### Team Notes/Up Next

• **Tough Defense:** LSU is keeping its opponents off the scoreboard at the rate of 52.9 points per game. The scoring defense ranks 8th in the nation and is tops in the SEC. The Lady Tigers' 3-point shooting defense is 4th in the league at 28.4 percent.

• **Mitchell's Marks:** Junior Ayana Mitchell, a preseason All-SEC selection, would rank 27th in the nation and 3rd in the SEC with a 57.8 field goal percentage. She is averaging 4.9 made shots per game and needs 5.0 to be included in the ranking. Mitchell is also 4th in the SEC in rebounds per game at 9.9 and 2nd with eight double-doubles on the season. Mitchell ranks 18th in the SEC with 13.4 points per game and 8th in steals per game (1.9).

• **Transfer Impact:** Junior college transfers Mercedes Brooks and Karli Seay are key components in LSU's recent improvement in bench play. Brooks is averaging 9.1 points per game since returning from the Christmas break. Seay is contributing 3.0 points and 1.1 assists and 1.1 steals per game in that same stretch.

• **Against Kentucky:** This will be the 49th meeting between LSU and Kentucky. The Lady Tigers hold a 33-15 lead in the series. LSU won last year's only meeting, 72-70, in Rupp Arena on Feb. 4. It was Nikki Fargas' 200th win of her career.

• **We Back Pat:** The game against Kentucky will be LSU's annual We Back Pat game to raise awareness for the need to increase funding in the search for a cure for Alzheimer's and dementia. The Pat Summitt Foundation has partnered with the SEC to celebrate the life of Coach Summitt and bring awareness to the need for more research.

Nikki Fargas and Tasha Butts played for Coach Summitt at Tennessee, while Fargas and Kentucky head coach Matthew Mitchell served on her staff at different times in their careers.

**Opponent Info - No. 16/15 Kentucky (15-3; 2-2 SEC)**

This will be the 49th meeting between LSU and Kentucky. The Lady Tigers hold a 33-15 lead in the series. LSU won last year's only meeting, 72-70, in Rupp Arena on Feb. 4. It was Nikki Fargas' 200th win of her career.

The Wildcats have three players in double figures, led by freshman guard Rhyne Howard with 16.9 points per game and senior guard Maci Morris at 16.8 points per game. Senior guard Taylor Murray is pitching in 12.3 points per game and leads the team with 68 assists. Howard is the top rebounder for Kentucky with 7.1 boards per game.

Head coach Matthew Mitchell is in his 12th season at Kentucky. He spent the 1999-2000 season as a graduate assistant under Pat Summitt.

**Home Court Advantage**

The Lady Tigers have a comfortable 479-133 record in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

**Schedule Strength**

In addition to the six SEC opponents on the LSU schedule who made the 2018 NCAA Tournament, the Lady Tigers will be challenged by five non-conference teams that made postseason play. Northern Colorado and Nicholls State made their inaugural appearances in the premier women's basketball postseason event, while Little Rock, USF and Florida State made return appearances.

**Statistically Speaking ...**

- LSU's scoring defense ranks 8th in the nation and is tops in the SEC at 52.9 points per game.

- The Lady Tigers have won or tied the battle of the boards in 13 of 16 games this season.

- LSU is forcing its opponents to commit 18.9 turnovers per game and are scoring 18.2 points per game off of those turnovers.

- Junior Ayana Mitchell would rank 27th in the nation and 3rd in the SEC with a 57.8 field goal percentage. She is averaging 4.9 made shots per game and needs 5.0 to be included in the ranking. Mitchell is also 4th in the SEC in rebounds per game at 9.9 and 2nd with eight double-doubles on the season. Mitchell ranks 18th in the SEC with 13.4 points per game and 8th in steals per game (1.9).

- LSU is 31-13 when Ayana Mitchell scores 10 or more points in a game. When she doesn't, LSU is 18-15.

- Sophomore Khayla Pointer ranks tied for 4th in assists per game (4.9) in the SEC and is 25th with 12.6 points per game. She is also tied for 13th in steals with 1.8 swipes per game.

- Sophomore Faustine Aifuwa is 9th in the league in blocked shots per game with a 1.2 average. She is 2nd on the team in rebounding with 5.7 boards per game.

- Junior college transfers Mercedes Brooks and Karli Seay are key components in LSU's recent improvement in bench play. Brooks is averaging 9.1 points per game since returning from the Christmas break. Seay is contributing 3.0 points and 1.1 assists and 1.1 steals per game in that same stretch.

**News & Notes ...**

- **Graduation Day:** Senior Shanice Norton earned her SEC Graduate patch in 3.5 years on Dec. 14, 2018. Norton will pursue a second degree during the Spring semester.

- **Century Mark Career Day:** Senior Shanice Norton played in her 100th game as a Lady Tiger on Dec. 27 versus Southeastern Louisiana. Norton recorded the first double-double of her career with 10 points and a career-high 13 rebounds.

- **Catching Sylvia:** Junior Ayana Mitchell recorded her fourth consecutive double-double of the season on November 18 at Florida State with 10 points and 10 rebounds. The feat was last done by a Lady Tiger in 2008, when Sylvia Fowles posted four consecutive double-doubles to end the season and her Lady Tiger career.

- Her third double-double of the season was on Nov. 15 versus Tulane with 19 points and tied her career rebounds mark with 18.

- She set her career rebounding high Nov. 11 against Northern Colorado. Mitchell grabbed a career-high 18 rebounds and added 14 points in the effort.

- The Preseason All-SEC player scored 20 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in the season opener versus Sam Houston State for her first double-double of the season.

- **Did That Really Happen?:** For the first time in the quarter-format era, LSU held an opponent scoreless in a quarter on Nov. 18 at Florida State. The Lady Tigers were trailing the Seminoles, 17-13, with 1:01 left in the first quarter before going on a 22-0 run and keeping FSU scoreless in the second quarter. By the end of the first half, LSU had built an 18-point lead, 35-17. The third quarter started out quietly as the stingy Lady Tiger defense continued to hold off FSU for another 1:26. In total, LSU kept FSU from scoring for a consecutive 12 minutes and 27 seconds. The fewest points scored against LSU in a quarter had been 2, by Alabama in the 4th quarter on February 5, 2017.

- **50+ Wins:** LSU's 86-36 win over McNeese on December 18 was the 21st game in program history that the Lady Tigers defeated an opponent by 50 points or more. The last time LSU beat a team by 50 or more points was Dec. 28, 2016 against Alabama State, 93-40.

Nikki Fargas knows success and what it takes to be successful. Entering her eighth season at the helm of the Lady Tiger Basketball program in 2018-19, Fargas is driven to keep the Lady Tigers on the national stage.

"We're going to do everything in our power to make sure that LSU Women's Basketball is at that elite level, that we are competing for SEC championships, and that we are positioning ourselves to cut down nets," said Fargas.

Fargas has produced four 20-win seasons and an overall record of 132-93 in seven seasons at LSU. Her 132 victories ranks her as the second-winningest Lady Tiger basketball coach in school history in terms of total wins, behind legendary coach Sue Gunter. In her first seven seasons, LSU secured six NCAA Tournament appearances highlighted by back-to-back trips to the NCAA Sweet 16, and 22 victories over ranked opponents.

Fargas, who won national titles as both a player and an assistant coach at Tennessee and turned UCLA into a national power in just three years, has that combination of outstanding in-game coaching ability and tremendous recruiting competence. In addition, Fargas has been a leader off the court in the Baton Rouge community, helping the Lady Tigers connect with the city of Baton Rouge while donating their time and efforts to making a difference. She and her Lady Tigers were heavily involved in assisting residents and local church

communities following the devastating flood in August 2016 that impacted thousands of people in the area.

In 10 seasons as head coach at both UCLA and LSU, Fargas owns a 204-119 overall record and a 99-67 mark in conference play.

In the classroom, LSU has been a shining example of the definition of student-athlete. The Lady Tigers have recorded a perfect score of 100 in graduation success rate released by the NCAA during three seasons under Fargas. For players who have exhausted their eligibility at LSU, Fargas boasts a 100-percent graduation rate. In her first seven seasons, the Lady Tigers have earned 23 SEC Academic Honor Roll accolades.

Well respected in coaching circles, Fargas has twice been selected by the USA Women's Basketball Committee to serve as an assistant coach for USA National Teams. In the summer of 2012, she became the first coach in LSU history to serve on a USA U18 team staff since the squad's inception in 1988. That team claimed the gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship. In the summer of 2013, most of that group reunited to lead the USA U19 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA World Championships in Lithuania. Fargas is the only coach in LSU history to claim multiple USA gold medals during her tenure as Lady Tiger head coach.

Fargas has been a part of a championship and winning

pedigree at every level of her career and owns an impressive 608-195 record as a player, graduate assistant, assistant coach and head coach dating back to her freshman season at Tennessee. She played, coached and studied under one of the game's greatest figures, the legendary Pat Summitt at Tennessee and she assisted Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan at Virginia.

Widely recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches during stints at Tennessee and Virginia, Fargas took over at UCLA in 2008. In three years with the Bruins, she turned around a UCLA program that had won only one NCAA Tournament game in the nine years prior to her arrival. Fargas led the Bruins to a 72-26 (.735) overall mark, reached the NCAA Tournament twice and finished second in the Pac-10 Conference in both 2010 and 2011.

Off the court, Fargas is a passionate crusader for breast cancer awareness. She is a co-founder of the non-profit organization, Champions for a Cause. Since 2007, the group has raised over \$300,000 through Cruisin' for a Cause, a long-haul motorcycle adventure to raise dollars and awareness for a cure for breast cancer.

Fargas, was raised in Oak Ridge, Tenn., by her mother, Jean Caldwell. She and her husband Justin Fargas are the proud parents of a six-year-old daughter, Justice Simone.
