2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O’Neal’s final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William “Will” Wade was named the 22nd head men’s basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

“I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here.”

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary’s in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade’s coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

LAST GAME: LSU 94, ARKANSAS 88 (OT) (January 12, 2019, Fayetteville, Arkansas)

LSU ended a nine-game losing streak on opponents home courts with the overtime win over Arkansas, dominating an overtime period by making 4-of-5 field goal attempts including both three-point attempts to out-score Arkansas, 13-7, in the extra session.

The Tigers got important contributions from just about everyone with Naz Reid hitting all four three-point attempts in hitting 10-of-12 from the field for 27 points and seven rebounds; Tremont Waters doubling up with 17 points and a personal equaling 11 assists; Skylar Mays 15 points in 41 minutes; and, junior college transfer Marlon Taylor getting 21 points and seven rebounds in 37 minutes. Also Emmitt Williams had just six points in 26 minutes, but what may have been overlooked was his 10 rebounds.

The Tigers shot 51.6 percent for the game including 4-of-5 in overtime (2-2 from the arc) and another good 18-of-22 at the free throw line.

LSU built a 50-42 lead at halftime and pushed the margin to 13 points on two separate occasions in the second half, the latter at 68-55 with 11:42 to play. But the Razorbacks outscored LSU, 26-13, over the rest of the

half to get the game to overtime. Arkansas scored the first two points of overtime, but back-to-back threes by Ja'vonte Smart and Naz Reid put LSU in position for the win.

OVERTIME – It marked the first time for a Will Wade coached team at LSU to get the win in overtime in three extra session games in his two years here. It was the 40th win for the Tigers in overtime in 96 games in school history. It stopped a five-game overall losing streak in overtime for the Tigers dating back to 2015. It marked the fifth overtime game against Arkansas with Arkansas 3-2 in those contests.

BACK-TO-BACK – It was the eighth win all-time against Arkansas in Fayetteville in 27 games and the first time LSU has won back-to-back games in Arkansas' home venue since the teams first met in 1949.

TIGERS AND REBELS PART OF QUARTET OF UNDEFEATED SEC TEAMS

LSU and Ole Miss are two of the four (along with South Carolina and Tennessee) that are undefeated in the SEC here in the early going.

LSU went to 2-0 for the first time since 2016 when LSU opened with a road win over Vanderbilt and a home win over No. 9 Kentucky. LSU last was 3-0 in the SEC in 2005-06 when the Tigers won their first seven SEC games.

LAST 5 GAMES – WINS VERSUS SAINT MARY'S, NO. 24 FURMAN, ULM, ALABAMA, AT ARKANSAS

In LSU's last five games – a 78-74 win versus Saint Mary's (in Las Vegas), a 75-57 win over No. 24 Furman, an 81-69 win over ULM – the Tigers have averaged 83.2 points per game, while giving up 73.4 a game. LSU has shot 50.7 percent from the field with 38 treys, while opponents shot 43.4 percent with 34 treys. LSU was 80-of-105 (76.2%) from the free throw line. LSU had a 34.6-31.8 rebound average advantage.

LSU IN THE NET; SEVEN QUADRANT 1-2 WINS

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

After weekend play, the Tigers are now 25 in the NET, one of five SEC teams in the top 25 of the NCAA Evaluation Toll.

LSU has seven total wins against teams in the Quadrant 1-2 section of the NET entering the week.

LSU is 0-2 (Florida State, Houston) in quadrant 1 play (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and 7-1 in quadrant 2 wins (Saint Mary's, Charleston, UNCG, Memphis, Charleston, Alabama, Arkansas)(home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Two of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4.

LSU's strength of schedule is 18th best in Division I.

TIGERS OWN 16-GAME WINNING STREAK AT MARAVICH CENTER

The win over ULM (12/21) extended LSU's winning streak at the Maravich Center to 16 games dating back to the final seven home games of a year ago. The Tigers won six regular season SEC home games to conclude the 2017-18 regular season and the NIT game with UL-Lafayette to reach seven and now eight in this 2018-19 season.

The present 16-game win streak is tied for the fifth longest in Maravich Center history and the longest since LSU won 17 straight at the end of the 2007-08 and start of 2008-09 seasons:

- 2 18 – Last 8 games 1983-84 season; First 10 games 1984-85 season

The win over Arkansas at Bud Walton Arena stopped a nine-game road losing streak for the Tigers and was the first time LSU has won consecutive road games in Fayetteville.

All-time, LSU is 420-637 on the road or a win percentage of 39.7 percent.

STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers in the first 15 games with 145 total (9.7 spg), with the total and average are ranked second in the SEC and tenth in the country.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league in both steals average (3.0) and total steals (45). He is fourth in the nation in steals per game and ninth in total nationally.

Skylar Mays is ranked third in the league in both steals average (1.9) and total steals (28). That is ranked 76th in the nation in average and 96th in total steals in the NCAA stats.

LSU is +2.1 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

Waters had eight steals in the ULM game (12/28), the second time (last year vs. A&M at home) that Waters had eight steals in a game. The eight steals is tied for most in the league in a single game by an individual this year. That number is also tied for the second most in a single game in LSU history:

LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

LSU has been over 50 percent from the field in three of the last four games and eight this season ... The Tigers posted a 55.4 percent shooting percentage against Furman (12/21), 52.5 percent against ULM (12/28) and 51.6 percent at Arkansas (1/12) ... Here are the 50 percent shooting games this season:

LSU is 7-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 19-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 80-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

TWO GOOD GAMES IN SEC PLAY SHOOTING THE THREE

The Tigers shot an amazing 80 percent from the arc in the first half against Alabama (1/8), hitting 8-of-10, including five in the final six minutes of the first half when LSU expanded the lead from three to 15 at the half. LSU finished the game 10-of-15 or 66.7 percent overall.

It marked the fourth time LSU has shot 66 percent or better when attempting at least 10 three-pointers in a game:

- 70.6% at South Alabama (12-17), 11/28/2010 (fifth all-time in SEC)**
- 66.7% vs. Alabama (10-15), 1/8/2019 (T10 all-time in SEC)**
- 66.7% vs. Vanderbilt (10-15), 2/12/2003 (T10 all-time in SEC)**
- 66.7% at Auburn (8-12), 2/13/1993 (T10 all-time in SEC)**

Against Arkansas, the Tigers also made 10 three-pointers in a 10-of-25 night (40%).

The Tigers are averaging 7.5 treys a game, compared to last year when LSU made a record 268 treys in 33 games (8.1 a game).

The Arkansas game was the fourth time this season (14 in Coach Wade's LSU tenure) the Tigers have hit

LSU is sixth in the SEC in three-point percentage (113-of-321, 35.2%), 138th nationally.

Opponents have made two more three-pointers than the Tigers so far this season (115-of-333, 34.5%).

LSU is 10th in the SEC in three-point field goal defense and accordingly only 218 nationally.

Three opponents – UNCG (19), Memphis (10) and Louisiana Tech (11) – recorded double digit three-point make games.

Tremont Waters and Skylar Mays are in a battle right now to see who will be the 21st LSU player with 100 career treys ... Mays enters the game with 96 career three-pointers and Waters has 94 treys.

INSIDE THE ARC

LSU continues to have its best games from two-point range at the Maravich Center where it is shooting over 58 percent at home.

For the season, LSU is No. 10 in the country in shooting percentage inside the arc at 57.1 percent for the season. The Tigers are second in the league in shooting inside the arc.

The Tigers are +0.9 over last year after shooting 56.2 percent inside the arc a year ago.

FREE THROWS

After two games making just 9-of-15 against Furman (12/21) and 9-of-16 against ULM (12/28), the Tigers have opened league play making a combined 40-of-49 (81.6%) at the charity stripe. The Tigers were 22-of-27 in the Alabama game (1/8), including 17-of-21 in the second half. At Arkansas (1/12), LSU was 18-of-22, including 10-of-13 in the second half and overtime.

LSU is third in the league and 49th in the nation in free throw percentage at 74.7 percent (242-324). In the league games, Tennessee and LSU are the two teams over 80 percent at the line in early play.

Opponents are 216-of-307 from the line (70.4%). The Tigers are +26 in free throw makes on 17 more attempts.

WILL WADE

The graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), as he coaches Tuesday his enters his 49th game as LSU coach, he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called major conferences in college basketball this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12, Big East, AAC) ... game. He is fifth in the league in assists and is No. 26 nationally.

In the last five games, Waters scoring average has gone up +1.9 and he has had 38 assists and 15 steals in those contests.

Waters in the Furman game became the 35th player in LSU history to get 100 career steals. With all the assists of late, he has already moved to 14th place on the career assists list with 288. He needs just four assists to move to No. 13 and that spot happens to belong to LSU's present day Director of Student-Athlete Development Tasmin Mitchell. Mitchell played as a freshman on LSU's NCAA Final Four team in 2006.

SKYLAR MAYS

The junior guard from Baton Rouge has had four double figure games in the present LSU win streak with 14 points versus Saint Mary's, 16 against Furman, 14 versus ULM and 15 versus Arkansas.

He didn't score in double figures against Alabama (1/8) but did have eight points with two assists and two steals.

For the season Mays is averaging a team high 13.3 points per game, 3.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.9 steals per game.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.01 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

Mays, who leads the team in three-point field goals (28) is shooting 50.4 percent from the floor (67-133) and 28-of-69 from the arc (40.6 percent). He is also exceptional at the line, making 37-of-42 free throws for 88.1%.

Mays is presently 14th among active career scorers in the SEC with 829 points and he is seventh in the league in career active assists leaders with 245. He is third behind only Q Weatherspoon of Mississippi State and KeVaughn Allen of Florida in active career steals in the SEC with 120.

JA'VONTE SMART

After struggling in the first two games of LSU's present win streak, scoring just a combined two points against Saint Mary's (12/15) and Furman (12/21) and making just 1-of-12 field goal attempts, the freshman has rallied back with 10 points against ULM (12/28) and 15 in the win over Alabama.

Against Arkansas, he had eight points but had two treys, including a very important three that got LSU going toward its overtime win.

He came off the bench for the first time in college against the Crimson Tide hitting 4-of-11 overall and 3-of-5 from the arc to go with five assists, just one turnover and one steal in 29 minutes.

The Baton Rouge native has delivered nine double figure scoring games this season including 18 at Houston (12/12) and 16 versus Louisiana Tech, Florida State and Incarnate Word.

Against Tech he had seven field goals with two treys with six field goals and two treys against Florida State. Versus UIW he also hit six field goals and two treys in the win. Against Houston, Smart in 36 minutes hit for six field goals, one trey and was 5-of-5 at the free throw line.

Smart enters the week averaging 10.4 points per game, 2.9 rebounds and 2.6 assists.

Since going 0-2 at the free throw line against Oklahoma State (11/25), Smart is 17-18 at the line in the last eight games. For the season, Smart is 31-of-36 at the stripe.

MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer had a huge game against Arkansas on Saturday that saw in contribute in so many ways:

Season high – 21 points

Co high – 7 rebounds (including 4 offensive)

Season high – 7 field goals (7-8 with 1 trey)

Timely free throws – 6-6

In LSU's five game winning streak, Taylor has started all five games for the Tigers. In the last six games, he has raised his scoring average from 5.1 points a game to 6.9 and his rebound average from 2.4 to 3.1. In the five game win streak, Taylor is 19-of-33 from the field.

Taylor has three double figure games, his debut against Southeastern (11/6) with 15 and 11 against Houston (12/12) before the Arkansas game.

For the season, Taylor has made 36-of-71 field goals (50.7 percent) with eight treys.

THREE, FOUR-GUARD OFFENSE

LSU and Coach Will Wade had consistently run at least three guards in the starting lineup for the first 15 games of the season – 10 games with Waters, Smart and Mays before two games with Smart, Mays and Taylor in the lineup with Waters coming off the bench. Against Alabama and Arkansas, the three guards were Waters, Mays and Taylor.

The one exception was against ULM (12/28), when based on the matchup, Coach Wade started four guards for the first time at LSU with Smart, Mays, Taylor and Waters in the starting lineup.

REBOUNDING NUMBERS

The Tigers have been out rebounded six times this year with a 4-2 record:

LSU's Emmitt Williams, who has two double doubles this year, leads the team in rebounding at 6.5 boards a game after grabbing 10 at Arkansas. Of his 91 rebounds, 40 are offensive. Williams is 12th in the SEC in rebounding average.

Naz Reid is at 5.5 rebounds a game with Kavell Bigby-Williams and Darius Days are at 4.7. LSU is 11 in the league in rebound average at 36.5 a game and fifth in rebound defense at 32.5 a contest.

KBW AND THE BLOCKS

Entering the week, Kavell Bigby-Williams' nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

After blocking five against Alabama, Bigby-Williams averages 2.1 blocks per game. That is fifth in the league and No. 34 in the nation.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

Bigby-Williams has also had some good games offensively this season:

Bigby-Williams 14-13 game against Alabama was his third double double of the season and in that game he was also 4-4 of the free throw line.

For the season, Bigby-Williams with six starts is averaging 7.8 points and 4.7 rebounds. He is averaging 17.1 minutes a game and is 40-of-61 from the field (65.6 percent).

DARIUS DAYS

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 6.7 points and 4.7 rebounds. He is 36-of-72 from the field and an impressive 18-of-22 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days was 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys.

His best game of the year came against Alabama (1/8) as far as scoring with 14 points on 5-of-10 shooting, including 3-of-4 from the arc.

NAZ REID

After playing his fewest minutes against Alabama (1/8) because of eventually fouling out after 17 minutes of court time (7 pts, 3 blks), Reid had a strong game at Arkansas (1/12) with 27 points on 10-of-12 field goal shooting which included 4-of-4 three-pointers. He also was 3-of-4 at the free throw line. He had seven rebounds and two assists.

For Reid, the Arkansas game was his second best scoring game of the season and continued a four-game run in which he has scored 62 points with 30 rebounds and shooting 23-of-34 from the field with six treys.

He scored his first double double against ULM (12/28) with 19 points and 12 rebounds after just missing a double double against No. 24 Furman (12/21) when he had nine points and 10 rebounds.

His best scoring game was in the second game of his LSU career, scoring 29 against UNCG. That was also a game in which he made four three-pointers.

The freshman was named Player of the Week in Louisiana for his play in the ULM game by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

He is averaging for the year 13.2 points and 5.5 rebounds along with 1.1 assist per game. He has started 13 games and is shooting 74-of-141 (52.5%) from the field with 16 treys. In the last six games, his scoring average is up +1.1.

EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman has been in double figures in two of the Tigers last five wins with 15 points versus Saint Mary's in the game in Las Vegas (12/15) and then 12 in 27 minutes off the bench against ULM (12/28).

That 15 points was a season high on 4-of-6 shooting and a perfect 7-of-7 at the free throw line. Williams had six boards with two assists and a steal. Against Furman (12/21), he hit all three field goal attempts and had eight points and against ULM he was 6-of-7 from the field with eight rebounds and two assists.

He has two double doubles – 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13). He had his third double figure rebound game at Arkansas (1/12) with 10.

Williams is averaging 8.6 points per game, 6.5 rebounds and is shooting 68.2 percent from the field (45-66) to go with 29-of-42 at the free throw line. In the last five games, Williams has gone 4-of-6, 3-of-3, 6-of-7, 2-of-3 and 3-of-3 from the field in the last five games.

FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at 15 games of 1.08, ranked 328 of the 353 teams as of the New Year. Only Arkansas and Kentucky have younger experience ranks in Kenpom.

The freshmen on the LSU team have scored 46.6 percent of LSU's points this season.

FORMER BASEBALL PLAYER SCORES IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES

Former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese scored his first two collegiate points in the Grambling game (12/1) and had another two against UIW (12/9). He joins a group of former players to have handled the two sport aspect at LSU. He was a scholarship pitcher for the baseball team for two seasons before deciding to walk-on to the men's basketball team at LSU, playing basketball for the first time since leading Anacoco High to two state titles.

He is the first two-sport player to score for LSU basketball since Robert Royal on Jan. 17, 20001 (FB, BKB) and he is the first LSU baseball player to record points since Lyle Mouton on March 17, 1989. Of course the SEC Network and ESPN/SEC Network's Ben McDonald also participated in both basketball and baseball in his time at LSU in the mid-1980s.

SERIES VERSUS OLE MISS

Ole Miss is 3-0 in the SEC and comes into the game at The Pavilion with 10 straight wins and a 13-2 overall record. The Rebels defeated Mississippi State on Saturday in Starkville, 81-77. Blake Hinson had 26 points with five treys with Breein Tyree getting 19 (5 assists), Terence Davis 12 and Devontae Shuler 10.

Ole Miss rallied from 41-39 down at halftime, shooting 46.6 percent for the game (27-58) and 12-31 from the arc. Ole Miss had an 18-11 advantage in points off turnovers.

For the year, Breein is averaging 17.5 points a game, Davis 15.7 and Shuler 10.6. In their three SEC games, Breein is at 18.3 points, Davis 16.7, Hinson 14.7 and Shuler 11.7.

Kermit Davis, Jr., is in his first year as the head coach at Ole Miss after a distinguished run at Middle Tennessee. He is a former LSU assistant coach, serving with head coach John Brady during the early part of Brady's tenure in the late 1990s.

LSU leads the overall series with the Rebels, 121-88, with LSU winning four of the last five. The loss came in 2017 when LSU made its only appearance to date at The Pavilion, losing 96-76. LSU's last win in Oxford came in 2015. Ole Miss leads, 55-38, in games in Oxford.

TIGERS BACK HOME FOR TWO STARTING SATURDAY

LSU will return to action at the Maravich Center for two games, facing South Carolina on Saturday (Jan. 19) at 5 p.m. against South Carolina and then on Wednesday, Jan. 23 at 6 p.m. against Georgia.
