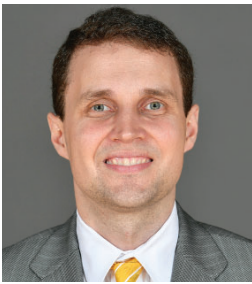

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the

middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

LAST GAME: LSU 67, COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON 55 (ORLANDO, 11/22/18; ADVOCARE INVITATIONAL)

The Tigers got off to a strong start in its opening quarterfinal game of the AdvocCare Invitational, holding Charleston to just 34 percent from the floor (including 8-of-29 in the first half) to advance to the championship semifinals.

Emmitt Williams, the Fort Myers freshman hit 6-of-9 field goals to score 14 points with nine rebounds. Skylar Mays was the other Tiger in double figures with 12 points. Sophomore point guard Tremont Waters had his seventh double figure assist game at LSU, equaling his career high of 11 assists (had 11 at Auburn last season).

The Tigers shot a consistent 51.9 percent for the game (15-of-29 the first half, 12-of-23 second half), with a 36-20 advantage in points in the paint and 16-10 in points off turnovers. versus McNeese State.

TIGERS OPEN WITH FOUR STRAIGHT WINS

The Tigers 5-0 start is their first since the 2012-13 season, a year in which LSU started 6-0 on the year. This is the seventh time LSU has started a season 5-0 since the start of the 1992-93 season.

TIGER OPPONENTS CAME LOADED WITH WINS

LSU's opening schedule came loaded with teams that won conference titles with post-season appearances and lots of wins.

Counting Florida State's 23 wins a year ago, LSU's opponents in the first six games won a total of 136 games a year ago.

TIGERS FACE RANKED TEAM AS RANKED TEAM

LSU will face ranked Florida State as a ranked team in today's semifinals, the 66th game that LSU will play when both teams are ranked in the AP poll

LSU is 26-39 (40.0 percent) in the first 65 games. Overall, LSU has been ranked in 201 polls all-time in the AP poll.

LSU is 14-4 as the No. 19 poll all-time in the AP poll and LSU is 3-9 against teams ranked No. 14 in the AP poll.

LSU is 1-4 against ranked teams in the Will Wade era.

LSU MAKES SECOND ADVOCARE APPEARANCE

LSU will be making its 56th appearance in an in-season tournament since its first appearance in the Fort Worth Collegiate event in 1947 ... This will be the second time LSU has appeared in the Disney-based tournament, the first since the 2013 event, which was then known as the Old Spice Classic.

LSU was 2-1 in that event, defeating Saint Joseph's, 82-65; losing to Memphis 76-69 and defeating Butler in overtime, 70-68, to finish second.

That was the last time LSU was 2-1 in a three-game event. Last year LSU was 1-2 in the Maui Invitational, defeating Michigan (77-75) before losing to Notre Dame (92-53) and Marquette (94-84).

FACE MASK ISN'T SO BAD AFTER ALL

So when Daryl Edwards put on his facemask last week for the LA Tech game (11/16), memories went back to last season when Tremont Waters had to wear a facemask for the three games of the postseason. Waters had three pretty decent games and Edwards responded just two days after surgery for a practice broken nose by having his best game of the season.

Maybe it's the facemask. The numbers

TWO POINT-GUARD SYSTEM BECOMES THREE

Soon after Coach Wade arrived at LSU, it became very clear that he believed in trying to have two-point guards on the court to run his offense.

Last season that meant Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays who combined to average 27.2 points (15.9 for Waters, 11.3 for Mays) and a combined 8.9 assists.

Now Coach Wade in the first five games has started three point guards – Waters, Mays and freshman Ja'vonte Smart.

In five games the trio has combined for 179 points, 44 rebounds, 55 assists and 32 steals while shooting a combined 62-of-132 from the field with 16 treys and 39-of-46 at the free throw line. The points are evenly spread as Mays has 63, Waters 60 and Smart 56.

TREMONT WATERS -- POINTING THE WAY

So far this season, Waters is averaging 12.0 points per game and 7.2 assists per game.

FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at two games of 1.10, ranked 323 of the 353 teams after the game on Thursday. Only Arkansas and Kentucky are listed as younger by the web site.

The freshmen on the team in three games have scored 209 of LSU's 417 points or 50.1 percent. Naz Reid has scored 67 points, Ja'vonte Smart 56, Emmitt Williams 53 and Darius Days 33.

SERIES VERSUS FLORIDA STATE

Florida State and LSU met last in 2004 in New Orleans at the Allstate Sugar Bowl event with LSU winning, 67-50. The teams have played five times over all with LSU leading 3-2. The first four meetings in the series took place in the time period from 1957-67 before the 2004 meeting.
