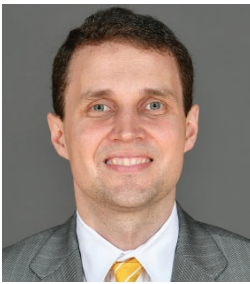

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the

middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

ADVOCARE GAME 3: OKLAHOMA STATE 90, LSU 77 (ORLANDO, 11/25/18)

The Tigers were unable to get going except in brief spurts Sunday against Oklahoma State, falling to the Cowboys for third place, 90-77, at the AdvoCare invitational.

LSU fell behind 7-0 and 15-2 in the first half before coming back to take a 35-33 lead with 3:02 left in the first half. Oklahoma State would lead at the intermission, 42-37.

But Oklahoma State was able to put the game away with another 15-2 run to open the second half that built an 18-point advantage the Tigers could only whittle down to the final margin.

Skylar Mays had a strong game for LSU completing a good tourney with 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting and 4-of-7 from the arc, while Kavell Bigby-Williams in 18 minutes off the bench hit 6-of-9 field goals for 12 points and seven rebounds.

LSU shot 41.2 percent for the game (28-68) with nine treys in the game and 16 turnovers. OSU shot 58.5 percent for the game (31-53) and 8-of-16 from the arc.

MORE LSU-OSU/TOURNAMENT NOTES

1-2 AGAIN -- For the fifth straight year, LSU leaves a November tournament with two losses, the second straight year playing in a third-place game in the third game of the event. Last year, LSU lost to Marquette, 94-84, in the third place game in Maui. LSU's last third-place game and 2-1 tournament was in the same locale (Orlando) in the 2013 Old Spice Classic. Since then, LSU has gone 1-2 in the Paradise Jam (2014), 0-2 in the Legends Classic (2015), 1-2 in the Battle 4 Atlantis (2016) and 1-2 in the Maui Invitational (2017).

MAYS GREAT TOURNEY -- Junior Skylar Mays had a good three games, leading the team in scoring at 17.0 points per game with 10 rebounds and 10 assists in the three games. Mays made 19-of-27 field

goals (70.4%) and 10-of-17 from the arc (58.8%).

TIGERS CONTINUE TO GET POINTS OFF TURNOVERS – LSU turned the ball over 16 times against OSU, but forced 18 turnovers and had a 31-23 advantage in points off turnovers. In seven games, the Tigers are averaging 20.6 points off opponents turnovers, compared to 12.4 for opponents on LSU turnovers.

KBW IN DOUBLE FIGURES -- Senior Kavell Bigby-Williams had one of his better games of the season down inside, getting 6-of-9 field goals for 12 points and seven rebounds in 18 minutes of play. It was his second double figure scoring game of the season.

ADVOCARE GAME 2: FLORIDA STATE 79, LSU 76 (ORLANDO, 11/23/18)

The Tigers were unable to keep the lead in the final three minutes of regulation and No. 14 Florida State forced overtime and hit a three-pointer that bounced twice off the rim with 0.5 seconds left to win over No. 19 LSU.

Skylar Mays equaled his season high of 19 points to go with four assists, while Ja'vonte Smart equaled his college high with 16 points and eight assists. Naz Reid had 12 points and Tremont Waters 11 points, three assists and four steals.

The Tigers shot 51.9 percent from the floor (27-of-52) and made 11 three-pointers. LSU had 16 assists, but 18 turnovers (the most in Will Wade's tenure at LSU). The main problem was being out-rebounded 43-30 and more importantly, 22-4 on the offensive boards including one overtime possession that lasted three five offensive rebounds that reset the shot clock. LSU was able to get out of it without giving up points after a traveling call.

With the offensive rebounds, Florida State took 76 shots overall. But for the third straight game, LSU has held opponents under 40 percent from the field (38.2, 29-of-76).

LSU trailed 30-29 at the half, the first time the Tigers have trailed at half this season.

MORE LSU-FLORIDA STATE GAME NOTES

OFFENSIVE BOARDS, MORE SHOTS – In taking 24 more shots than LSU (76-52), it was the largest margin of more shots for an opponent since Nov. 12, 2010 by Northwestern State (30) ... The 22 offensive rebounds is most by an opponent since Jan. 14, 2015 by Ole Miss (23).

FIRST LOSS – The FSU game was the first loss in the Will Wade era when outshooting an opponent (by percentage) ... It was the first loss in 17 games late in the 2016-17 season when shooting 50 percent or more by LSU ... It was the first loss in 22 games in the Will Wade era when leading with 10 minutes to play.

BACK-TO-BACK – LSU had the exact same FG/FGA in the two games against Florida State and Charleston – 27-of-52.

OVERTIME WOES -- LSU has now lost five straight overnight games dating back to the 2015 season ... LSU's last overtime win was against Vanderbilt, 79-75, on Jan. 24, 2015 ... The Tigers are 0-2 in overtime in the Will Wade era at LSU (South Carolina, 83-74, 2/28/18; Florida State, 79-76, 11/23/18) ... Ironically, this was the first overtime game in the AdvoCare Invitational since LSU beat Butler in the third place game in 2013.

ADVOCARE GAME 1: LSU 67, COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON 55 (ORLANDO, 11/22/18)

The Tigers got off to a strong start in its opening quarterfinal game of the AdvoCare Invitational, holding Charleston to just 34 percent from the floor (including 8-of-29 in the first half) to advance to the championship semifinals.

Emmitt Williams, the Fort Myers freshman hit 6-of-9 field goals to score 14 points with nine rebounds. Skylar Mays was the other Tiger in double figures with 12 points. Sophomore point guard Tremont Waters had his seventh double figure assist game at LSU, equaling his career high of 11 assists (had 11 at Auburn last season).

The Tigers shot a consistent 51.9 percent for the game (15-of-29 the first half, 12-of-23 second half), with a 36-20 advantage in points in the paint and 16-10 in points off turnovers.

IT'S NET, BUT THERE IS STILL RPI BEING FIGURED

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

In very early and still processing NET showings through Wednesday, LSU is at No. 60 with its 5-2 record. LSU is 0-1 in quadrant 1 wins and 1-1 in quadrant 2 wins.

LSU PLAYS FOR 12 STRAIGHT ON THE HOME WIN STREAK

The win over Louisiana Tech on Nov. 16 gave LSU 11 consecutive wins in the Maravich Center dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette.

The present 11-game win streak is tied for the 11th longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons:

TIGERS STILL RECEIVING VOTES IN POLLS AFTER LOSSES

Despite going 1-2 in the AdvoCare Invitational, the Tigers are still receiving votes and is in the first five of those out of the Top 25 in both the AP media poll and the USA Today Coaches poll.

The Tigers recorded five wins as a ranked team in the AP poll – ranked in the preseason No. 23 and then moving to No. 22 and No. 19 before being dropped to RV in Monday's poll.

LSU's four appearances put them at 201 polls they have appeared in LSU is now 265-101 when playing while ranked in the Top 20/Top 25 since the 1948-49 season.

SHOOTING THE THREE

The Tigers have not shot the ball from the arc as well as they did last year but in the three games of the AdvoCare Invitational did make 26 treys in three games compared to 25 in the first four games of the season. LSU did shoot 35.6 percent for the three games of the Invitational (26-73) which upped LSU's percentage to 32.5 for the season (51-of-157).

LSU is ninth in the SEC in three-point percentage. Opponents have made 18 more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season, taking 23 more attempts (69-of-180, 38.3%).

Last season, LSU made a school record 268 treys in 33 games (268-744) and shot 34.6 percent from the arc.

INSIDE THE ARC – LSU 12TH IN NATION

LSU continues to lead the SEC and is No. 12 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 59.5 percent.

The Tigers shot 56 percent inside the arc a year ago. LSU shot 56.6 percent inside the arc in the AdvoCare Invitational and just 46.3 percent in the loss to Oklahoma State. LSU is shooting over 61 percent inside the arc at the Maravich Center.

Second in the SEC in two-point percentage is Mississippi State at No. 19 at 58.6 percent.

FREE THROWS

LSU shot below 70 percent at the AdvoCare Invitational at 69.8 percent (30-of-43). Again, like three-point shooting, opponents were at the line more, making 46-of-64 for 71.9 percent.

The Tigers started the season with a couple of its best free throw games in years making 24-of-31 against Southeastern (11/6), 28-of-31 against UNCG (11/9) and 12-of-16 against Memphis (11/13).

In the UNCG game, the Tigers hit 22 in a row at the free throw line to start the game before missing. For the season, LSU is still a good 75 percent, hitting 105-of-140, third best in the SEC. Opponents have made just 84 free throws of 125 attempts (67.2%).

WILL WADE

The native of Nashville graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach during last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called power 5 major conferences this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12) ... TWO POINT-GUARD SYSTEM BECOMES THREE

Soon after Coach Wade arrived at LSU, it became very clear that he believed in trying to have two-point guards on the court to run his offense.

Last season that meant Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays who combined to average 27.2 points (15.9 for Waters, 11.3 for Mays) and a combined 8.9 assists.

Now Coach Wade has started three point guards in every game – sophomore Waters, junior Mays and freshman Ja'vonte Smart.

In seven games the trio has combined for 258 points, 64 rebounds, 80 assists and 45 steals while shooting a combined 91-of-194 from the field with 31 treys and 46-of-57 at the free throw line. The points are spread like this: Mays 102 (14.6 ppg); Waters 79 (11.3 ppg); Smart 78 (11.1 ppg)

TREMONT WATERS -- POINTING THE WAY (5th in spg) 20th in assists.

The sophomore from New Haven had his second 11-assist game of his career against Charleston (11/22). Here are the career 10 assist games for Waters:

So far this season, Waters is averaging 11.3 points per game and 6.3 assists per game. He averaged 9.0 points and 6.3 assists in Orlando in the three games. So far this season, Tremont is No. 3 in the SEC and 20th in the NCAA stats in assists while in steals Waters is the league leader at 3.3 a game which is also fifth in the nation.

Waters has struggled from the arc this season hitting just 8-of-29 three-point attempts in the first seven games. He is averaging 33.4 minutes per game, which is third in the league.

SKYLAR MAYS

Junior guard Skylar Mays joined teammate Tremont Waters with his own ESPN SportsCenter moment against Memphis (11/13) when he delivered an emphatic driving dunk that registered as the third best player of the day. Mays would score 19 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including three treys. He has 38 career double figure scoring games at LSU.

Mays is coming off an outstanding AdvoCare Invitational in which he led the team, averaging 17.0 points per game, 3.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game.

Mays is averaging 14.6 points per season, 3.0 rebounds and 2.3 rebounds. He has now made 62 starts in 71 career games ... He is one of 34 players to have at least 200 career assists and is one of 27 players to have 100 career steals.

pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

JA'VONTE SMART

Smart is averaging 11.1 points per game and 3.7 rebounds. He is also averaging just under three assists a contest, shooting 47.5 percent from the field overall. Smart had a high of 13 points against UNCG (11/9). He had his best two games in dishing the ball in the last two games with 8 against Florida State (11/23) and 4 against Oklahoma State (11/25).

REBOUNDING NUMBERS

The Tigers were outrebounded in three straight games – versus Louisiana Tech (11/16), Charleston (11/22) and Florida State (11/23) – before out rebounded Oklahoma State 36-34. LSU in the three game they were outrebounded were taken hard on the offensive boards to the tune of a 50-23 margin over the three games, including 22-4 against Florida State.

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding by a good margin, averaging 7.4 boards a game. Of his 52 rebounds, 21 are offensive. Williams is 10th in the league in rebounding average.

Darius Days is second at 32 (4.6, 16-16) and Kavell Bigby-Williams is third at 28 boards (4.0). LSU is 11th in the league in rebound average at 36.0 a game and eight in rebound defense at 33.4 a contest.

SENIOR BEGINNING TO HIT STRIDE

Senior transfer Kavell Bigby-Williams has hit his stride in a couple of games and in both of those once he got rolling he was hard to stop in offensive output.

Against Memphis, he hit 7-of-7 field goals in scoring 14 points (11/13) and against Oklahoma State he hit 6-of-9 field goals in scoring 12 points with a team high 7 rebounds (11/25).

For the season, KBW is averaging 6.6 points and 4.0 rebounds with 12 blocks. He is averaging 15.0 minutes a game and is 20-of-29 (69 percent) from the field.

FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at seven games of 1.07, ranked 330 of the 353 teams after the game on Friday. Only Arkansas and Kentucky are listed as younger by the web site.

The freshmen on the team in six games have scored 47.7 of LSU's 570 points this season. Naz Reid is the leading freshman scorer at 12.1 points per game with Ja'vonte Smart at 11.1 points, Emmitt Williams at 9.3 and Darius Day 6.3.

SERIES VERSUS GRAMBLING STATE

Grambling State will come into the Maravich Center with a 3-3 record after an 80-69 loss against IUPUI in the Fort Myers Tip-Off Classic Opening Games that were played in Niagara Falls, New York. In the IUPUI game, both Dallas Polk-Hillard and Axel Mpoyo each scored 11 to lead the Tigers, while Travon Bunch and Mpoyo led the team with eight rebounds. All of Mpoyo's rebounds were offensive boards.

Donte' Jackson is in his second year as the head coach at Grambling State, guiding the Tigers to their first SWAC regular season title since the 1988-89 season. The Tigers finished with 17 wins and 13-5 in SWAC play. Jackson earned the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Honors. Before taking the Grambling job, he was head coach for four years at Central State and three years at Stillman.

This will be the fourth meeting between the Tigers of Grambling State and the Tigers of LSU. The last meeting came in 2011 with LSU scoring a 69-37 win. LSU won the other two meetings in 2000 (112-37) and 2008 (87-41).

VERSUS LOUISIANA COMPETITION
