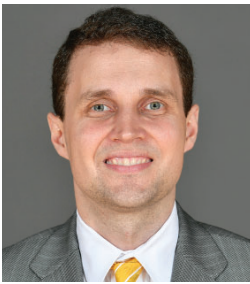

2nd Year at LSU • 6th Year as a Head Coach

After laying a new foundation for the future of LSU basketball in Year 1, Will Wade enters his second year as head coach of the Tigers.

The first night Wade led the Tigers onto the floor of the Maravich Center was a night that signaled a new dawn for the storied program.

There had been plenty of excitement prior to the opening game as the first-year coach went all over the state speaking to groups about basketball.

But would people back that up by showing for the opening game?

They did to the tune of 11,856 at the Maravich Center, the largest opening night crowd since the start of Shaquille O'Neal's final season of play at LSU in 1991-92.

It was the first of 18 wins that would lead LSU back to postseason play for the first-time since 2015 and produce the first postseason NIT win in Baton Rouge.

Wade became just the second coach in school history to take his first LSU team to postseason play.

The first-year coach delivered on what he promised – a team that would play hard, would represent the University well and players committed to building the program.

Wade and an experienced coaching staff put together a recruiting class that included two five-star players and two four-star players that helped the Tigers finish with the No. 3 recruiting class in the country leading into the 2018-19 season.

That new foundation for the future began on March 20, 2017, when Frank William "Will" Wade was named the 22nd head men's basketball coach at LSU.

He arrived at LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University with four years of very successful experience as a head basketball coach.

Wade was introduced to LSU fans at a special media event held in the middle of the LSU Student Union. Wade told the media and a large contingent of LSU students:

"I am so excited about the opportunity to lead this program and LSU Basketball back to the top of the SEC and back to regular, consistent NCAA Tournament appearances. We have been to four Final Fours. We have been to 20 NCAA Tournaments. We have 10 SEC Championships, and we are going to add to all three of those categories over our tenure here."

Prior to his appointment at LSU, the native of Nashville, Tenn., directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the 2017 tourney.

Before becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as director of Basketball

Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). In eight years as an assistant coach at Clemson (2005-07), Harvard (2007-09) and VCU (2009-13), the teams had a record of 177-97 with six postseason appearances (2005-13).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth.

LAST GAME: LSU 83, AUBURN 78 (Feb. 9, 2019, Baton Rouge)

The Tigers survived a barrage of Auburn three-pointers and a 16-point deficit in the first half to get the win to start the second half of SEC play. LSU used its inside dominance, out rebounding Auburn, 48-35, and 23-7 on the offensive boards to turn the game around. LSU had a 36-18 advantage in points in the paint and 29-1 in second chance points, as well as a 31-14 edge in points off turnovers.

Auburn in its first 13 field goals made in the game hit 11 three-pointers and two two-point field goals. On the other hand, LSU had in its first 13 field goals, 11 made two-pointers and two three-point field goals.

LSU fell behind, 26-10, with 11:02 to go in the first half as Auburn would outscore LSU, 20-1, before cutting the margin to 41-38 at intermission. In the second half, LSU took the lead for good at 48-45 on a Tremont Waters three-ball with 16:29 to go in the contest and would eventually lead by as much as 10 with 8:42 to go.

Auburn would cut the margin to one and had a couple of shots down three in the final minute.

Skylar Mays led LSU with 20 points, while Waters had 19 points and 10 assists. Naz Reid had 13 points and 11 rebounds, while Kavell Bigby-Williams had 10 rebounds.

PROBABILITIES

LSU has been walking a high-wire of late of getting down double figures in four-of-the last five games.

NCAA.com documented that a couple weeks ago when LSU was down 14 to Missouri (1/26) with 2:14 to play that LSU's probability of winning was down to 0.3%. Skylar Mays scored nine straight and LSU had a 14.6% chance when the Tigers cut the lead to five. Slowly but surely the percentages came in LSU's favor as the game went to overtime and won.

Against Arkansas (2/2), the Tigers were down 18 points in the second half and came back to take a lead in the final minute before losing by a point.

According to SEC Charts – Hoops (@ChartsSEC), the Tigers had just an eight percent chance to win the game at Mississippi State (2/6) when LSU was down 10 in the contest and still was under 10 percent as the game headed to the final seven minutes. LSU turned that around and in overtime again got the percentage all the way to 100 in its favor.

Against Auburn (2/9), the Tigers were 16 down in the first half and at that point before LSU made its comeback and turned the margin all the way up to 10 up, LSU had a win probability at that point of 17 percent.

LEAGUE ENTERS FINAL FOUR WEEKS

The league has passed the halfway point and now begins its final four weeks of play with the Tuesday/Wednesday schedule. Three teams -- Tennessee (10-0), Kentucky and LSU (both 9-1) enter the week with at least two games on fourth place South Carolina (7-3). The Gamecocks presently hold the final double bye position and they are one game ahead of Alabama and Ole Miss at 6-4. Alabama and Auburn are at 5-5.

The Tigers with the win on Saturday have surpassed in 23 games the number of wins (18) it posted a year ago in 33 games and the nine conference wins in 10 games this year surpasses LSU's conference win total in Coach Will Wade's first year at LSU.

The Tigers have two on the road this week. After the Kentucky game, the Tigers will play at Georgia on Saturday before coming home for three straight against Florida, Tennessee and Texas A&M.

SCORING NOTES

The Tigers remain undefeated in Will Wade's tenure when scoring 90 or more after the 92-88 win at Mississippi State (2/6). LSU is 6-0 this season and 9-0 in Coach Wade's two seasons scoring 90-or-more. LSU is 13-1 this year and 24-4 when scoring 80 or more over two seasons.

The game with Arkansas in a 90-89 loss (2/2) marked the only time this season that LSU has scored at least 80 points and lost.

On defense, the Tigers are 10-0 when allowing less than 70 points and 20-1 in the Coach Wade era when allowing less than 70 points.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

The LSU Tigers will be ranked for a fourth straight week and for the seventh time this season when the new polls come out on Monday. LSU should move up from No. 21 in the AP poll and 22 in the coaches' poll after two wins last week. LSU was ranked No. 23 in the preseason poll, No. 22 in the second poll and 19 in week three. LSU received votes out of the top 25 in weeks four and 11 before getting back in at 25, 19, 21 and the new ranking in the last four polls.

The Tigers are 10-3 this year when ranked (5-2 in their first stint, 5-1 in this stint) and overall is 270-102 as a ranked AP team all-time. This is the 205th poll appearance since the first poll began in 1949.

When playing a game when both teams are ranked in the AP poll, the Tigers are 26-40 all-time.

LSU IN THE NET; 11 QUADRANT 1-2 WINS

The tool that the NCAA selection committee will use to help determine the tournament field is called the NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool), which relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin (capped at 10 points), net offensive and defensive efficiency and the quality of wins and losses.

After play on Saturday, the Tigers are 17 in the NET, one of four SEC teams in the top 20 of the NCAA Evaluation Toll.

LSU has an 11-4 mark against teams in the Quadrant 1-2 section of the NET. Altogether, 15-of-LSU's 23 games have been either presently Quadrant 1 or Quadrant 2 games.

The wins over Saint Mary's (Neutral), Ole Miss, Arkansas, Mississippi State (all three road) and Auburn (home) are Quadrant 1 wins where LSU is 5-2 (home 1-30, neutral 1-50, away 1-75). LSU is and the Tigers are 6-2 in quadrant 2 wins (W, Alabama, Furman UNCG, Memphis, Missouri, Texas A&M)(home 31-75, neutral 51-100, away 76-135). Five of LSU's wins are in quadrant 3 and three in quadrant 4.

LSU's strength of schedule is 18th best in Division I.

DUNK-O-METER

The revived dunk-o-meter has gotten lots of use here lately, including the Arkansas game when 10 were registered. LSU added five more against the Auburn to push the season total to 118.

It was suggested back when Shaquille O'Neal arrived at LSU before the 1989-90 season that we find a spot in the notes for the total number of dunks O'Neal primarily and with him the rest of the Tigers had in those three years he was at LSU. Thus for lack of a better title, the Dunk-O-Meter was born.

Now with what may be one of the most exciting and entertaining teams in college basketball this year, it was requested on social media that the dunk-o-meter make a return. Even though the dunks have been a part of the stats in the game notes all season, we will move some team totals and other dunk notes to this spot.

Kavell Bigby-Williams has 32 dunks and Marlon Taylor with 26, Naz Reid 24, Emmitt Williams 18 and Skylar Mays completing those in double figures with 11.

Marlon Taylor became the third member of the Tigers team that has made SportsCenter top play when he took an alley-oop from Tremont Waters to earn No. 1 play after the win over Georgia. Waters and Skylar Mays were featured in multiple POD last season.

ON THE ROAD

Once LSU found a way to win on the road, the road has become a fun place over the last five games as the Tigers have gone more than halfway through the league road season undefeated at 5-0 with three wins in overtime.

The win over Arkansas (1/12) at Bud Walton Arena stopped a nine-game road losing streak for the Tigers and was the first time LSU had won consecutive road games in Fayetteville since they first played the Hogs in 1949.

With the win at Mississippi State last Wednesday, the Tigers have won their first five road league games for the fifth time in school history:

1980-81 - 8 (started 8-0 on road; lost final game at UK)

1952-53 - 7 (finished 7-0 on the road)

1953-54 - 6 (finished 6-0 on the road)

1990-91 - 5

2018-19 - 5

LSU won its first two league road games in 2018 before losing the last seven. LSU is 7-7 in 14 league road games under Will Wade.

Highlighting the five road wins was LSU's first win in The Pavilion at Ole Miss, 83-69. The winning margin of 14 points was LSU's largest win ever on an opponent's home court against a ranked team. Besides Arkansas, the overtime wins came at Missouri and Mississippi State.

All-time, LSU is 424-637 on the road or a win percentage of 39.9 percent.

OVERTIME

LSU is 3-1 in overtime games this year:

11/23 -- L - vs. Florida State (Orlando) - 76-79

1/12 - W - at Arkansas - 94-88

1/26 - W - at Missouri - 86-80

LSU all-time is 42-57 in overtime games. This is the sixth time LSU has had four or more overtime games in a season and the first time LSU has had three overtime seasons since LSU was 3-2 in the record five overtime season of 2014-15.

TIGERS AT THE MARAVICH CENTER

LSU is now 12-1 at home in the Maravich Center coming off the win against Auburn (2/6).

LSU's loss to Arkansas on Feb. 2 snapped an 18-game home winning streak in the building that started in late January 2018 and ended up tied for the second longest in the building history.

The Tigers have been playing in the Maravich Center, originally the LSU Assembly Center, since January 3, 1972.

The Tigers, all-time, are 561-194 (74.3%) in the building and 257-151 in SEC games (63.0%).

EIGHT IS ENOUGH

For those that may not remember, Eight Is Enough was a popular ABC TV show in the late 1970s through the early 1980s, but it also is proving to be the mantra for LSU's team in the SEC.

Coach Will Wade has pretty much settled into the eight-man rotation of guards Waters, Mays, Smart and Taylor and forwards Reid, Bigby-Williams, Williams and Days. That rotation became official after the announcement earlier in the month when Daryl Edwards had undergone surgery on his injured leg/foot.

Also able to contribute are Marshall Graves and former LSU baseball pitcher Will Reese.

STEALS ARE GOOD IN BASKETBALL

LSU has some very good steal numbers with 225 total (9.8 spg), with the average ranked first in the SEC and seventh in the country.

LSU's Tremont Waters is ranked first in the league in both steals average (3.13) and total steals (72). He is fourth in both nationally.

Skylar Mays is ranked third in the league in both steals average (2.0) and total steals (47). That is ranked No. 42 in the nation in average and No. 40 in total steals in the NCAA stats.

LSU is +2.2 over last year's steal average of 7.6 a game.

Waters had eight steals in the ULM game (12/28), the second time (last year vs. A&M at home) that Waters had eight steals in a game. The eight steals is tied for most in the league in a single game by an individual this year. That number is also tied for the second most in a single game in LSU history:

 With a minimum of nine games remaining, Waters is on pace to reach the LSU total steals record of 93 set by Daryl Joe in 1987 (72 total to date).

FREE THROW TOTALS TRENDING UP

There have been some ups and downs at the free throw line for LSU, but the Tigers shot over 90 percent at the line for the second time this season against South Carolina (1/19). Here are the numbers for those games:

UNCG (11/9) – 28-of-31 – 90.3%
Carolina (1/19) – 32-of-35 – 91.4%

In the UNCG game, the Tigers made their first 22 attempts before a miss. Against South Carolina, the Tigers made their last 19 in a 19-of-19 second half at the line.

LSU started slow against Georgia (1/23) making just 7-of-12 in the first half, but made 14-of-17 in the second half to finish 21-of-29 (72.4%). At Missouri (1/26), LSU attempted 37 and made 29 for 78.4 percent. Skylar Mays became the first player in the Will Wade era at LSU to make 10 free throws in a game.

The Tigers made 32 free throws for the second time in SEC play this year against Arkansas (2/2) when they made 32-of-38 from the line. The Tigers were 12-of-13 in the first half and 20-of-25 in the final 20 minutes. The final free throw percentage was 84.2 percent. Against Mississippi State, LSU was 19-of-25.

In 10 games, LSU has made at least 20 free throws including six of the SEC games. The South Carolina and Arkansas games were nearly record setters as only once since the 2002-03 season has the Tigers had a game where they made more than 32 free throws (37 vs. Georgia, 1/26/16).

The 91.4 percent against the Gamecocks is LSU's highest when taking at least 35 free throws, which has happened more times than you might think according to webmaster Todd Politz who found it has happened 148 times since 1966.

The Tigers are third in the league and No. 16 in the nation in free throw percentage at 76.1 percent (426-560). Opponents are 320-460 (69.6%). LSU is +106 in free throw makes on 1003 more attempts. Skylar Mays is 76-of-87 (87.4 percent), with Darius Days is at 84 percent (21-25) and Javonte Smart is at 83.1% (49-59).

Mays is third in the league and No. 33 in the nation in free throw percentage. In the SEC games, the Tigers are 224-of-285 or 78.6 percent, compared to 143-of-207 (69.1%). In SEC play, the Tigers have made more free throws (224) than the eight opponents have attempted (207). Mays is 46-of-53 (86.8 percent), Reid is 41-of-50 (82%) and Smart at 80 percent (24-30).

LSU has only lost 46 times in the last 52 seasons (402 games) when it has made more free throws in a game than the opponent attempts.

LSU OVER 50 PERCENT

LSU has been over 50 percent from the field in 10 games this season ... Here are the 50 percent shooting games this season:

LSU is 9-1 this year when shooting 50 percent or better, 21-1 in the Will Wade era. That one loss came in the Florida State game (11/23), stopping a 16-game winning streak dating back to the end of the 2016-17 season when LSU shot 50 percent or better. LSU is 82-7 since the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.

LSU is fifth in the league in field goal percentage at 47.1 percent.

THREE-POINTERS

LSU was good from the arc in the first three conference games, making 10 versus both Alabama (1/9) and at Arkansas (1/12) and nine at Ole Miss (1/15) for 29 three-point makes. LSU made just 32 total in conference games 4-9. But LSU rebounded a bit against Auburn (2/6), making nine total.

In the 10 conference games, LSU is 70-of-218 from the arc (32.1 percent) while opponents are 77-of-234 (32.9%). In the State game (2/2), LSU took only one three-pointer in the first 20 minutes, but one of the three makes in the game was Naz Reid's rim bouncer in the final 30 seconds of overtime that clinched the win.

The Tigers shot an amazing 80 percent from the arc in the first half against Alabama (1/8), hitting 8-of-10, including five in the final six minutes of the first half when LSU expanded the lead from three to 15 at the half. LSU finished the game 10-of-15 or 66.7 percent overall.

It marked the fourth time LSU has shot 66 percent or better when attempting at least 10 three-pointers in a game:

70.6% at South Alabama (12-17), 11/28/2010 (fifth all-time in SEC)
66.7% vs. Alabama (10-15), 1/8/2019 (T10 all-time in SEC)

Tremont Waters had six three-point field goals (1/30) at Texas A&M when he scored 36 points. The six field three-point field goals by Waters marked the 11th time an LSU player has made at least six field goals in a game since 2003. Ten of those were six treys and Marcus Thornton, who had eight at Auburn (1/30/08). It was the first time a player had six treys in a game since Keith Hornsby at Houston on Dec. 13, 2015.

WILL WADE

The graduate of Franklin Road Academy in Nashville won his 100th game as a head coach last season ... Now in his sixth season as a head coach (2 at Chattanooga, 2 at VCU and 2 at LSU), he coached on Jan. 19th his 50th game as LSU coach. In his two years, he has reestablished an interest in basketball at LSU and established a new culture for this program as it moves forward ... This from one of the youngest head coaches in the so-called major conferences in college basketball this season (SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12, Big East, AAC).

The 10-game LSU win streak LSU had in December and January marked the longest win streak for Coach Wade at LSU and T2 for the longest win streak in his head coaching career. Wade had winning streaks of 12 and 10 at either Chattanooga or VCU before the 10-game streak at LSU.

In his coaching stops, he has won 72-out-of-98 conference games over the six years and three different conferences.

TREMONT WATERS

He doesn't like talking about his game but he enjoys talking about his team and through the ups and downs of the season that it was "just about playing basketball" and he has just been playing basketball the last few weeks, averaging 20.0 points, 6.8 assists and 3.0 steals in the SEC.

In the last five games, Waters is posting at a 21.2 points per game mark.

And, a picture showed up on Twitter Saturday evening an hour or so after the game and his post-game media. After scoring 19 points and dishing out 10, he was in the practice gym with the shooting net up working on his game.

The last two Wednesdays on the road, Waters has shown his ability in two different ways.

At College Station (1/30), he scored 23 first-half points on the way to his second highest career scoring game of 36 in the win over the Aggies. In the game, he had six three-pointers in 10 attempts, finishing 11-of-18 from the field.

At Mississippi State Wednesday (2/6), Waters attempted just two treys, making one and was determined to drive the ball in deep and scored several layups and short shots on another 11-of-18 shooting night that saw him score 26 points.

Waters had 39 as a freshman against Marquette in the Maui Invitational in November 2017 and was scoring almost at will, especially in the first half when he hit 5-of-7 treys. For the game he was 11-of-18 from the field, 6-of-10 at the arc and just as impressive, 8-of-8 from the line. He also had seven assists and three steals.

The 36 points by Tremont Waters against A&M (1/30) is T5 among all individual point games by LSU since the 2003 season and the sophomore has two of those games:

On January 23, in the win over Georgia, the sophomore from New Haven, Connecticut posted a 26-points, no turnover game. It was his first no turnover game at LSU. He made 9-of-14 field goal attempts, one trey and 7-of-11 at the free throw line. Not to mention his passing to Marlon Taylor that led to the No. 1 play the next day on SportsCenter.

Waters has been in double figure scoring for 14 straight games dating back to the Houston loss on Dec. 12. He is the first LSU player with double figure consecutive double figure scoring games since Ben Simmons ran off 28 in his 2016 season at LSU.

Waters flirted with a triple double against ULM in equaling his career high in steals, a game he also flirted with similar numbers.

SKYLAR MAYS

The junior guard from Baton Rouge has had five double figure games in SEC play, including 17 against Arkansas (2/2). But he was entering Saturday's game off two road games in which he was 3-of-16 and had a combined nine points at A&M

and Mississippi State.

However, against Auburn, the Skylar Mays LSU fans were used to seeing was back in all phases of the game with two treys, eight free throws as part of a 20-point, two assist, three steal game.

After the game Saturday, Coach Will Wade mentioned in the press conference that Mays had been preparing this week for a big physics exam on Thursday and an anatomy test on Friday. Wade said that you could see all the weight lifted off his shoulders prior to the game.

The 20 against Auburn, was his fourth 20 point game of the season joining 20 vs. Oklahoma State (11/25), 20 vs. Georgia (1/23) and 24 at Mizzou (1/26). In that game, Mays had the 9-0 run that started LSU's comeback to force overtime from 14 down. Against Missouri, Mays was 6-of-12 from the field with two treys and 10-of-12 from the free throw line.

In the last five games, Mays is averaging 14.0 points a game with 2.0 assists and 2.2 steals.

For the season Mays is averaging 13.4 points per game, 3.1 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

The second team Academic A-A in 2018 chosen by CoSIDA members has a 4.008 GPA and is majoring in pre-med/kinesiology ... In addition to the CoSIDA honor last spring, he was honored by the LSU Black Faculty and Staff Caucus at their annual awards presentation as one of the recipients of the Jesse Owens Student Award for highest GPA by undergrad student-athletes.

His free throw percentage of 88.3 percent is the third best in the conference.

JAVONTE SMART

Freshman Javonte Smart had his fourth double figure scoring game in the last seven against Arkansas (2/2) when he scored 18 points, tying his season high. Smart hit five field goals with a trey and 7-of-8 at the free throw line. He previously had 18 points in the game at Houston (12/12).

For the season, Smart has made 27 treys and is shooting well from the free throw line at 83.1 percent (49-59). He is averaging 10.2 points a game and 2.3 assists.

He started the first 13 games before coming off the bench during conference play. He came off the bench for the first time in college against the Crimson Tide (1/8) hitting 4-of-11 overall and 3-of-5 from the arc to go with five assists, just one turnover and one steal in 29 minutes.

The Baton Rouge native has delivered 13 double figure scoring games this season.

MARLON TAYLOR

The junior college transfer had a huge game at Arkansas (1/12) that saw him contribute in so many ways: Season high – 21 pts; Co high – 7 rebs (4 offensive); Season high – 7 FGs (7-8, 1 trey); 6-6 FTs

Then at Ole Miss (1/15): 12 pts; 5 rebs, 5-8 FGs (2 treys, equaling season best); 2 asts, 2 stls

Against South Carolina (1/19), Taylor was in double figures for the third straight game with 10 points, but eight of the points came at the foul line where he was 8-of-9. It was his second big free throw game of the year, making 9-of-11 at Houston (12/12).

Against Georgia (1/23), it wasn't double figures but an appearance in SportsCenter's top plays that made it another night for Taylor to be remembered.

For the season, Taylor has made 55-of-116 field goals (47.4%) with 11 treys. He is averaging 7.0 points and 3.7 rebounds a game. In the league, Taylor has averaged 8.3 points a game and 5.2 rebounds.

THREE, FOUR-GUARD OFFENSE

LSU and Coach Will Wade has consistently run at least three guards in the starting lineup for the first 21 games of the season – 10 games with Waters, Smart and Mays before two games with Smart, Mays and Taylor in the lineup with Waters coming off the bench. In the 10 conference games, the three guards have been Waters, Mays and Taylor.

The one exception was against ULM (12/28), when based on the matchup, Coach Wade started four guards for the first time in his two years at LSU with Smart, Mays, Taylor and Waters in the starting lineup.

Naz Reid leads the team in rebounds at 6.3 boards a game with Kavell Bigby-Williams at 5.9 boards a game and Emmitt Williams 5.8 a contest.

LSU averages 38.4 boards a game for the season and a rebound margin of 5.6 which is second in the league. LSU is fourth in overall rebound average. In the 10 conference games, the team is averaging 40.7 boards a game, compared to 33.6 for opponents. LSU is first in the league in conference game rebounding and second in rebound margin (+7.1). In the last five games, LSU is pulling down 43.0 boards a game compared to 33.4 by the opponents.

KBW

Senior forward Kavell Bigby-Williams had his third double digit rebound game in the last four against Auburn (2/9) when he pulled down 10 boards while scoring seven points. Earlier in the week at Mississippi State, KBW had 14 points and 13 rebounds, his sixth double double of the season.

Entering the week, Kavell Bigby-Williams' nine blocks against Grambling on Dec. 1 was tied for second most in a single game this season in the NCAA with the top two being in-state players:

Bigby-Williams averages 1.9 blocks per game. That is fifth in the league and No. 47 in the nation.

KBW just missed becoming the third person in the last 30 years to have double figure blocks in a game. Shaquille O'Neal had games with 12 blocks (once), 11 (3 times) and 10 blocks (twice). Stromile Swift had 11 in a game once.

Since the start of the 2001-02 season, KBW joined the following LSU players who have had six or more blocks in a game are: Kavell Bigby-Williams (1), Tyrus Thomas (3), Chris Johnson (4), Jordan Mickey (4), Brandon Bass (2), Glen Davis (1), Anthony Randolph (1) and Malcolm White (1).

For his efforts against Ole Miss and South Carolina, he was named SEC Player of the Week. For the season Bigby-Williams is averaging 7.8 points and 5.9 rebounds. He is averaging 19 minutes a game and is a good 70-of-101 from the field (69.3 percent). He has posted nine double figure scoring games.

NAZ REID

The freshman scored 25 points in the second half and overtime to post 29 in the win at Mississippi State Wednesday. He had nine rebounds, was 10-of-17 from the floor with two treys and 7-of-8 from the line. He also had two assists, one block and a steal in 35 minutes.

He came back at Auburn (2/9) and scored 13 points and grabbed 11 boards for his third double double, his second in the last three games and Reid's third straight double figure points game.

The freshman had his first SEC double double against Arkansas (2/2) with 19 points and 10 rebounds, hitting five field goals, including a trey and 8-9 at the free throw line.

Four times this year he has posted three consecutive double figure scoring games.

In the rally against Missouri, Reid had two important free throws, part of a 9-9 night at the free throw line. Reid is 70-of-94 at the stripe for 74.5 percent and 28-of-34 in the past five games combined.

In his opening game of SEC play, he played his fewest minutes against Alabama (1/8) because of eventually fouling out after 17 minutes of court time (7 pts, 3 blks). But Reid had a strong game at Arkansas (1/12) with 27 points on 10-of-12 shooting which included 4-of-4 three-pointers. He also was 3-of-4 at the free throw line. He had seven rebounds and two assists.

His first 29 point game came in November against UNCG. That was also a game in which he made four three-pointers.

The freshman was named POW in Louisiana for his play in the ULM game by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

He has made 21 three-pointers and in SEC games, he is 10-of-22 from the arc at 45.5%.

He is averaging for the year 13.9 points and 6.3 rebounds. He is averaging 15.5 points and 6.9 rebounds in the SEC games.

DARIUS DAYS

Coach Wade in his media session on Jan. 25 predicted success for the freshman and he has delivered in many ways recently, especially on the boards. At College Station (1/30), Days had nine points on 4-of-7 shooting, including a three, with eight rebounds, a block and a steal in 15 minutes. Days had seven offensive rebounds and that led to three offensive put backs and scores for the Tigers.

Against Arkansas, he didn't score but he had seven more rebounds and four of those were offensive.

The freshman has started three games for the Tigers and is averaging 5.4 points and 4.3 rebounds. He is 45-of-98 from the field and an impressive 21-of-25 at the free throw line.

In the three games as a starter, Days had 13 points and nine rebounds against Grambling (12/1), nine points and eight rebounds against Incarnate Word (12/9) and seven points and three boards at Houston (12/12). In the three games, Days was 11-of-21 from the floor with three treys.

His best game of the year came against Alabama (1/8) as far as scoring with 14 points on 5-of-10 shooting, including 3-of-4 from the arc.

EMMITT WILLIAMS

The freshman had seven points and five rebounds (three offensive) against Missouri (1/26) but it was his hustle play when he was fouled with 2.2 seconds that got him to the line for a most pressure packed free throw that got LSU to the overtime. After missing the first, he got the roll on the second one to get LSU even at 71-71.

The freshman has been in double figures in six games this season, the last with 15 points against South Carolina (1/19).

The 15 points represent a season high. Against South Carolina, he played 24 minutes and made 3-of-8 from the field and 9-of-10 from the free throw line. For the game, he also had his third double double with 13 rebounds. He also had 15 points against Saint Mary's (12/15).

His other two doubles came with 12 points and 10 rebounds against Southeastern (11/6) and 11 points and 10 rebounds against Memphis (11/13). He had his fourth double figure rebound game at Arkansas (1/12) with 10.

Williams is averaging 7.8 points per game, 5.8 rebounds and is shooting 60.8 percent from the field.

FRESHMAN SCORING WELL FOR TIGERS

Kenpom.com gives LSU an experience level at 23 games of 1.08, ranked 326 of the 353 teams as of Monday. Only Arkansas and Kentucky have younger experience ranks in Kenpom.

The freshmen on the LSU team have scored 44.3 percent of LSU's points this season overall and 41.3% of the points in LSU's nine SEC games.

SERIES VERSUS KENTUCKY

The Wildcats have won 10 straight games heading into this matchup, coming off a four-point, 71-67, win at Starkville against Mississippi State. The Wildcats led 40-25 at the half. PJ Washington led Kentucky with 23 points while Keldon Johnson had 13 and Tyler Herro had 12. Ashton Hagans had eight points and nine assists. The teams only had nine turnovers each in the game as UK shot 47.4 percent overall and 7-of-18 outside the arc.

Washington leads UK in scoring at 14.2 points a game, while Johnson averages 13.9, Herro 13.3 and Reid Travis 11.7.

Kentucky leads the overall series, 89-26 and has won three straight in the series. LSU has two wins in the last 13 games against the Wildcats. LSU has won five times in 49 games in Lexington with the last win coming in 2009, 73-70, when LSU clinched the SEC title in Lexington.

Highlighting the 26 LSU wins is 18 by Coach Dale Brown in his 25-year career.

GEORGIA IN ATHENS NEXT

The Tigers are on the road again on Saturday, traveling to Athens to take on the University of Georgia at 6 p.m. ET (5 p.m. BR time). LSU will then return home for consecutive home games against Florida, Tennessee and Texas A&M.
