# Will Wade

**Head Coach**

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

### LAST GAME: ARKANSAS 90, LSU 89 (Feb. 2, Baton Rouge)

The Tigers came close to another comeback to talk about for the second straight Saturday, but fell short in their first loss in over a year at the Maravich Center. Arkansas shot over 60 percent for much of the game and made 13-of-24 three-pointers to hold a four-point halftime lead and as much as an 18-point advantage with 13:45 to play (66-48) and as much as a 17-point advantage (72-55) still with 10:33 to go.

But just like the Missouri game when LSU rallied from 14 down with 2:14 to play, the Tigers were able to slowly gather itself back into the contest, taking the lead for the first time at the 3:39 mark on a layup by Javonte Smart. The Tigers would take other one-point leads at 87-86 (FT by Emmitt Williams) and their final points at 89-88 with 2:01 to play (FT by Smart).

After that there were two missed shots by Arkansas and a miss and a turnover by LSU before Arkansas got the winning bucket with 22 seconds to play. LSU would miss three shots in the final possession.

Naz Reid had his first SEC double double, second of the year with 19 points and 10 rebounds, with Javonte Smart off the bench getting 18 points, Skylar Mays 17, Tremont Waters 12 points (6 assists) and Kavell Bigby-Williams 10.

Arkansas would shoot 58.3 percent for the game and 54.2 percent from the arc while LSU shot 44.1 percent



(26-59) and 5-of-24 from the arc (20.8 percent). LSU did make free throws, making 32 for the second time this year, (32-38) or 84.2 percent. LSU out rebounded Arkansas 44-20 (29-10 in second half) and 19-4 on the offensive glass. LSU had a 21-6 advantage in points off turnovers, but the Tigers turned the ball over 21 times.

#### LEAGUE REACHES HALFWAY POINT IN TUESDAY/WEDNESDAY SCHEDULE

The league will reach the halfway point when the Wednesday schedule concludes with the LSU at Mississippi State and Georgia at Alabama game. Entering the week, four teams – Tennessee (8-0), Kentucky and LSU (7-1) and South Carolina (6-2) – have separated themselves by at least two games from six teams – Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Mississippi and Mississippi State – that are all 4-4.

The Tigers have three of the next four on the road – at Mississippi State Wednesday and then next week at Kentucky (Feb. 12) and at Georgia (Feb. 16). The home game will be Feb. 9 at 1 p.m. against Auburn.

#### SCORING NOTES

The game with Arkansas in a 90-89 loss marked the first time in 12 games this season that LSU has scored at least 80 points and lost (6-1 when scoring in the 80s and 5-0 when scoring in the 90s). LSU is 24-4 in the Will Wade era when scoring 80 or more and 10-0 in the Wade era when scoring 90 or more.

On defense, the Tigers are 10-0 when allowing less than 70 points and 20-1 in the Coach Wade era when allowing less than 70 points.

#### TIGERS 18-GAME WINNING STREAK AT MARAVICH CENTER STOPPED AT SECOND LONGEST

The loss to Arkansas Saturday stopped the Tigers 18-game winning streak, leaving the 18 games streak that started in late January 2018 tied for the second longest in the building history. LSU won its last six regular season SEC home games a year ago, an NIT first-round game and the first 11 home games in the 2018-19 season to get this 18-game streak.

The Tigers have been playing in the Maravich Center, originally the LSU Assembly Center, since January 3, 1972.

The Tigers, all-time, are 560-194 (74.3%) in the building and 256-151 in SEC games (63.0%).

#### RANKINGS UPDATE

The LSU Tigers are ranked for a third straight week and for the sixth time this season, falling two spots from 19 to 21 in the poll released on Monday ... LSU was ranked No. 23 in the preseason poll, No. 22 in the second poll and 19 in week three. LSU received votes out of the top 25 in week four and 11 before getting back in at 25, 19 and now 21 the last three polls.

Also in besides the Tigers and No. 1 Tennessee from the SEC are Kentucky at No. 5 in the AP poll.

LSU is ranked 22 in the Amway Coaches Poll.

The Tigers are 8-3 this year when ranked (5-2 in their first stint, 3-1 in this stint) and overall is 268-102 as a ranked team all-time. This is the 204th poll appearance since the first poll began in 1949.

#### LSU IN THE NET; NINE QUADRANT 1-2 WINS

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

After play on Sunday, the Tigers are now 20 in the NET, one of three SEC teams in the top 20 of the NCAA Evaluation Toll.

LSU has a 9-3 mark against teams in the Quadrant 1-2 section of the NET. Altogether, 13-of-LSU's 21 games are either presently Quadrant 1 or Quadrant 2 games.

The wins over Saint Mary's (Neutral), Ole Miss and Arkansas (both road) are Quadrant 1 wins where LSU is 3-2 (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75) and the Tigers are 6-2 in quadrant 2 wins (W, Alabama, UNCG, Memphis, Saint Mary's, Missouri, Texas A&M)(home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Four of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and four in quadrant 4.

LSU's strength of schedule is 30th best in Division I.

## DUNK-O-METER REGISTERED 10 AGAINST ARKANSAS

The revived dunk-o-meter has gotten lots of use here lately, including Saturday's Arkansas game when 10 were registered.

It was suggested back when Shaquille O'Neal arrived at LSU before the 1989-90 season that we find a spot in the notes for the total number of dunks O'Neal primarily and with him the rest of the Tigers had in those three years he was at LSU. Thus for lack of a better title, the Dunk-O-Meter was born.

Now with what may be one of the most exciting and entertaining teams in college basketball this year, it was requested on social media that the dunk-o-meter make a return. Even though the dunks have been a part of the stats in the game notes all season, we will move some team totals and other dunk notes to this spot.

That put the team over 100 dunks for the season with Kavell Bigby-Williams has 28 dunks and Marlon Taylor with 26, Naz Reid 22, Emmitt Williams 16 and Skylar Mays completing those in double figures with 11.

Marlon Taylor became the third member of the Tigers team that has made SportsCenter top play when he took an alley-oop from Tremont Waters to earn No. 1 play on Thursday morning. Waters and Skylar Mays were featured in multiple POD last season.

## ON THE ROAD

The win over Arkansas (1/12) at Bud Walton Arena stopped a nine-game road losing streak for the Tigers and was the first time LSU had won consecutive road games in Fayetteville since they first played the Hogs in 1949.

Now with the win at Texas A&M last Wednesday, the Tigers have won their first four road league games for the sixth time in school history:

1980-81 - 8 (started 8-0 on road; lost final game at UK)

1952-53 - 7 (finished 7-0 on the road)

1953-54 - 6 (finished 6-0 on the road)

1990-91 - 5

**2018-19 - 4**

1945-46 - 4 (finished 4-0 on the road)

LSU won its first three road games in 2018.

Highlighting the four road wins was LSU's first win in The Pavilion at Ole Miss, 83-69. The win margin of 14 points was LSU's largest win ever on an opponent's home court against a ranked team. Also there are two overtime wins at Arkansas and Missouri.

All-time, LSU is 423-637 on the road or a win percentage of 39.9 percent.

## EIGHT IS ENOUGH

It was a popular ABC TV show in the late 1970s through the early 1980s, but it also is proving to be the mantra for LSU's team in the SEC.

Coach Will Wade has pretty much settled into the eight-man rotation of guards Waters, Mays, Smart and Taylor and forwards Reid, Bigby-Williams, Williams and Days. That rotation became official after the announcement earlier in the month when Daryl Edwards had undergo surgery on his injured leg/foot.

Also able to contribute are Marshall Graves and former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese.

## STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers with 205 total (9.8 spg), with the average ranked first in the SEC and xxxx in the country.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league in both steals average (3.0) and total steals (62). He is xxxx in the nation in steals per game and xxxxx in total nationally.

Skylar Mays is ranked third in the league in both steals average (2.0) and total steals (43). That is ranked xxx in the nation in average and xxx in total steals in the NCAA stats.

LSU is +2.2 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

Waters had eight steals in the ULM game (12/28), the second time (last year vs. A&M at home) that Waters had eight steals in a game. The eight steals is tied for most in the league in a single game by an individual this year. That number is also tied for the second most in a single game in LSU history:

With a minimum of 11 games remaining, Waters is on pace to reach the LSU total steals record of 93 set by Daryl Joe in 1987 (62 total to date).

## FREE THROW TOTALS TRENDING UP

There have been some ups and downs at the free throw line for LSU, but the Tigers shot over 90 percent at the line for the second time this season against South Carolina (1/19). Here are the numbers for those

games:

**UNCG (11/9) – 28-of-31 – 90.3%**  
**Carolina (1/19) – 32-of-35 – 91.4%**

In the UNCG game, the Tigers made their first 22 attempts before a miss. Against South Carolina, the Tigers made their last 19 in a 19-of-19 second half at the line.

LSU started slow against Georgia (1/23) making just 7-of-12 in the first half, but made 14-of-17 in the second half to finish 21-of-29 (72.4%). At Missouri (1/26), LSU attempted 37 and made 29 for 78.4 percent. Skylar Mays became the first player in the Will Wade era at LSU to make 10 free throws in a game.

The Tigers made 32 free throws for the second time in SEC play this year against Arkansas (2/2) when they made 32-of-38 from the line. The Tigers were 12-of-13 in the first half and 20-of-25 in the final 20 minutes. The final free throw percentage was 84.2 percent.

In 10 games, LSU has made at least 20 free throws including six of the last eight games. The South Carolina and Arkansas games were nearly record setters as only once since the 2002-03 season has the Tigers had a game where they made more than 32 free throws (37 vs. Georgia, 1/26/16).

The 91.4 percent against the Gamecocks is LSU's highest when taking at least 35 free throws, which has happened more times than you might think according to webmaster Todd Politz who found it has happened 148 times since 1966.

The Tigers are second in the league and xxx in the nation in free throw percentage at 76.4 percent (389-509). Opponents are 296-423 (70%). LSU is +93 in free throw makes on 86 more attempts. Mays is 65-of-74 (87.8 percent), with Javonte Smart at 86.5% (45-52). Darius Day is also over 80 percent at 84 percent (21-25).

In the SEC games, the Tigers are 187-of-234 or 79.9 percent, compared to 119-of-170 (70%). In SEC play, the Tigers have made more free throws (187) than the eight opponents have attempted (170). Mays is 35-40 (87.5 percent), Smart is at 87 percent (20-23) and Marlon Taylor 20-23 (80 percent).

LSU has only lost 46 times in the last 52 seasons (402 games) when it has made more free throws in a game than the opponent attempts.

#### LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

LSU has been over 50 percent from the field in nine games this season ... Here are the 50 percent shooting games this season:

LSU is 8-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 20-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to once at the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 81-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

LSU is fourth in the league in field goal percentage at 47.2 percent.

#### THREE-POINTERS

LSU was good from the arc in the first three conference games, making 10 versus both Alabama (1/9) and at Arkansas (1/12) and nine at Ole Miss (1/15) for 29 three-point makes. LSU has made just 29 total in the last five conference games.

In the eight conference games, LSU is 58-of-179 from the arc (32.4 percent) while opponents are 53-of-173 (30.6%) after Arkansas' big game from the arc. In the last five games, LSU is 3-of-19, 5-of-20, 9-32, 7-of-25 and 5-of-24 (29-120, 24.2%).

The Tigers shot an amazing 80 percent from the arc in the first half against Alabama (1/8), hitting 8-of-10, including five in the final six minutes of the first half when LSU expanded the lead from three to 15 at the half. LSU finished the game 10-of-15 or 66.7 percent overall.

It marked the fourth time LSU has shot 66 percent or better when attempting at least 10 three-pointers in a game:

Tremont Waters had six three-point field goals (1/30) at Texas A&M when he scored 36 points. The six field three-point field goals by Waters marked the 11th time an LSU player has made at least six field goals in a game since 2003. Ten of those were six treys and Marcus Thornton, who had eight at Auburn (1/30/08). It was the first time a player had six treys in a game since Keith Hornsby at Houston on Dec. 13, 2015.

#### WILL WADE

The graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he coached on Jan. 19th his 50th game as LSU coach. In his two years, he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called major conferences in college basketball this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12, Big East, AAC) ...

The 10-game LSU win streak marked the longest win streak for Coach Wade at LSU and T2 for the longest win streak in his head coaching career. Wade had winning streaks of 12 and 10 at either Chattanooga or VCU before the 10-game streak at LSU.

### TREMONT WATERS

He has said through the ups and downs of the season that it was "just about playing basketball" and he was just playing basketball Wednesday at College Station as he scored 23 first-half points on the way to his second highest career scoring game of 36 in the win over the Aggies.

Waters had 39 as a freshman against Marquette in the Maui Invitational in November 2017 and was scoring almost at will, especially in the first half when he hit 5-of-7 treys. For the game he was 11-of-18 from the field, 6-of-10 at the arc and just as impressive, 8-of-8 from the line. He also had seven assists and three steals.

The 36 points by Tremont Waters against A&M (1/30) is T5 among all individual point games by LSU since the 2003 season and the sophomore has two of those games:

On January 23, in the win over Georgia, the sophomore from New Haven, Connecticut posted a 26-points, no turnover game. It was his first no turnover game at LSU. He made 9-of-14 field goal attempts, one trey and 7-of-11 at the free throw line. Not to mention his passing to Marlon Taylor that led to the No. 1 play the next day on SportsCenter.

Waters has been in double figure scoring for 12 straight games dating back to the Houston loss on Dec. 12. He is the first LSU player with double figure consecutive double figure scoring games since Ben Simmons ran off 28 in his 2016 season at LSU.

Waters flirted with a triple double against ULM in equaling his career high in steals, a game he also flirted with similar numbers.

The six assists versus Arkansas (2/2) marked the 14th time he has five or more assists in a game this season and the 35th in his two-year career. Waters had his fourth game of the season or 10-or-more assists versus Arkansas (1/12) and his ninth game of 10 or more assists in his career (third with 11 assists):

### SKYLAR MAYS

The junior guard from Baton Rouge has had five double figure games in SEC play, including 17 against Arkansas on Saturday.

Included in that are back-to-back 20-point games with 20 versus Georgia (1/23) and 24 at Mizzou (1/26) which included the 9-0 run that started LSU's comeback to force overtime from 14 down.

Against Mizzou, Mays was 6-of-12 from the field with two treys and 10-of-12 from the free throw line.

The junior struggled from the field at A&M (1/30), but his primary defense on Wendell Mitchell was outstanding, holding the A&M scorer to just two points. But Mays rebounded for a good offensive game against the Razorbacks (2/2) with the 17 points.

For the season Mays is averaging 13.4 points per game, 3.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

The second team Academic A-A chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.008 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for the highest GPA by undergraduate student-athletes.

His free throw percentage of 87.8 percent is the best in the conference and xxxxx in the nation.

#### JAVONTE SMART

Freshman Javonte Smart had his fourth double figure scoring game in the last five against Arkansas (2/2) when he scored 18 points, tying his season high for the season. Smart has five field goals with a trey and 7-of-8 at the free throw line. He previously had 18 points in the game at Houston (12/12).

For the season, Smart has made 27 treys and is shooting well from the free throw line at 86.5 percent (45-52). In the four double figure games recorded in the last five, he was 14-of-16 at the charity stripe. He is averaging 10.6 points a game and 2.3 assists.

He started the first 13 games before coming off the bench the last eight. He came off the bench for the first time in college against the Crimson Tide (1/8) hitting 4-of-11 overall and 3-of-5 from the arc to go with five assists, just one turnover and one steal in 29 minutes.

The Baton Rouge native has delivered 13 double figure scoring games this season.

#### MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer had a huge game at Arkansas (1/12) that saw him contribute in so many ways: Season high – 21 pts; Co high – 7 rebs (4 offensive); Season high – 7 FGs (7-8, 1 trey); 6-6 FTs

Then at Ole Miss, he came with more good numbers (1/15): 12 pts; 5 rebs, 5-8 FGs (2 treys, equaling season best); 2 asts, 2 stls

Against South Carolina (1/19), Taylor was in double figures for the third straight game with 10 points, but eight of the points came at the foul line where he was 8-of-9. It was his second big free throw game of the year, making 9-of-11 at Houston (12/12).

Against Georgia (1/23), it wasn't double figures but an appearance in SportsCenter's top plays that made it another night for Taylor to be remembered.

For the season, Taylor has made 52-of-108 field goals (48.1%) with 10 treys. He is averaging 7.2 points and 3.6 rebounds a game. In the league, Taylor has averaged 9.1 points a game, shooting 25-of-51 from the field, and 5.1 rebounds.

#### THREE, FOUR-GUARD OFFENSE

LSU and Coach Will Wade has consistently run at least three guards in the starting lineup for the first 21 games of the season – 10 games with Waters, Smart and Mays before two games with Smart, Mays and Taylor in the lineup with Waters coming off the bench. In the seven conference games, the three guards have been Waters, Mays and Taylor.

The one exception was against ULM (12/28), when based on the matchup, Coach Wade started four guards for the first time in his two years at LSU with Smart, Mays, Taylor and Waters in the starting lineup.

In the last two games, Darius Days has grabbed 15 rebounds and 11 were offensive. Williams has grabbed 15 rebounds in the last four games and 11 were offensive.

#### KBW AND THE BLOCKS

Entering the week, Kavell Bigby-Williams' nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 is tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

Bigby-Williams averages 2.1 blocks per game. That is T3 in the league and xxxxx in the nation.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

Bigby-Williams' 12-11 game versus South Carolina was his fifth double double of the season. More importantly, it was back-to-back double doubles and his first back-to-back double figure scoring games this season. For his efforts against Ole Miss and South Carolina, he was named SEC Player of the Week. He had another double figure rebound game against A&M (1/30), pulling down 11 rebounds. For the season, Bigby-Williams is averaging 7.5 points and 5.4 rebounds. He is averaging 18.4 minutes a game and is a good 61-of-90 from the field (67.8 percent). He has posted eight double figure scoring games.

### NAZ REID

The freshman had his first SEC double double against Arkansas (2/2) with 19 points and 10 rebounds, hitting five field goals, including a trey and 8-9 at the free throw line. It was his second double double of the seasons, getting 19 points and 12 rebounds against ULM (12/28). It was his third game in double figure rebounds this season.

Three times this year he has had three consecutive double figure scoring games, including 15 against South Carolina, 15 versus Georgia and 14 at Missouri.

In the rally against Missouri, Reid had two important free throws, part of a 9-9 night at the free throw line. Reid is 62-of-83 at the stripe for 74.7 percent and 27-of-31 in the past five games combined.

In his opening game of SEC play, he played his fewest minutes against Alabama (1/8) because of eventually fouling out after 17 minutes of court time (7 pts, 3 blks). But Reid had a strong game at Arkansas (1/12) with 27 points on 10-of-12 field goal shooting which included 4-of-4 three-pointers. He also was 3-of-4 at the free throw line. He had seven rebounds and two assists.

His best scoring game was in the second game of his LSU career, scoring 29 against UNCG. That was also a game in which he made four three-pointers.

The freshman was named Player of the Week in Louisiana for his play in the ULM game by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

He is averaging for the year 13.2 points and 5.9 rebounds, his highest rebound average since the third game of the season. He has started 19 games. He is averaging 14.1 points and 6.1 rebounds in the SEC games.

### DARIUS DAYS

Coach Wade in his media session on Jan. 25 predicted success for the freshman and he has delivered in many ways the last two games, especially on the boards. At College Station (1/30), Days had nine points on 4-of-7 shooting, including a three, with eight rebounds, a block and a steal in 15 minutes. Days had seven offensive rebounds and that led to three offensive put backs and scores for the Tigers.

Against Arkansas, he didn't score but he had seven more rebounds and four of those were offensive.

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 5.6 points and 4.6 rebounds. He is 42-of-93 from the field and an impressive 21-of-25 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days was 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys.

His best game of the year came against Alabama (1/8) as far as scoring with 14 points on 5-of-10 shooting, including 3-of-4 from the arc.

### EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman had seven points and five rebounds (three offensive) against Missouri (1/26) but it was his hustle play when he was fouled with 2.2 seconds that got him to the line for a most pressure packed free throw that got LSU to the overtime. After missing the first, he got the roll on the second one to get LSU even at 71-71.

The freshman has been in double figures in six games this season, the last with 15 points against South Carolina (1/19).

The 15 points represent a season high. Against South Carolina, he played 24 minutes and made 3-of-8 from the field and 9-of-10 from the free throw line. For the game, he also had his third double double with 13 rebounds. He also had 15 points against Saint Mary's (12/15).

His other two doubles came with 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13). He had his fourth double figure rebound game at Arkansas (1/12) with 10.

Williams is averaging 8.1 points per game, 6.1 rebounds and is shooting 62.6 percent from the field (57-91) to go with 46-of-67 at the free throw line.

### FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at 19 games of 1.08, ranked 327 of the 353 teams as of Monday. Only Arkansas and Kentucky have younger experience ranks in Kenpom.

The freshmen on the LSU team have scored 44.6 percent of LSU's points this season overall and 41.4% of the points in LSU's eight SEC games.

### SERIES VERSUS MISSISSIPPI STATE

Mississippi State comes into Wednesday's game 16-5 overall and 4-4 in the SEC after an 81-75 win over Mississippi at The Pavilion in Oxford Saturday. The Rebels had a 43-39 halftime advantage before Mississippi State outscored Ole Miss, 42-32, in the second half. The Bulldogs shot 52 percent in the second half of the game making 13-of-25 shots. MSU out-rebounded the Rebels, 40-28, and had a 19-6 advantage in points off turnovers. Quindary Weatherspoon had 27 points for Mississippi State and Reggie Perry added 21 points and 11 rebounds.

Q Weatherspoon averaged 17.6 points a game with Lamar Peters averaging 12.9 and Aric Holman 10.9.

LSU leads the series with Mississippi State, 110-102 with MSU winning four of the last five. LSU won the last game of the regular season, 78-57, over the Bulldogs in Baton Rouge last year. The past two years, the Tigers and Bulldogs have played the last game of the regular season and then the first game in the SEC Tournament. Mississippi State leads in Starkville games, 60-38, with LSU's last win in Starkville in 2013 (69-68).

Ben Howland is in his fourth season as the head coach at Mississippi State.

The Tigers are back home at the Maravich Center on Saturday at 1 p.m. against Auburn. The game will be on one of the ESPN networks (ESPN/2/U) that will be announced early this week.
