for the second time this season and first time since Sept. 14. Baucom ended the regular season with 15 goals in her 18 starts for the Tigers to rank No. 2 in the SEC and tied for No. 6 in the NCAA scoring charts for 2015. She is also tied with former Tiger **Kara Dean** in 2000 for the No. 3 spot on LSU's all-time single-season goal-scoring list with her 15 goals this season.

Gomez-Junco Scores Third Free Kick Goal at Kentucky

The Tigers found themselves 1-0 in front just under five minutes from the opening kickoff in Thursday's regular-season finale at Kentucky thanks to yet another free kick goal from the right boot of senior midfielder **Natalia Gomez-Junco**. LSU's free kick specialist stepped up from 25 yards out after a Wildcat defender was whistled for a handball outside of the area and curled her effort around the Kentucky wall and into the top right corner of the net for her fourth goal on the season. It was also her third goal directly from a free kick in 2015 as she found the back of the net from similar positions in a 4-3 home win against Georgia on Sept. 17 and a 1-0 home win against Mississippi State on Oct. 23.

Rubiano Named SEC Defensive Player of the Week

LSU's senior goalkeeper **Catalina Rubiano** was honored by the SEC office for her performance in goal in leading the Tigers to a 1-0 win at Arkansas two weeks ago as she saved all six shots on target she faced in the match to post her fifth clean sheet of the season. She even made an acrobatic diving save high and to her right in the first half that featured in the "Top Plays" segment on ESPN's SportsCenter that night as the No. 8 play of the day on Oct. 15. Rubiano was then named the SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week for her performance. She followed by saving two shots and keeping her sixth clean sheet on the season when the Tigers picked up a 1-0 home win over Mississippi State on Friday of last week. Rubiano has started all 18 matches for the Tigers this season heading into their regular-season finale.

Tigers Return to Rankings in Soccer America Top 25

On the strength of their three-game winning streak over Duke, Georgia and Marquette, the Tigers returned to the national rankings for the first time in more than two years in recent weeks when they entered the Soccer America Women's Top 25 poll as the No. 24-ranked team in the country for the week of Sept. 21. LSU returned to the national rankings for the first time since they cracked the TopDrawerSoccer.com Top 25 at No. 25 on Sept. 2, 2013, while they featured in the Soccer America Top 25 for the first time since picking up a No. 18 national ranking on Oct. 12, 2011. The Tigers earned their highest ever ranking in the Soccer America Top 25 poll on Sept. 22, 2008, when they climbed as high as No. 9 nationally during a season in which they placed second in the SEC standings.

Baucom's Penalty Lifts Tigers Past No. 15 Duke, 1-0

After being tripped in the box by a Duke defender on a ball played over the top, sophomore striker **Jorian Baucom** stepped up to the penalty spot and buried what proved to be the winning spot kick to lift the Tigers to a 1-0 win over the 15th-ranked Blue Devils on Sept. 13 at the LSU Soccer Stadium. The win was LSU's 10th victory over a nationally-ranked opponent in the program's history and first over a nationally-ranked team since a 1-0 win over the 13th-ranked USC Trojans at the Minnesota Gold Classic in Minneapolis on Sept. 8, 2013. Baucom, having already missed a penalty earlier in the match in the 13th minute, was true on her second attempt as she fired past Duke goalkeeper EJ Proctor from 12 yards out to give the home side a 1-0 lead on 73 minutes with her eighth goal of the 2015 season. She ran her scoring streak to six-straight matches that started in a 4-1 win over Western Kentucky on Aug. 28.

Tigers Pick Up 10th Win Over Nationally-Ranked Opponent

LSU's 1-0 win over 15th-ranked Duke on Sept. 13 was its 10th victory against a nationally-ranked opponent in the program's history, and first since a 1-0 win over 13th-ranked USC at the Minnesota Gold Classic on Sept. 8, 2013. The Tigers have now won 10 and drawn nine matches against nationally-ranked opponents in their history, with nine of those wins and all nine draws coming during the **Brian Lee** era. Defense Holds Minnesota Without a Shot On Goal in 1-0 Shutout

For the first time in nearly five years, the Tigers held their opponent without a shot on goal in a match when Minnesota failed to find the target on just four shot attempts in the finale at the "Battle on the Bayou" back on Aug. 30. The Golden Gophers managed just one shot attempt in the second half as LSU's sophomore **Jorian Baucom** scored the winner with a header from **Summer Clarke's** end-line cross in the 70th minute in a 1-0 win. It marked the first time since Oct. 8, 2010, that the Tigers held their opponent without a shot on goal when they kept SEC rival Kentucky off target in 104 minutes in a 1-0 double overtime victory at the LSU Soccer Stadium in Baton Rouge. In fact, LSU has now held an opponent without a shot on goal in a match a total of 17 times in their history, including four times against major NCAA Division I level opposition. Along with Minnesota on Sunday and Kentucky during the 2010 season, the Tigers also held the likes of Vanderbilt (Oct. 17, 2008) and Mississippi State (Sept. 28, 2009) without a shot on goal in 90 minutes of a match. record in exhibition play, including a 1-1 away draw with Auburn and a 2-0 shutout of Ole Miss on a neutral field.

• SEC Offensive Player of the Week –

Florida's Savannah Jordan, a junior forward from Fayetteville, Ga., provided the Gators with three goals in last week's matches. Against No. 17 South Carolina, Jordan scored the tying goal by taking a left-footed, sharp-angled shot that scored at the far post in the 21st minute. Against Arkansas, Jordan scored Florida second and final goals in a 4-0 win. Jordan now has 17 goals for the season to lead the league and place her among the nation's top five scorers. Her two goals versus Arkansas was her fourth multi-goal match of the season and the 15th of her career.

• SEC Defensive Player of the Week –

Georgia's Louise Hogrell, a sophomore goalkeeper from Asa, Sweden, made save after save during Georgia's impressive two-win weekend. In Georgia's 3-1 win over Vanderbilt, Hogrell kept the scoreboard clean for 73 minutes before the Commodores snuck in a goal in desperation mode. The highlight of the weekend was Hogrell's performance on the road vs. No. 16 Auburn. She had several spectacular saves throughout the game shutting out one of the nation's top teams. The shutout marked the first time that Auburn was beaten on its home turf all year long. No matter what the Tigers threw at Hogrell, she was a brick wall for all 90 minutes. On the weekend, she made 11 saves.

• SEC Freshman of the Week –

Ole Miss's CeCe Kizer, a freshman forward from Overland Park, Kan., scored three goals over the weekend to help Ole Miss defeat Tennessee and No. 19 Texas A&M. In the first game of the weekend, Kizer provided an insurance goal to secure a 2-0 victory, the Rebels' first win over the Vols since 2003. On Sunday, Kizer scored two goals in a span of two minutes to propel No. 13 Ole Miss over No. 19 Texas A&M. Kizer first found the equalizer before the game winner two minutes later in the 71st minute. The pair

of goals gave Kizer her seventh game-winning goal of the season as well as the third multi-goal game of her career. The performance also led Ole Miss into ending Texas A&M's 17-game home unbeaten streak. The freshman forward leads the Rebels with 14 goals and 29 points this season; both rank second overall in the SEC. The 14 goals in one season are the third-most by a freshman in school history as well as the eight-most by any Rebel in a single season.

- Five SEC teams were mentioned in the latest NSCAA poll - Florida is ranked eighth nationally while Ole Miss was tabbed 13th, Auburn 16th, South Carolina 17th and Texas A&M 23rd.
- SEC teams have won 69.9 percent (64-23-16) of their non-conference games this season.
- Two SEC coaches rank among the all-time winningest Division I coaches – Florida's Becky Burleigh (third with 450 wins) and Texas A&M's G Guerrieri (fifth with 408 wins).
- Twelve SEC teams were named NSCAA 2014-15 Women's College Team Academic Award Winners for posting a team grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Ole Miss's 3.71 team grade point average was the third-highest in the nation.
- Three active SEC student-athletes represented their countries in the 2015 FIFA Women's World Cup – Alabama's Celia Jimenez Delgado (Spain), Vanderbilt's Lina Granados (Colombia) and Tennessee's Hannah Wilkinson (New Zealand).
- Twenty-one regular season matches will be televised to a national television audience this year. SEC Network will broadcast 17 matches while ESPN2 will show four. Additionally, more than 100 matches will be shown digitally on SEC Network +.
- Fifty-two players were named to the Preseason SEC Watch List. Check page two of this release for a complete listing of the players.
